

# Poll official jailed, over 100 hurt in violence

A presiding officer was jailed for violating election code of conduct in Mymensingh while over 100 people were injured in UP poll-related violence in Narsingdi, Munshiganj, Madaripur and Pabna districts yesterday.

Our Mymensingh correspondent reported that a mobile court led by Assistant Commissioner (Land) Lokman Hossain of Muktagachha upazila sentenced the presiding officer of Kandulia Registered Primary School centre in Kumargata Union to three days imprisonment for violating election rules.

Officer-in-Charge (OC) of Muktagachha Police Station Raqibul Haque said police arrested Presiding Officer Abdul Kalam, 45, also the Project Implementation Officer (PIO) of the upazila, on charge of having meal at a house near the polling centre.

He was produced before the mobile court that sent him to jail for violating election code of conduct. Peaceful voting at the centre took place yesterday.

In Narsingdi, the supporters of a chairman-elect and a defeated candidate clashed in Raipura upazila yesterday, leaving at least 50 people from both sides injured.

Of the injured, 10 were admitted to Narsingdi Sadar Hospital while the rest to Nabinagar and Bhairab upazila health complexes.

Witnesses said hundreds of people of Sonakandi, Amirabad, Birgaon and Nilakha supporting chairman-elect Abdul Haq Sarkar

and defeated chairman candidate Ismail Hossain locked in a clash at Nilakha at around 1:00pm, reports UNB.

The clashing groups used spears and sharp weapons and vandalised at least 50 houses. Being informed, police rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control.

Our Munshiganj correspondent reports: At least 20 people were injured in a clash between the supporters of two member candidates near Sambhu Haldarkandi Government Primary School polling centre under Sadar upazila during yesterday's election to Bangla Bazar Union Parishad.

Witnesses said the clash ensued following an altercation between the supporters of the member candidates over seeking votes from the villagers.

In Pabna, post-poll

clashes in sujanagar upazila yesterday left 30 people injured, according to our correspondent.

Of the injured, 15 were admitted to Sujanagar Upazila Health Complex while the rest given first aid. The supporters of defeated candidates Nowab Ali Mondol and Abdul Barik Bablu clashed at Udoypur village in Nazirpur Union, leaving at least 15 people from both sides injured.

At Fakirpur village in Satbaria Union, the supporters of defeated member candidate Md Abdul Kuddus attacked the house of his rival candidate Abdul Baten.

At least 10 people, including Abdul Baten, his wife Monwara Khatun and daughter Shukhi Khatun, were injured in the attack. They are undergoing treatment at Sujnagara Upazila

Health Complex.

The supporters of defeated member candidate Md Rafik Mondol attacked the houses of their rivals at Momrajpur village in the same union, leaving at least 10 people injured.

In Madaripur, At least 10 people were injured in a clash between the supporters of two defeated member candidates in Shashikar Union under Kalkini upazila in the morning.

Shahin Mondal, officer-in-charge of Kalkini Police Station said the incident occurred when the supporters of Mintu Sarker swooped on the workers Bibhuti Bushan, leaving at least 10 people from the both sides injured.

On information, police rushed to the spot, charged batons on the clashing groups and brought the situation under control.

## Court sends bullet-hit Rahima to jail

Rahima Akter, who was bullet-hit during an operation by Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) in Bhairab on June 3, was sent to jail by the court on Monday.

A team of Rab-11, Narayanganj, produced her before a judicial magistrate's court at Kishoreganj on Monday afternoon, bringing her from Dhaka Medical College Hospital where she was undergoing treatment.

Court Sub-inspector Shafiqul Islam Mukul pleaded for showing her arrested in two cases -- one under Narcotics Act and the other for creating hindrance to the performance of gov-

ernment work. Mufakkarul Islam, sub-inspector of Rab-11, filed the cases with Bhairab police station on June 3 night.

After hearing, Judicial Magistrate Muhammad Billal Hossain ordered sending Rahima to jail on Monday evening.

On June 3, Rahima Akter, 40, was shot on the head as a team of Rab-11 went to arrest her at her shanty at Panchabati Pukurpar in Bhairab town, suspecting her to be a narcotic trader.

After the incident, a Rab press release claimed that Rahima was hit by a stray bullet from the weapon of a Rab member when the woman got locked in a tussle with the elite law enforcers.

## Tragic death of medical student in Faridpur

A female student of Faridpur Medical College (FMC) met a tragic death as an end of her long scarf got wrapped around the wheel of the auto rickshaw that was carrying her near Faridpur Medical College Hospital (FMCH) in the town on Monday.

The victim is Rubina Parveen, 20, a second year student of FMC, and daughter of Abdul Haque of Chandpur village under Burichong upazila in Comilla district, college sources said.

