

Five more Jubo League men remanded for Rasu murder

Pistol used in killing recovered from accused

Five more Jubo League men have been remanded in the case for May 23 murder of party activist Abu Bakkar Siddik Rasu. The Chief Judicial Magistrate's Court here yesterday granted a five-day remand for Rana Sarkar, Sumon alias 'Petrol' Sumon, Nipun, Uzzal and Sazed, said sub-inspector Hipzul Alam Munshi, also the investigation officer (IO) of the case.

Earlier police produced the accused in the court seeking seven days' remand on Wednesday noon, Munshi added.

Police on Tuesday night arrested two more Jubo League men -- Rana Sarkar and Sumon alias 'Petrol' Sumon -- on specific charges in Jubo League activist Abu Bakkar Siddik Rasu killing case

from Charghat area in Rajshahi.

On the basis of Rana and Sumon's statement police also recovered the pistol used in killing Rasu and two bullets from Rana's business house "Arts of Bangladesh" in Kanaikhali area of the town on the same night.

Rana Sarkar, 28, is a son of Abdul Mannan of Kanaikhali area in the town while Sumon alias 'Petrol' Sumon, 25, is son of Abul Kashem of the same area.

On May 26, police arrested Nipun, Uzzal and Sazed and recovered a scarf used to gag Rasu's mouth before killing, the IO said.

On May 29, Chief Judicial Magistrate Liakat Ali Mollah granted a three-day remand for Nipun, Uzzal and Sazed. After the end of remand, all the three

were produced in court again seeking seven days' remand on Wednesday noon while Rana and Sumon were produced in court yesterday also for seven days' remand.

Nasirul Islam, additional superintendent of police in Natore said that Nipun, Uzzal and Sazed have already confessed that they shot Rasu with pistol on Narad river in Kanaikhali area.

On May 25, the same court granted a four-day remand for Ripon Ali, Goutam, Sohrab and Subhash and a two-day remand for Sabbir. They are now in Natore jail, Nasirul added.

Abu Bakkar Siddik Rasu, 28, son of Abdur Rouf Noni, was shot dead at Kanaikhali Jelepara allegedly by intra-party rivals on May 23 night.

Singapore experts yet to salvage Banglar Shikha

A six-member Singapore team that came to Mongla Port on Tuesday evening could not salvage MV Banglar Shikha till yesterday noon.

Strenuous efforts are being made to salvage the ship and save the huge quantity of imported wheat from being damaged, an official said.

MV Banglar Shikha, a sea going vessel owned by Bangladesh Shipping Corporation (BSC) and laden with 7,700 metric tonnes of imported wheat, got stuck at Heron Point close to the Bay of Bengal at 6:30 pm on May 15.

All the efforts made by Mongla Port Authority (MPA) to salvage the ship with the help of tug boats amid high waves of the rough sea went in vain, officials said.

The ship could not be tugged to the shore as it was heavily burdened with 7,700 metric tonnes of wheat.

Later, it was decided to tug the ship after unloading at least 70 percent wheat sacks.

But lighterage vessels could not go to the place of occurrence as the sea has been rough since last three weeks, said Sirajul Huq, manager of the Khulna office of BSC.

The vessel got stuck at Heron point as it plied on wrong route. Because, there was neither any signal light nor any route indicator for it to reach the destination through narrow channel of Mongla Port, he said.

However, all the 35 crew members on board are quite hale and hearty. They have food for more 10 days in their stock, said Md Nasiruddin, assistant manager (admin) of the media wing of BSC.

The six-member salvage team brought from Singapore started work on Wednesday with help of two tug boats--Dynamic and Agni Prahari.

"We have a plan to bring more high powered tug boats from Singapore, if necessary, in case of failure to salvage MV Banglar Shikha," manager Sirajul Islam further said.

Abducted schoolgirl rescued in Gaibandha

Gobindaganj police yesterday rescued a schoolgirl from a house at Maria village in the upazila.

Police said Ranju Mia, father of two children, picked up the girl, a student of class seven at Mokaberia Dakhil Madrasa on a microbus on May 9 and took her to an unknown place.

The victim later told police that the abductor kept her confined to houses in different areas and violated her several times.

Father of the victim Alam Mia of Maria Shahebbari village filed an abduction case with Gobindaganj police station a few days later as he failed to find out his daughter after vigorous search.

Following a tip-off yesterday, police raided the house of Ranju Mia, rescued the girl but failed to arrest the culprit as he fled the scene sensing police presence.

