# Indian PM convenes all-party meeting

Says bill to work within constitutional framework

PTI, New Delhi

Affirming government's commitment to enact Lokpal Act that will provide for a strong and effective way to tackle corruption in high places, Prime Minister Manmohan Singh yesterday said such an institution will have to work within the framework of Constitution.

He told the all-party meeting on Lokpal Bill that strong

laws to tackle corruption were necessary but these would not suffice as there was a need to focus on "simplifying procedures, reducing discretion, eliminating arbitrariness and increasing transparency in the way government functions."

Singh noted that there was a feeling that institutional arrangements in place are not strong enough to ensure that the guilty, especially those occupying high positions, are brought to book swiftly and given deterrent punishment.

"I must make it clear at the outset that we, in government, are committed to the enactment of a Lokpal Act, which provides for a strong, effective and quick institutional arrangement

Constitution provides for an "intricate system of checks and balances", he said the new institution of Lokpal has to find an appropriate place in that matrix."

Singh's comments assume significance as the Anna Hazare team has been pushing for bringing all institutions, including the Prime Minister and higher judiciary, under the purview of Lokpal. The government sees this as an attempt to create a structure parallel to the government.

Singh said the government was "focussed on this process and we propose to pursue this with vigour and speed."

The enactment of a strong Lokpal Bill has attracted a lot of attention during the past few months, he said and referred to setting up of a joint drafting committee consisting of five Union ministers and five nominees of Hazare including he himself.




