## Request for Expression of Interests (EOI)

## Services for

Training and Capacity Building on Brick Sector - Stakeholder Institutions Establishment of a Brick Technology and Information Center in Bangladesh  
(Contract Package # DoE-S1)

1. The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received an IDA credit (No.4581-BD) in the amount of US\$ 62.2 million towards the cost of the Clean Air and Sustainable Environment (CASE) Project, a component of which is implemented by the Department of Environment under the Ministry of Environment and Forests, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for the provision of services for the project by hiring an organization/institute/association for Training and Capacity Building on Brick Sector - Establishment of a Brick Technology and Information Center in Bangladesh.

2. The objective of the proposed assignment is to sustain the interest created in VSBKs, HHKs, and other cleaner and more efficient technologies by continuous engagement with interested stakeholders, by raising awareness, by improving necessary technical capabilities, and by facilitating investments in VSBKs, HHKs and other clean technologies. The objective of the assignment will be achieved through identification and capacity development of potential service provider for VSBK in Bangladesh who will be willing to contribute to sustain the efforts. With establishing a Brick Technology and Information Center for various clean technologies such as VSBKs, HHKs Zigzag and other clean brick making technologies will be promoted in Bangladesh.

3. The Brick Technology and Information Center will gradually (initially over a period of one year) develop its capacity to be able to undertake the following three main tasks:

- a) Respond to various queries from already interested stakeholders on the technical, financial, environmental and social aspects of the VSBK, HHK and any other clean technology;

Tentative schedule: Develop and establish this capacity by month 3 of signing this contract and continue providing this service throughout the duration of this contract.

- b) Build awareness and confidence and promote the adoption of cleaner and more efficient technologies;

Tentative schedule: Develop and establish this capacity by month 5 of signing this contract and continue providing this service throughout the duration of this contract.

- c) Explore, initiate and facilitate innovative investment opportunities for these cleaner technologies.

Tentative schedule: Develop this capacity by month 6 of signing this contract and continue providing this service throughout the duration of this contract.

4. The assignment is expected to be carried out over a period of 36 months preferably starting September 2011 and the contract will be initially for a period of 12 months. Subject to a satisfactory evaluation towards the end of this period, the contract could be extended for an additional 24 months.

5. The hosting organization/institute/association should have its own institutional capacity for research and development in technology promotion and improving energy efficiency for brick/ceramic industries. The assignment requires specialized technical input from the hosting organization/institute/association having in-depth experience on cleaner brick making technologies. The hosting organization/institute/association should have preferably demonstrated working experience (both national and international) in different energy efficient brick making technologies.

6. The hosting organization/institute/association are invited to provide information indicating that they are sufficiently qualified to perform the services as elicited above (i.e. brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar operating conditions, availability of appropriate and qualified professionals and staffs etc. experienced in brick production technologies). The EoIs would be reviewed on the basis of the following:

- a) Registration of the lead organization/institute including its associations;

- b) Brochures indicating organization's facilities and areas of skill;

- c) Demonstrated capacity of the organization/institute with documentary evidence to handle such assignment;

- d) Demonstrated experience in similar operating conditions;

- e) Human resources of the organization/institute and its association with appropriate skills and their availability in the course of implementation of the assignment;

- f) Evidence of support services provided by the organization/institute and its association;

- g) Any other criteria related to the assignment to be determined by the Technical Evaluation Committee duly constituted by the government.

7. The organization/institute may associate with other firms, local or foreign, to enhance their qualification, but should mention whether the association is in the form of a "Joint Venture" or of "Sub-Consultancy". In case of a joint venture proposal, all members of such "association" should have real and well-defined inputs to the assignment and it is preferable to limit the total number of firms including the associates to a maximum of two.

8. An organization/institute will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrower*, May 2004 (revised October 2006 and May 2010) following Fixed Budget Selection method.

9. Interested organization/institute may obtain further information (i.e., detailed ToR at the address below from 9:00am to 5:00pm (except holidays). The Expression of Interests must be submitted to the address below by July 21, 2011 before 4:00 pm, in a sealed envelope clearly marked 'Training and Capacity Building on Brick Sector-Establishment of a Brick Technology and Information Center in Bangladesh'. The EoI should be submitted in CD-ROM (pdf version) in addition to the hard copies.

10. Incomplete or partial EoIs will be rejected. The authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the EoIs without assigning any reason thereof.
