Freedom fighter murdered

UNB, Gazipur
A freedom fighter was strangled by rivals over previous enmity at Kashimpur Dakkhin Panishail village in Sadar upazila Wednesday night. The deceased was identified as Chan Mia, 55, hailed from Kishoreganj district and a resident of Polish Housing. Police said a local gang called Chan Mia, also a land broker, out of his house and took him to a lonely place in the area at around 10:30 pm. Later, they strangled him and left the body there. Local people found the body yesterday morning and informed police. Police recovered the body and sent it to Sadar hospital morgue for autopsy.

Two sued on rape charge

A case was filed with Satkhira Sadar police accusing two people of violating a madrasa student at Baikari village in Sadar upazila on Wednesday. The accused are Shahidul Islam, 32, and Abdul Momin, 33, of Baikari village. The victim filed the case with Sadar PS against the accused under the Women and Children Repression Preventive Act. The complainant alleged that the accused entered her house at about 8:00 am on Tuesday. They took her to a room of the house forcibly and raped her in absence of her parents. While leaving the house, the culprits also threatened to kill her if she disclosed the matter to her parents, she alleged.

SAU students agitate

No classes or examinations could take place at Sylhet Agriculture University (SAU) for the second day yesterday as the students agitated on the campus to press for cancelling the recently announced credit percentage for their promotion. The authorities set 80 per cent credit for promotion while the students are demanding 60 per cent, campus sources said. The students yesterday took out a procession and staged a three-hour sit-in in front of the administration building. They also put the gate of the building under lock and key for some time. The students affairs adviser and others held a meeting with the students in the afternoon. But it ended in failure. The students said they would continue agitation till the demand was met.

Man beaten to death

A man was beaten to death for failing to repay a loan in Janpur area of Sirajganj on Wednesday. The victim was identified as Jahangir Alam, 40, son of Sanaullah Mia of the area. Witnesses said, the victim was severely beaten up by Rana Sheikh and Shamim Ahmed of the same area after he locked in an altercation with tea stall owner Malek over an outstanding bill there. Injured Jahangir died at his father-in-law's house the same day.

Tk 276 cr SCC budget for 2011-12 fiscal

The Sylhet City Corporation (SCC) announced a budget of Tk 275.95 crore for the 2011-2012 financial year on Wednesday.

Mayor Badar Uddin Ahmed Kamran formally placed it at a press conference held at the SCC conference room in the afternoon. No new tax has been imposed on the city dwellers in the new fiscal, he said.

The major heads of income shown in the budget include holding tax-Tk26.71 crore, property hand over fee-Tk 4.5 crore, building construction and reconstruction fee-Tk2.5 crore, business and profession tax-Tk 3 crore, tender schedule sale-Tk 3 crore, water supply charge-Tk 2.8 crore, bus terminal and bus

stand leasing-Tk 80 lakh, business ownership transfer and renewal fee-Tk 50 lakh, ferry ghat (terminal) leasing-Tk 20 lakh, rent of city corporation property-Tk 50 lakh, water connection and reconnection fee-Tk 35 lakh and compensation for road cutting-Tk one crore, water supply charge-Tk 2.8 crore, water connection and reconnection fee-Tk 35 lakh etc.

The major heads of expenditure include, revenue-Tk 21.7 crore, infrastructure development and expansion-Tk 100 crore, water supply project-Tk 35 crore, city ADP projects-Tk 5.6 crore, special fund project-Tk 13 crore, urban primary health care project-Tk 4.95 crore, development of mosques, temple, graveyard, cremation ground etc development-

Tk 2.5 crore, flood rehabilitation project- Tk 2 crore, city corporation building construction Tk5.5 crore, reclamation of the canals and drains-Tk 1 crore, land acquire-Tk 6 crore, setting up of deep tube well-Tk 35 lakh, slum development programme-Tk 10 lakh, road, drain and water supply programme-Tk 1.10 crore, poverty alleviation project-Tk 3 crore.

Addressing the press conference, the mayor assured of taking special measures to resolve the long-standing drainage problem and improve water supply facilities.

Deputy commissioner Abu Syed Mohammad Hashim, Sylhet Metropolitan Police (SMP) commissioner A B Barua and Rab-9 commanding officer Syed Anagh were also present.

Two kids drown in ponds in Moulvibazar, Satkhira

A boy and a girl drowned in ponds in Moulvibazar and Satkhira districts on Wednesday.

Dipos Boidya, 10, son of Bijoy Boidya of Ramkrishna Mission Road drowned in a pond in Moulvibazar district town. The boy was a student of Srinath Government Primary School, reports our correspondent.

During the recess period at school on Wednesday, he played football with his classmates and then went to the nearby municipal office pond with others to have a wash.

All on a sudden Dipos fell in the pond. Hearing hue and cry, schoolteachers and

others recovered Dipos and took him to a local private hospital where the physicians declared him dead.

In Satkhira, a three-year old girl drowned in a pond at village Bhaluka-Chandpur in Sadar upazila on Wednesday, reports our correspondent.

The victim was identified as Sabiha Khatun, 3, daughter of Rajab Ali of the village.

Quoting locals police said, Sabiha, while playing by the side of the pond near her house, all on a sudden fell in the pond and drowned at about 11 in the morning.

Local people recovered the body from the pond at about 12.15pm.

BCL rivals clash in Madaripur again

Ten more injured

At least ten people were injured as two rival groups of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) locked in a fresh clash at Madaripur Government Nazimuddin University College yesterday.

The authorities closed

the institution till June 26 following the clash.

Seriously injured Shovon Sharif, 18, Rezaul Mia, 35 and Badal Bepari, 27 were admitted to Madaripur General Hospital.

Md Kayum Ali Sarder, officer-in-charge (OC) of Sadar police station, said the clash ensued over 'admission trade' at about 12:30pm.

A chase and counter-chase took place during the incident that also saw rival groups attacking each other with locally-made weapons.

On information police went to the spot and brought the situation under control.

Additional police forces have been deployed in the area following the incident, the OC said.

Earlier, ten people were injured in a clash on the campus on Wednesday over the issue.

Man gets life for murder

A court here yesterday sentenced a man to life term imprisonment for killing his brother-in-law.

The convict was identified as Alamgir Mia, 25, son of Farid Mia of Kadma village in Nabiganj upazila.

The court also fined him Tk 5,000, in default, to suffer one year RI more.

According to the prosecution, Alamgir Mia hacked his brother-in-law Shahel Mia, 17, to death on March 9, 2009.
