## Man falls from 5th floor of hotel, dies

A man died after falling from the fifth floor of a hotel in the city's Banani early yesterday while allegedly trying to escape a police raid.

The deceased was identified as Masud Alam Bhuiyan, 30, a clothes trader from Madhobdi of Narshingdi district.

Masud was climbing down a pipe around 12:00am when he slipped and fell, said Wahidur Rahman an employee of a restaurant adjacent to the Hotel Sea Queen, who rushed the injured to Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

Brother of the deceased, Alamgir Bhuiyan said Masud often visited the capital on business but always stayed over at his sister's house at Uttara.

He had no idea why Masud chose to stay at a hotel instead, he added.

Shah Alam, officer-in-charge of Gulshan Police Station said they raided the hotel around 11:45pm in a bid to bust unsocial activities and arrested 21 people in this connection.

The victim might have slipped while trying to make a getaway after hearing about the raid, he added.

## Birdem marks first yr of liver transplantation

Birdem Hospital yesterday celebrated the first anniversary of successful liver transplantation in the country.

Experts at the celebration at Birdem auditorium highlighted the limitations of frequent liver transplantation in the country.

Prof Mohammad Ali, chief liver transplant surgeon placed a follow-up report on Kazi Ershad Ahmed, who underwent the liver transplantation on June 3 last year.

A 17-member team conducted the 17 hour-long transplantation surgery.

Kazi Ershad, 42, now in good health and leading a normal life, was present at the celebration.

## 3 killed in Comilla road crash

At least three people were killed and 10 others injured in a head-on collision between a bus and a truck on Dhaka-Chittagong highway near Chandina bus stand in Chandina upazila.

The deceased were identified as Masud Hasan, 28, of Sandwip; Yusuf Ali, 22, of Halihsahar; and the bus driver Md Selim, 33, of Amirabad village of Lohagora upazila of Chittagong.

Police said the accident occurred around 4:00am when a Dhaka-bound bus of Eagle Paribahan collided with the Comilla-bound truck, leaving three bus passengers dead on the spot and 10 others injured.

Of the injured, three were rushed to Comilla Medical College Hospital in critical condition.

Our staff correspondent from Chittagong reports: One was killed and five others injured in separate road accidents.

Four people were injured seriously as a speeding bus rammed into a roadside hotel on the north sideway of 3rd Karnaphuli Bridge in Chittagong yesterday.

The injured were Salim, 32, Sahajahan, 45, Siddique 32 and Sohel 18.
