

# Police intercept bid to bury domestic help secretly

Police intercepted and recovered the body of a teenage domestic help as her employers secretly arranged her burial in Birganj upazila after she succumbed to burn injuries on Wednesday.

The deceased, Shanta Akter, 13, daughter of late Saiful Islam of Bhabki village in Birganj upazila, worked at the house of Md Mofazzal Hossain, a retired general manager of Pubali Bank, and a resident of Mission Road in Dinajpur town.

After the girl got burn injuries on Sunday midnight, her employer secretly took her to Dhaka

for treatment but she died on Wednesday morning, police said.

"Mofazzal's family members brought Shanta's body to Shahidul Islam, a relative of Mofazzal, also a resident of Bhabki village in Birganj upazila, for burial on Wednesday afternoon. Informed by the girl's family members, police rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Dinajpur Medical College and Hospital for autopsy in the evening," said ASI Abdul Motin of Birganj police station.

Mofazzal Hossain's family members claimed that the girl was burnt in the fire originated from a

mosquito coil.

Police, on the other hand, said attempt to bury the body secretly gives rise to the suspicion that someone set fire to the girl.

Meanwhile, neighbours alleged that Shanta was often tortured.

Anisur Rahman, officer in -- charge of Birganj police station, said autopsy report will make clear whether it is an accident or deliberate act of burning.

A team from Dinajpur Kotwali police station inspected Mofazzal's house on Mission Road in Dinajpur town and a UD case was filed with Birganj police station on Wednesday, police said.

# MMCH nurses increase duration of strike

No headway yet in resolving crisis

Nurses at Mymensingh Medical College and Hospital (MMCH) on the second day of their agitation yesterday observed a six-hour strike demanding punishment to culprits who attacked trainee nurses at the hospital on Monday.

Earlier, the nurses observed a four-hour strike on Wednesday.

"We will go for an indefinite strike from June 18 if our demands are not met soon", said a leader of the nurses yesterday.

Our emergency squads are working to look after the critical patients, she said adding that the hospital authorities are yet to take any step to resolve the situation.

At least 35 people were injured as trainee nurses and employees of MMCH locked in a series of clashes on Monday. Among the injured, 30 are students of Mymensingh Nursing College (MNC) and the rest five employees.

Boycotting the classes for the third day yesterday, the trainee nurses brought out a silent procession at MNC campus. The students again vowed to continue their programme until their demands are met.

The demands include removal of the MMCH director, arrest of the fourth class employees involved in the attack and beefing up security for the students.

"We feel insecure as the attackers are moving freely at the hospital", said a student nurse.

Meanwhile the employees of MMCH under the banner of Karmachari Oikya Parishad also brought out a procession at the hospital yesterday morning chanting slogans against the nurses

# 50 fall sick in Manikganj

At least 50 people were food poisoned after taking 'prasad' (sweets and food offered to an idol) of Narayan puja at Koita village in Satura upazila on Wednesday night.

Over 100 villagers joined the puja held at the house of Sukumar Bhoumik. Afterwards food items made of raw milk, wheat, banana, dates and molasses were served at about 6:30pm.

After 8:00pm people started to fall sick. Over 50 people were rushed to Sadar hospital as they started vomiting and feeling abdominal pain.

Dr Rezaul Hossain of the hospital said food poisoning might be the cause of falling sick. Condition of a few patients is serious, he added.

# SIRAJGANJ TENDER CLASH

# 22 BNP men held

Police on Wednesday night arrested 22 BNP activists in connection with clash with AL men at noon over submission of tender documents at Sirajganj municipality.

The arrestees include former district BNP joint convenor and the party's local unit finance secretary. Police arrested them in separate raids in different areas of the city.

The arrestees are-- Mirja Mostafa Zaman, former district BNP joint convenor, Russell Emdad, finance secretary, Chayan Islam, Jinnah, Mirja Rana, Ashrafal Islam, Nur Islam, Hamidul Haq, Yousof, Mridul, Shamim, Joy Kumar, Yousof (2), Arif Hossain, Rubel, Koyel, Alsafa, Rajib, Arif, Abul Kalam and Nazmul.

A mobile court later jailed four of the arrestees.

The convicts are finance secretary Russell Emdad, Chayan Islam, Jinnah and Mirza Rana.

Earlier, at least 50 people were injured in an hour-long clash between the activists of BNP and Awami League (AL) over submission of tender documents at Sirajganj municipality on Wednesday.

Of the wounded, 21 were admitted to different hospitals.

The rival party workers locked in a clash at noon over a tender worth Tk 20 lakh for a earth filling work.

Police said the clash took place on the municipality office premises at about 10 in the morning.

The clash later spread to other areas of the town, forcing police to charge baton on the feuding groups.

A number of shops were ransacked and two motor-bikes damaged during the incident.
