Afridi seeks county permission

Dumped captain Shahid Afridi has called in the lawyers in a bid to secure Pakistani permission to play county cricket in England that was denied amid a public slanging match, an official said Friday.

"We have received a letter from legal firm Mandviwalla and Zafar Associates on behalf of Afridi and as per the rules we forwarded it to the disciplinary committee," said Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB)

spokesman Nadeem Sarwar. Sources close to Afridi said the letter was not a legal

notice as such but sought permission for him to play county cricket. The PCB revoked all No-Objection Certificates issued

to Afridi to play abroad, stopping him from playing for Hampshire in the Twenty20 league in England. The PCB also suspended

his central contract and salary, asking Afridi to appear before a three-man disciplinary committee on June 8.

Afridi was punished for violating the players' code of conduct in announcing his retirement from international cricket and levelling allegations of mistreatment at the PCB.

Gillespie gets Aus A role

Former Australian paceman Jason Gillespie has been appointed an assistant coach for Australia A's tour of Zimbabwe this month, Cricket Australia said on Friday.

Gillespie, who captured 259 Test wickets for Australia in a 10-year career, will support head coach Troy Cooley on the monthlong tour, which includes one-day and four-day matches.

Gillespie, 36, joins former Test players Justin Langer, Darren Lehmann and Craig McDermott in national and state level coaching roles.

"CA feels this A tour presents a good opportunity to further enhance Jason's elite coaching experience," CA general manager Michael Brown said.

"Jason has recently coached in Zimbabwe and understands the conditions we'll face there. Many of the young up-andcoming players he'll be working with followed his successful international career as schoolboys."

Gillespie spent last southern hemisphere summer as head coach of the MidWest Rhinos in Zimbabwe's first-class competition and was recently the bowling coach for Kings XI Punjab in the Indian Premier League.

"This Australia A tour allows me to further dip my toe into the elite coaching system, to work with some of the best young cricket talent in Australia and to learn from experienced bowling coaches like Troy Cooley," Gillespie said.

Australia A will play a one-day tri-series involving Zimbabwe and South Africa A, before finishing with two four-day matches against Zimbabwe.

Alastair Cook was closing in on his sixth hundred in nine Tests but England were far from having things all their own way on the opening day of the second Test against Sri Lanka.

England were 165 for four at tea at Lord's here on Friday, with opener Cook 75 not out and fellow left-hander Eoin Morgan 23 not out.

Sri Lanka, 1-0 down in this threematch series after an innings and 14run loss in the first Test in Cardiff concluded Monday, where Cook made 133, enjoyed a sensational start at the 'home of cricket' after winning the toss. They reduced England to 22 for

Depleted India expect success

A depleted India begin their tour of the Caribbean with a familiar format, playing a Twenty20 International against West Indies on Saturday at Queen's Park Oval.

Bereft of a number of their star players, like World Cup-winning captain Mahendra Singh Dhoni, batting legend Sachin Tendulkar, opener Virender Sehwag, and left-arm fast bowler Zaheer Khan, the visitors are still heavily favoured to topple their opponents.

All of their players were involved in the Indian Premier League, so the format should pose little or no trouble, neither should the conditions in the Caribbean, which are not so dissimilar to their homeland.

"The Indian Cricket Board has been very kind to the players and have allowed them some rest and we must respect this," said stand-in India captain Suresh Raina.

"Those guys have been performing well for India for quite a long time, and they deserve a break.

India, and I am excited to see them perform over the next few weeks." Raina promised that the Indians
