Hartal, processions in Brahmanbaria

A half-day hartal was observed in the district town and Sarail upazila headquarters yesterday protesting a reported move by the authorities concerned to merge Titas Gas Transmission and Distribution Company with Bakharabad Gas System Company.

Vehicles were off the roads while shops, business establishments, private offices and educational institutions in the town remained closed during the hartal called by Brahmanbaria Zila Nagorik Committee.

Several processions were

brought out in the town during hartal hours, No untoward incidents occurred.

Addressing a rally in the town, Nagorik Committee President Advocate Abdus Samad said the authorities concerned are trying to place Titas Gas Transmission and Distribution Company in Brahmanbaria under the administration of Bakharabad Gas System Company in Comilla.

He urged the authorities concerned not to change the name of Titas Gas Transmission and Distribution Company. He said the people of Brahmanbaria will go for a tougher agitation if the name is changed.

53 Indian nationals released from Satkhira Jail

At least 53 Indian nationals, held from different districts on various charges, including smuggling and trespass were released from Satkhira Jail yesterday after court ruling.

Jail sources said they were released at 1:30pm after a Satkhira court granted bail to them ordering their immediate release.

Satkhira Jail Superintendent Nurannabi Bhuiyan said they freed the Indians following court order after the hearing on a C R case filed recently with

the district court challenging their detention and seeking bail for them.

The Indian nationals were held 11-12 years ago by police, BGB and Coast Guard from different areas of Cox's Bazar, Chittagong, Khagrachhari, Meherpur, Chuadanga, Satkhira and Jessore districts on charges of smuggling, intrusion and their involvement with various criminal activities.

Most of them were sentenced to different terms of imprisonment, ranging from 3 months to one year in separate judgments delivered by different

courts. Their trial was held in connection with separate cases lodged with different courts and police stations across the country after their arrest between 1999 and 2000.

Jail Superintendent Nurannabi said they spent 7-8 more years in prison after expiry of their jail terms as they could not be released due to legal complexities.

They left for India immediately after their release. Authorities provided each of them Tk 50 to meet their expenses on the way to different destinations in India.

3 housewives murdered allegedly by husbands

Three housewives were murdered allegedly by their husbands in Gaibandha, Pabna and Sirajganj districts on Tuesday and Wednesday.

A housewife was tortured to death allegedly by her husband at Bhangamore village in Sadullapur upazila of Gaibandha on Tuesday night, reports our correspondent.

Police said Ziaur Rahman, 32, used to beat his wife Golenur Begum, 27, when he returned home deep at night after losing money in gambling.

On Tuesday, the accused came home at night and started beating Golenur mercilessly.

At a stage, the woman succumbed to injuries.

Police said there were

several injury marks in the body of the victim.

In Pabna, a pregnant housewife was beaten and strangled allegedly by her husband and his friend at Bhato-Miapur village in Santhia upazila on Tuesday, reports our correspondent.

Victim Kuti Buri, 22, was wife of Al-Amin of the village. Police quoting the family members said, Kuti Buri was murdered by Al-Amin and his friend following an altercation over payment of Tk 50 thousand dowry.

Later, the two culprits dumped the body under water-hyacinth of a pond beside their residence.

The victim's family suspects that Al-Amin and his friend Mukul killed Kuti Buri along with other family members of Al-Amin.

Police arrested Mukul

and the mother of Al Amin but main accused Al-Amin went into hiding.

In Sirajganj, a housewife was killed allegedly by her husband over family dispute in Chhayadhan Para area in the municipality Wednesday morning.

The deceased was identified as Subarna Begum, 25, wife of Faruk Hossain, a resident of the area, reports UNB.

Locals said, Faruk engaged in an altercation with Subarna over a family matter and at one stage hit her with a wooden stick in the head, leaving her dead on the spot.

Subarna's family members alleged that Faruk killed her for dowry. A case was filed with Sirajganj Sadar police station.

JCD men assault Rajshahi Govt College principal, vice principal

Activists of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) assaulted the principal and vice-principal of Rajshahi Government College on the campus on Wednesday night.

Third year resident students of the female hostel, who have been agitating since Tuesday demanding cancellation of session fee, confined hostel superintendent Ashraf Ali to his office room in the evening.

Hearing the news, Principal Ali Reza M Abdul Majid and Vice-Principal Habibur Rahman along with some BCL leaders went to the hostel at around 8:00pm.

presence of BCL leaders at the female hostel enraged the resident students. They kept the principal, vice principal and BCL leaders confined to the office room for an hour.

In the meantime, JCD activists gathered on the road in front of the female hostel and started chanting slogans against BCL intrusion into the dormitory.

As the principal and the vice-principal came out of the hostel at around 9:30pm, the JCD men swooped on them, alleging that the two are patronising the BCL. The JCD activists also chased the BCL leaders who later came

Abducted girl rescued

An abducted college student was rescued by police from a house at Laxmanpur village in Sharsha upazila of Jessore early yesterday.

The victim is daughter of Md Moslem Ali Sardar of Kushodanga village in Kalaroa upazila of Satkhira district.

Police said, acting on a tip-off, they raided the house at Laxmanpur and rescued the girl at about 4:00 am yesterday.

During the raid, the abductors managed to flee sensing presence of police, police said.

The girl, a second year HSC student at Kazirhat College said one Abul Kalam and others used to stalk her on her way to college off and on for the last three months.

On June 27, while she was going to college to attend coaching classes, the accused along with his accomplices abducted her from near the college.

They took her to Laxmanpur village and confined her in a room, she said.

Being informed, police rushed to the spot and rescued the principal and vice-principal. Vice-Principal Rahman received injury in the nose and was given first aid at a clinic.
