### 3 Shibir activists held

Police yesterday arrested three activists of Chhatra Shibir on charge of attempting to create chaos at Chapainawabganj Government College. Sources said, Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) yesterday morning brought out a procession on the campus welcoming the freshers. Meanwhile, the three activists went to the campus and tried to disrupt BCL programme. On information, police rushed in and brought the situation under control. Police arrested former general secretary of district unit Shibir Zubair Rahman, 32, and two Shibir workers--Kamal Uddin, 22, and Selim Reza, 22,--from the spot.

### Grocer kidnapped

A grocer was kidnapped by criminals at Sorojanj Bazar in Sadar upazila of Chuadanga Saturday night. Victim Faruk Hossain, 25, a resident of Shambhunagar village, is son of Kalob Ali of Sorojanj. Police said Faruk was abducted while returning home after closing their shop at the bazaar at 10:00pm. The abductors demanded Tk 2 lakh from Faruk's family, they said. The victim could not be rescued till yesterday afternoon.

### JMB suspect arrested

Headmaster of a government primary school Abdul Munnaf, 37, was arrested on Saturday from a house in Wapda area of Faridganj on suspicion of his link with banned Islamist outfit Jama'atul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB). Officer-in-charge (OC) of Faridganj police station Md Jabelul Islam said that the arrestee was threatening government officials over cell phone claiming himself a member of JMB.

### Housewife killed for dowry

A housewife was killed allegedly by her husband for dowry at Jaduarchar village in Shibchar upazila on Thursday. The victim was identified as Happy Akter, 20, daughter of Mohan Miah of Sanyasirchar village in the upazila. Police said Happy got married with Almas Miah, 26, of Jaduarchar village three months ago and since then he used to torture Happy for dowry. Almas beat her up mercilessly on the fateful day following an altercation over the issue. Seriously injured, she was admitted to Shibchar health complex where she succumbed to her injuries. Police arrested Almas in this connection.

## Killers of Sylhet expat Tahir still at large

Police could not arrest any killer of expatriate Sheikh Tahir Ali, seven days into the murder as they are playing the role of silent spectators, family members alleged yesterday.

Sheikh Tahir's son Sheikh Abul Basher told newsmen at a press conference at Biswanath upazila headquarters that before the incident they met lawmaker Sha fi q u r R a h m a n Chowdhury as they had disputes with some others over some landed property.

The lawmaker referred the matter to the upazila AL general secretary Babul Akhtar, but to no effect, he said.

Besides, just a day after the complaint was lodged with the lawmaker, Tahir's rivals started construction of

pucca wall on the said disputed land, the victim's son alleged.

Then Sheikh Tahir also met Babul who failed to give any satisfactory reply. The rivals that time attempted to attack Tahir, the family members alleged.

As a sequel to that, an armed gang attacked our house on 23 June night and chopped my father to death while my brother was seriously hurt and admitted to hospital, Basher said.

They beat up all the members of the house mercilessly and looted gold ornament, cash and other valuables. While leaving the house, the gang threatened my mother not to disclose their names. Otherwise, they would attack again, alleged Tahir's son.

On the following day, lawmaker Sha fi q u e visited our house and assured us of

arresting the killers within 24 hours.

But so far nothing has been done in more than a week after the incident. Rather the killers are now asking me to withdraw the case over telephone, Basher alleged.

Sheikh Basher said that a gang of 10 to 15 attacked their house and looted valuables worth over Taka one crore and chopped his father to death.

Wife and other children of the victim were present at the press conference.

Meanwhile, a procession was brought out at Biswanath upazila headquarters on Saturday to protest the killing of expatriate Sheikh Tahir.

UK expat septuagenarian Sheikh Tahir returned to his Biswanath house a few months ago.

## UPDF stages procession, rally

Leaders of anti-peace accord United People's Democratic Front (UPDF) yesterday brought out a procession in the town and held a protest rally at Kutukchhari Bazar.

Criticising the government for terming the indigenous people as Bangali, they said an indigenous man cannot be a Bangali which is also applicable for a Bangla speaking person.

The government has betrayed with the 'jummo people' through passing the

15th amendment bill, they said.

They termed the government move as undemocratic, communal and fundamentalist.

The indigenous people will never accept it. The government must pay for its wrong decision, they warned.

All the indigenous communities have their own distinct culture, tradition and customs. Every indigenous community has separate identity and different caste, the leaders said.

Slatting the role of MPs, including Dipankar

Talukder, Bir Bahadur Ushoi Sing, Jatindra Lal Tripura, and Promod Mankin, they said that all of them failed to bring any positive change to the hills.

Rather, they are making the situation complicated and working against the interest of jummo people, they alleged.

Alokesh Chakma, coordinator of UPDF Rangamati unit, Bablu Chakma, UP member Kajoli Tripura, Kutukchhari UP chairman Prava Ranjan Chakma and Sapchhari UP chairman Shimul Bikash Chakma spoke at the rally.

## Robbers hijack another goods laden truck

Highway robbers killed the helper of a fertiliser-laden truck badly wounded driver and took away the truck at Majheera in Bogra district early yesterday.

