

Defeated candidate, his men sever leg of BNP activist

Criminals allegedly led by a ruling Awami League backed defeated union parishad (UP) chairman candidate severed the left leg of a BNP activist and badly stabbed his right leg at Modhupur village of Sarpukur union under Aditmari upazila in Lalmonirhat district on Tuesday night.

The victim, Mozammel Haque, 60, son of late Sadar Uddin of Modhupur village in Sarpukur union under Aditmari upazila, is a retired army man and an executive member of Sarpukur union BNP.

He worked for Monsur Ali, vice president of Aditmari upazila unit of BNP, during the campaign before June 14 UP election, said

Monsur Ali, who won the seat of chairman of Sarpukur UP.

After primary treatment at Lalmonirhat Sadar Hospital, Mozammel was referred to Rangpur Medical College Hospital.

"Mozammel's left leg was severed and most part of the other leg was stabbed. His condition is critical due to serious bleeding. If sufficient blood is not available, it will be difficult to save his life," said Dr Abdul Quader Gani, on duty doctor of the emergency ward.

"Mozammel Haque was attacked allegedly by Awami League supported defeated chairman candidate Azizul Haque Prodhan and his eight to ten men beside Burirjhar bridge at Modhupur village at around 9:30pm on Tuesday night," second officer of Aditmari

police station SI Sobahan Miah quoted the family members as saying.

"My husband told me he identified some attackers including defeated chairman candidate Azizul Haque Prodhan, his son Shimul Islam, younger brothers Shafiqul Islam, Rofiqul Islam and cousin Jamal Uddin," Mozammel's wife Monowara Begum said.

Family members were preparing to file a case accusing eight people including Azizul Haque Prodhan, said injured Mozammel's son Mazharul Anwar.

Contacted, defeated chairman candidate Azizul Haque Prodhan, also the secretary of Aditmari upazila AL, said he or any of his workers were not involved with the attack on Mozammel.

Rail, road blocked demanding vote recount in Gaibandha

Supporters of a defeated chairman candidate yesterday joined a rail-road blockade programme in Sunderganj upazila of Gaibandha demanding recounting of votes cast in Sarbananda Union Parishad election on June 8.

Braving downpour, several thousand people of the union put up barricades on rail racks at Bamondanga Station and Bamondanga-Rangpur Road, disrupting rail and road traffic for six hours from 6:00am, reports our correspondent.

The agitating supporters of chairman candidate Mujibur Rahman Sarker also held rallies at the railway station and on the road rail to press for the demand. They alleged that the chairman-elect with the connivance of the election officials manipulated the election results and snatched the victory of their candidate.

They urged the authorities concerned to arrange

recounting of votes at all centres of the Sarbananda Union as early as possible. Otherwise, they threatened to launch a tougher agitation programme in the upazila.

According to our Kishoreganj correspondent, post-poll clashes in Itna upazila of Kishoreganj

district left at least 22 people injured yesterday.

Police and local people said the supporters of chairman-elect Omar Faruq of Itna Union Parishad and defeated chairman candidate Noor Mia locked in a clash at Itna Bazar in the morning, leaving 10 people from both sides injured, reports our correspondent.

Locals said the clash ensued following an alteration between the supporters of Omar Faruq and Noor Mia over the election in the union held on Tuesday. Some shops were vandalised at the bazaar during the clash that continued for half an hour.

Seven of the injured are undergoing treatment at Itna Upazila Health Complex while the rest received first aid at the hospital.

Meanwhile, a mobile court on Tuesday fined six

Police rushed to the spot, dispersed the clashing groups and brought the situation under control. Of the injured, Fazlu Mia, 60, Nargis Akhter, 25, Jumela Khatun, 45, and Abdul Hye, 60, were admitted to the local health complex while the rest given first aid.

At Purbagram village in the same union, the supporters of member-elect Hazrat Mia clashed with defeated member candidate Chan Mia's men at the village at noon. Villagers said both sides used lethal weapons during the clash, leaving at least 12 people injured.

Being informed, law enforcers from Itna Police Station rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control.

Expat killed allegedly by wife

A Dubai expatriate was murdered at his father-in-law's house allegedly by wife at Bhabki village in Muktagachha upazila early Tuesday.

Victim Helal Uddin, 35, was son of Ahmed Ali of Nandibari village in the upazila. Helal was in Dubai for more than three years.

Police said, Hafiza Khatun, 25, wife of Helal, a mother of two children, allegedly developed an illicit relationship with a local young man during Helal's stay in Dubai.

Being informed, police rushed to the spot and recovered the body at around 8:30 am yesterday.

Hafiza was handed over to police but her lover fled the scene.

Police sent the body of Helal to Mymensingh Medical College and Hospital morgue (MMCH) for autopsy.