"Rubina fainted as the scarf of her neck got wrapped around a wheel of the auto-rickshaw on which we were



going to the college library in the town campus from the medical college hospital," said Rubina's classmate Sabrina Afroj, who was also on the same auto-rickshaw during the incident.

She was immediately admitted to FMCH and later shifted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital where the attending doctor declared her dead at around 8:30pm, Sabrina added.

# Railway platform being used as paddy husking yard!

Barely three months into its renovation, Barokhata railway station platform has turned into a chatal, paddy/maize husking and drying yard, thanks to some influential people of Barokhata village under Hatibandha upazila.

Railway officials concerned are yet to take any measure to stop such activities that have been creating trouble for the passengers.

Used by over 100 passengers everyday, the 250 feet long and 40 feet wide station platform is not maintained by any staff. Only one train stops at the station at 9:00pm and 6:00am.

Yakub Ali, a resident of the village, said "Anybody will be confused whether it is a railway platform or paddy husking ground, after a quick glance at the platform at noon".

Platform is generally used by train passengers and locals for walking or waiting. But Barokhata station platform is under control of three to four local influential people, he added.

Mirza Ali Ahmed, another local, said that the platform is now being used like a personal property. If the authorities concerned did not take measures immediately, the grabbers will wipe out all the symbols of railway

platform.

A local said on condition of anonymity that Ashraf Hossain, Badol Miah, Rahmot Ali and two others of the village are using the platform as chatal. Locals do not dare to protest because of their political link.

The alleged persons however said that the platform is being used by many other locals.

Contacted, Barokhata railway station master 'on

additional duty' Abu Bakkor Siddique said he is the station master of Votmari railway station but he has to carry out duty at Barokhata station too.

"I visit Barokhata station at night and at dawn, as only one train runs on Lalmonirhat-Burimari route and it stops twice a day."

"I do not know anything about the misuse of the platform. Nobody made any allegation in this regard", he

added.

Mostafizar Rahman, Lalmonirhat West Zone Railway Divisional Traffic Superintendent (DTS), however, said the platform remained uncared for due to lack of any staff at the station.

"Within a short time another train will start running on the route. Then Barokhata station will have staff to look after it", he added.

### Baby girl drown

A two-year-old girl drowned in a pond at village Chowbaria in Kaliganj upazila yesterday. The victim was identified as Sathi Parvin, daughter of Shahinur Rahman of the village. Quoting local people police said that Sathi, while playing by the side of the pond near her house, all on a sudden fell in the water and drowned at about 11-30 am. Local people recovered the body from the pond at about 12-30 pm.

### Husband murdered

A man was killed allegedly by his wife over a family feud at Biswapur village in Sadar upazila on Sunday. The deceased was identified as Abdus Sattar, 46, of the village. OC of Sadar PS Raihan Islam, quoting family sources said, Sattar married Reshma, 30, as his second wife five years back. After their marriage, they used to quarrel over flimsy grounds. On Sunday afternoon Reshma locked in a quarrel with Sattar and at one stage kicked him heavily on his scrotum, leaving him dead on the spot.

### Nurse held with Indian passport

Immigration and customs authorities arrested a senior staff nurse of Gopalganj district 250-bed hospital with an Indian passport at Bhomra land port here on Sunday afternoon. The arrestee was identified as Krishna Hira Das 37, daughter of Shashi Bhushan Hira of Chutamanda village of Gopalganj. Immigration officials of Bhomra land port said they, on secret information, arrested Krishna while going to India along with Tk 2 lakh using Indian passport. During interrogation by intelligence officers and immigration authorities Krishna admitted that she has been working as a senior staff nurse at the Gopalganj 250-bed hospital since long. Immigration authorities also said that Krishna went to India using Bangladeshi passport in last May through Benapole and returned home using Indian passport through Bhomra frontier.

### Houses gutted in Tangail

Two dwelling houses were gutted in a fire which broke out at Nagarpur upazila headquarters Sunday noon. Police and fire service sources said the fire originated from an electric short circuit at the house of Akkas Ali near the upazila complex building and soon engulfed the adjacent house. On information, fire fighters with the help of local people doused the fire after an hour of frantic efforts. The affected house owners claimed that the extent of loss from the fire could go up to Tk 3 lakh.

## Death of boy in road crash sparks protest

Death of a schoolboy in a road crash sparked off violence in Bajitpur upazila here yesterday morning.

The deceased was identified as Zamran Mia, 12, student of class VII of Bajitpur Pilot High School and son of Emad Mia of Bahernagar village of the upazila.

Police said the boy died

on the spot as he was hit by a speedy truck near T & T office while going to school at about 11am.

Angered at the incident, local people damaged the truck and blocked the Kishoreganj-Bajitpur highway.

Police later rushed to the spot, brought the situation under control and arrested truck driver Dulal.
