Re-Invitation of Expression of Interest (EOI) from the NGOs to Implement the Post-Literacy and Continuing Education Program

1. The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and grant from the Department for International Development (DFID) and the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC) towards the cost of the project titled "Post-Literacy and Continuing Education for Human Development Project-2 (PLCEHDP-2)" and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the contract for Implementing Non-Government Organization (NGO) services for implementation of Post-literacy & Continuing Education Program in 210 upazilas of 29 districts of 6 divisions.

2. The objectives of the project are to develop human resources of the country, to include about 1.6 million neo literates in post literacy and continuing education programs to consolidate, maintain and upgrade the literacy skills they have acquired previously, to help develop their life pattern by increasing their incomes through providing technical skills training. The project has been reformulated to support new implementation strategy and implementation & dissemination of the recently approved NFE Policy Framework that the government has developed and instituted to guide the planning, operation and coordination of Non-Formal Education (NFE) sub-sector activities in the country. The Government of Bangladesh (GOB) will selected and contract experienced large INGO, with adequate functional capacity, one for each project district. The INGO will be responsible for effective implementation of the project in the allotted district including internal monitoring. Each INGO will be responsible for the following tasks:
a. Provide post literacy and continuing education;
b. Conduct baseline survey to identify target areas and potential skills;
c. Identify and appoint supervisors and facilitators;
d. Mobilize community to identify learners, Center Management Committee (CMC) members, venue, potential skills and service providers;
e. Help district level Assistant Director of BNFE to organize training program for CMCs, supervisors and facilitators and to conduct social mobilization programmes;
f. Help CMC to establish and make it operational and
g. Monitor the performance of Continuing Education Centers (CECs);
1 (one) INGO will be selected for Kushtia district and INGO may include associate service provider/associate NGO as necessary for implementation of program. The associate service providers/associate NGOs must have been registered under Social Welfare Department/Directoriate of Women Affairs/Bureau of NGO Affairs/Registrar of Joint Stock Companies of the Government and at least have three years of NFE experience after registration.
Eligibility Criteria: Implementing Non-Government Organization (INGO) must:
(i) Be registered with the NGO Affairs Bureau;
(ii) Be a non-profit and non-political organization;
(iii) Have a duly approved constitution as per relevant registration act and hold elections regularly as provided for in the constitution;
(iv) Have a legally constituted Executive Board with list of membership, including their academic and professional background;
(v) Have an organizational structure with information on number of staff at senior and mid level management in the areas of finance, management, monitoring and NFE, with information on their academic background, professional experience, roles and responsibilities; and preferably have or can arrange adequate physical facilities for holding vocational skills training classes;
(vi) Have established local office premises in the proposed project district where willing to work;
(vii) Have working experience with government and different donors;
(viii) Have at least five years working experience, after registration, in the field of non-formal basic literacy and in the field of vocational/livelihood skills training;
(ix) Have program progress evaluation reports prepared by the NGO as well as external/third party. Submission of evaluation reports, one each prepared internally and externally;
(x) Have ability/provision to share the overhead cost (maintenance of office/salaries/wages of management personnel, etc.) from its own resources;
(xi) Have a good system of maintaining transparent accounts, internal and external audit, and general financial management. Submission of general audit report for the last 3 years based on NGO's fiscal year. Be willing to accept external audit;
(xii) INGO must submit bank solvency certificate mentioning the closing balance and their financial turnover for the past three (3) years;
(xiii) Have a good system of planning, monitoring, evaluation and reporting of program activities, problem identification and remedial actions taken;
(xiv) Have ability to undertake surveys for baseline data and income-generating opportunities within the project district and maintain a database of its own;
(xv) Have a network of infrastructure in the designated operation area or the ability to build/expand the same as required;
(xvi) Have a program for development of women (one with a good record of service where beneficiaries have been involved in project planning and management will be given preference);
(xvii) Not seek or receive funds from more than one source for the program in the same area;

6. It is estimated covering the above table for the district will be established during the project period. Each CEC will have 30 male learners and 30 female learners in two shifts every year. Post literacy and continuing education course will be 9 months followed by 3 months follow-up activities.

7. The Project Director, PLCEHD-2 under the Bureau of Non-Formal Education (BNFE) of Ministry of Primary and Mass Education (MOPME) invites eligible INGOs to submit their Expression of Interest (EOI) for the above contract. Interested INGOs must provide specific information with supporting documentary evidence for above requirements, demonstrating that they are qualified to perform the services.

8. Interested INGOs are required to submit their EOI to the address indicated below by 05 July 2011. Only short-listed INGOs will be asked to submit the proposal as per Request for Proposal (RFP). INGO will be allowed to submit Expression of Interest (EOI) including the list of associate service providers/associate NGOs.
