500 FAMILIES HOMELESS IN GAIBANDHA Villagers join hands to thwart erosion

Erosion by river Jamuna in the last one week devoured scores of homesteads and other establishments and a vast tract of croplands in Kamarpara and Baushir villages in Fulchhari upazila rendering over 500 families shelterless.

As there was no initiative by local water development board (WDB) to stop erosion, people of the two villages themselves built bamboo spar and dumped sand bags voluntarily along the erosion point.

Many of them spontaneously supplied bamboo and empty bags while others offered physical labour to thwart erosion, said Gazaria UP member Shakawat Hossain Manu.

According to WDB, water level of the Jamuna is on steady increase at Fulchhari point following heavy downpour and

onrush of water from upstream. The water level might cross danger mark any time, they said.

The most erosion-affected villages are Ratanpur, Kalasana Char, Singria, Kanchipara, Syedpur, Balashi, Kauabadha, harichandi, Alger Char, Kamarpara, Baushi, Namapara and Katlamari.

Erosion has already devoured a large chunk of Eidgah ground while threatening a degree college, a senior madrasa, Baushi primary school, temples and mosques in two villages.

Local said, newly elected chairman of Gazaria union Manotosh Roy Mintu asked villagers to join the work to protect their area from erosion on self-help basis.

Responding to the call, hundreds came forward with all possible help to

build bamboo spar along the erosion point, they said.

"First we started work along the 500-foot erosion affected area at Baushi village piling bamboos and dumping sand bags. The work will continue and it will be done in other areas in phases", said Aysha Shiekh, woman member-elect of Gazaria union.

In the last one week, local people set up the spar with more than 4,000 pieces of bamboos and dumped over 6 000 sand bags in the affected areas.

We are getting spontaneous response from common people and they are helping as per their capacity, said chairman Manotosh Roy.

Contacted, executive engineer of Gaibandha WDB told this correspondent that at present they cannot go for erosion control in those areas, because of lack of any scheme and fund constraint.

However, we shall submit a proposal for emergency erosion protection work to the higher authorities soon, he said.

LALMONIRHAT, BOGRA Two schoolgirls raped, culprits on the run

Two school kids were raped in Lalmonirhat and Bogra districts on Friday.

A 7-year-old girl was violated at Karnapur Mandoltari village of Lalmonirhat union under Lalmonirhat Sadar upazila on Friday night, reports our correspondent.

Accused Majibar Rahman, 35, is son of late Mansur Mollah of Baparitari village under the same union.

Daughter of rickshaw puller Rafiqul Islam of Karnapur Mandoltari village, the victim is a student of class-I at Mogolhat Government Primary School.

Police said, Majibar gagged the schoolgirl with a piece of cloth and forcibly took her to a bamboo cluster around 8:00 pm and raped her.

Hearing screams, locals rescued the schoolgirl but the rapist fled the scene immediately.

Critically injured, the girl

is now being treated at Lalmonirhat Sadar Hospital.

A rape case was lodged accusing Majibar Rahman with Lalmonirhat Sadar PS on Friday night.

In Bogra, a 12-year-old girl was violated by a vendor in Sultanganjpara area of the district town on Friday, reports UNB.

Police quoting locals said, the girl came to visit the house of her neighbour Gafur at about 12:00 noon. Gafur, in absence of his family members, violated the girl.

Hearing the shrill cry of the victim, local people rescued her in profusely bleeding condition and rushed her to Bogra Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College and Hospital where her condition was stated to be critical.

After the incident, the culprit went into hiding. Angered by the rape incident, local people later set afire the house of Gafur.

RU founding anniversary

Rajshahi University (RU) will celebrate its 58th founding anniversary today.

To mark the day, the university authorities have chalked out colourful programmes on the campus.

The RU anniversary will be celebrated today instead of the university's actual founding day as the Opposition called hartal on July 6.

Different cultural organisations and theatre groups will hold cultural show and street drama on the day at Central Shaheed Minar and Old Folklore premises.

Couple, 2 women commit 'suicide'

A couple allegedly committed suicide in Mymensingh while two women killed themselves in separate places of Pabna on Saturday.

Nazim Uddin, 45, a farmer and his wife Hasina Akhtar, 35, of Kamat village in Kachina union of Bhaluka in Mymensingh allegedly committed suicide on Saturday, reports our correspondent.

Police said, the couple committed suicide by hanging themselves from the ceiling of their house following a feud over family affairs. They had two sons- Abdul Hannan, 20, and Harunur Rashid, 18.

Family sources said, Nazim Uddin, son of late Abdul Gani was slightly lunatic and the couple used to lock in altercation over family matters.

Following an altercation on Saturday night, Hasina might have committed suicide first while Nazim Uddin followed her, said Narendra Nath Sarker, offi-

cer-in-charge (OC) of Bhaluka police station.

In Pabna, two women allegedly committed suicide in separate places of Iswardi upazila on Saturday, reports our correspondent.

Sources said Merina Khatun, 30, wife of Idris Ali, committed suicide by hanging herself at Masuriapara in the upazila headquarter following a family feud.

Family sources said Idris had enmity with his brother Anis and Idris was sent to jail recently in a case filed by Anis.

Idris's wife requested Anis to withdraw the case. Refused by Anis, Merina allegedly killed herself.

In another incident, Najmunnahar Begum, 48, of Dhulti-Boharpur area of the upazila became seriously shocked following the death of her only son in road mishap last year. She took several attempts to commit suicide since then.

On Saturday, she took poison and fell seriously sick. She died after admission at Iswardi Hospital.

Three youths jailed for stalking

Mobile courts in Dinajpur and Patuakhali on Saturday sentenced three youths to jail for stalking school and madrasa students.

A mobile court in Dinajpur sentenced a truck driver to one-month jail for stalking a schoolgirl in Birampur upazila on Saturday morning.

Convict Azim Babu, 20, is son of Motiar Rahman of Collegepara area under Birampur town, reports our correspondent.

Police said, a mobile court led by Md Shawkat Osman, assistant commissioner of land of Birampur upazila caught Babu on Saturday morning following a complaint from the parents of the schoolgirl and sentenced him to jail for one month.

In Patuakhali, two stalkers were jailed by a mobile court on Saturday night, reports

our correspondent.

Md Zakir Hossain, UNO of Patuakhali Sadar upazila, also executive magistrate delivered the judgment on the spot.

The convicts are Al Amin alias Rasel, 18, of Sabujbagh area and Rafiqul Islam Murad, 19, of Jainkathi area in the town.

Police said, both the boys used to sexually harass a female student of class eight at Kourakhali Dakhil Madrasa under Jainkathi union in Sadar upazila. Recently, Rasel made a proposal which was turned down by the girl. On Saturday evening, they went to the house of the girl and tried to call her out.

The villagers besieged them and caught them with sharp weapon.

Later, they informed police at Patuakhali police station and the mobile court handed down the punishment.