The victim was sent to Gaibandha Sadar Hospital for medical test yesterday.

Fake fertiliser making factory unearthed

Police unearthed a fake factory with fertiliser making machine and other accessories at Dhalbaria in Sadar upazila yesterday.

Police also arrested two people and a truck laden with adulterated fertiliser from Jhhowdanga bazaar in Sadar upazila.

The arrestees are Rafiqul Islam and truck driver Tariqul Islam of Khajura area in Jessore district.

But the main accused Golam Azam, the owner of the factory, managed to flee the scene, police said.

Quoting local people police said, the night guards of Jhhowdanga bazaar seized the truck loaded with adulterated phosphate fertiliser and caught Rafiqul Islam Wednesday night. Later they handed him over to police.

Upon the confession of Rafiqul Islam, police arrested truck driver Tariqul.

During interrogation, they told police that they bought and loaded the fertiliser from a fertiliser producing factory at Dhalbaria on June 1.

Police raided the adulterated fertiliser making factory yesterday and seized fertiliser making machine with other accessories.

Two more infected with anthrax in Pabna

Two more people have been infected with anthrax at Raut Nagdapa village in Faridpur upazila of the district.

The doctors confirmed it yesterday raising the number of infected people to 12 in the last four days.

Faridpur upazila health and family planning officer Dr Md Khalilur Rahman said that the two new patients were found at Raut Nagdapa village. They are Shathi, 14, daughter of Hafizur Rahman and Mahamuda, 25, wife of Masud Rana.

"They came to Faridpur upazila health complex yesterday noon with symptoms of infection. Both of them are being treated," Dr Khalilur Rahman said.

Meanwhile, an expert team of the Institute of Epidemiology, Disease, Control, Research (IEDCR) led by Dr Apurba Chakrabarty visited the affected area on Wednesday afternoon. During the visit, the team collected samples from the area.

AUG 17 BOMB BLAST CASES IN SATKHIRA 2 charge-sheeted JMB men freed on bail

Two activists of the banned Jama'atul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB), also charge sheeted accused in five cases for August 17 bomb blasts in Satkhira in 2005, were released on bail granted by a court at Satkhira yesterday.

Judge Md Obaidus Sobhan of the District and Sessions Judge's Court granted bail to the two JMB men -- Monowar Hossain Ujjal of Itagachha village and Asadul Haque of Kharibila in Satkhira town.

Police arrested Monowar and Asadul soon after the series blasts in the town on August 17 in 2005 and five cases were filed with Sadar police station in this regard, police said.

The two charge-sheeted JMB men were released on bail granted by the High Court on November 11 in 2010 and police arrested them again the same night.

Earlier the two JMB activists submitted a bail prayer

before the District and Sessions Judge's Court.

After a long hearing, Judge Md Obaidus Sobhan granted them bail yesterday.

On August 17 in 2005, pickpocket Rawshan Ali, who went to steal on the premises of Women and Children Repression Prevention Court, saw his neighbour Nasir Uddin Dafadar standing with a bag in hand. As Nasir Uddin left the bag there, Rawshan waited to pick it up later. But shortly after the bag was kept, it blew up.

Five other bombs also exploded simultaneously at five places in the town.

Following Rawshan's lead, police arrested JMB operative Nasir Uddin Dafadar of village Bakal Islampur and then other JMB operatives in Satkhira.

Consequently, law enforcers detected JMB's involvement in the series bomb blasts across the country on August 17 in 2005.

The Criminal

Investigation Department ASP Munshi Atiqur Rahman also investigation officer of five cases for August 17 blasts in Satkhira, submitted supplementary charge sheet against 19 JMB activists including JMB kingpins Shaikh Abdur Rahman, Siddiqul Islam Bangla Bhai and Aatur Rahman Sunny (later executed in Jhalakathi judges' murder case) to a court at Satkhira on April 4 in 2006.

The other accused are Nasir, Munna, Khokon, Monowar Hossain Ujjal, Momtaz, Asadul Haque, Belal, Khayer, Sayeed, Nayeem, Noor Ali, Gias, Habib, Fakar Uddin Raji, Palash and Liton.

Of them Nayeem, Raji, Habib, Khayer, Momtaz and Sayeed have been absconding since then.

Trial of the five August 17 series bomb blast cases has been delayed as the prosecution failed to produce either the accused or the witnesses before the court for long.