Earlier, a rice-laden truck from Naogaon was looted from Tongi on Friday night raising the number of hijacked rice trucks to 15 and killing of truckers to 5 during the last one month.

Police said, the truck with

350 sacks of urea from Bhairab Fertiliser Factory was going to Bogra on Saturday night.

On the way, 4-5 armed robbers intercepted the truck at Majheera at about 2:30am.

They held driver Sabuj and helper Masud at gunpoint, tied their hands and legs, gagged mouth with scotch tape and locked them in the cabin of the truck.

The robbers then drove the truck to Natore where

the fertiliser was unloaded at a private godown.

Later, they drove the empty truck through Nagarbari-Bogra highway and left it near Brammakopalia Bridge in Ullahpara upazila.

In the morning, Ullahpara police found Masud dead and rescued driver Sabuj in semi-conscious state from the truck.

Both Masud and Sabuj hailed from Birkedara village of Kahalu upazila in Bogra district.

## Invitation for Expression of Interest (EOI) for Project Management, Design and Supervision Consultancy (PMDSC) Services for South Asia Tourism Infrastructure Development Project-SATIDP (Bangladesh Portion)

- Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh (GOB) has received a loan 2580-BAN(SF) from Special Funds resources of the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of South Asia Tourism Infrastructure Development Project-SATIDP (Bangladesh Portion), and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this loan to eligible payments under the consultancy services for which this invitation for Expression of Interest (EOI) is issued. This consultancy services will be jointly financed by ADB and GOB. The terms and conditions of the contract and payments by ADB will be subject to the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement, including the "Guidelines on the Use of Consultants by Asian Development Bank and Its Borrowers". Except as ADB may specifically otherwise agree, no party other than GOB shall derive any right from the loan or have any claim to the proceeds of the loan.
- The project aims at developing and improving tourism-related infrastructure in Bangladesh. The main objectives of the project are to: i) improve access, destination infrastructure and services in nature and culture-based key tourism sites located along a heritage-rich geographic corridor extending from north to the south in the western regions of Bangladesh; ii) build the capacities of sector agencies for sustainable protection and management (including organizational and financial) of natural and cultural heritage sites as well as tourism-related infrastructure and assets, tourism planning, coordination, monitoring and marketing; and iii) strengthen linkages between tourism and local population, and build the capacity of communities to enable them to obtain greater benefits from tourism.
- Being selected as the Executive Agency (EA) for the project, Department of Archaeology (DOA) under the Ministry of Cultural Affairs (MOCA) in project eligible consulting firms who have adequate (preferably five years) experience in project management, design and supervision activities to submit Expressions of Interest (EOI) for providing Project Management, Design and Supervision Consultancy (PMDSC) Services for "South Asia Tourism Infrastructure Development Project (SATIDP) (Bangladesh Portion)."
- The PMDSC package will involve anticipated 25 person months of international experts and 183 person months for national experts as key professionals. The firm will be selected through international competitive bidding following quality-and cost-based selection (QCBS) procedures in accordance with ADB's Guidelines on the Use of Consultants (April 2010 or as amended from time to time). The duration of consulting services contract is expected to be about 30 months commencing tentatively from the end of March 2012.
- The PMDSC under the project will assist the Project Management and Implementation Unit (PMIU), to be based within the Department of Archaeology, Ministry of Cultural Affairs, in managing detailed design, supervision, monitoring of the project including the capacity development activities. The community tourism specialist and the marketing and promotion specialist will work with the Bangladesh Parjatan Corporation (BPC) under the guidance of the project management specialist. In addition, the scope of consultancy services will also include, but not limited to, the following:  
i) A team of experts will assist the PMIU in setting up of the project management and monitoring systems; and assisting Project Site Offices in the field and the Project Implementation Unit in BPC in managing and monitoring of the overall project progress and reporting.  
ii) The experts in project management, monitoring procurement, and financial management will provide support to define detailed program and work plans; procedures for coordination, overall management, and financial management; and project accounting, project performance monitoring system, and reporting; and design, installation and operationalization of new systems as required. iii) The PMDSC will also assist the unit in BPC in "community participation and livelihood generation" and "marketing and promotion" activities. Moreover, PMDSC will assist the PMIU in the implementation of the Sustainable Heritage and Tourism Action Plan.
- The PMDSC firm is expected to have expertise in participatory and contemporary training methodologies and approaches; sound knowledge of government policies, administrative systems and procedures; and expertise in design and supervision for improvement of cultural heritage sites. The consultant will be required to make own arrangements under the consultant's contract for appropriate English/Bangla translation and interpretation service that may be required.
- EOIs may be submitted by a firm, association, or joint venture (JV). An international firm, as a lead firm, associate or partner can only be nominated in one EOI. A national firm as a lead firm can only be nominated in one EOI. A national firm as an associate or partner can be nominated in more than one EOI. To avoid confusion and possible elimination after short-listing, lead firms of associations or joint ventures are strongly advised to confirm relationships (exclusive or non-exclusive) with selected associates or partners prior to expressing interest.
