## Border haats trade hopes

Dhaka, Delhi start open trading on no-man's land

Top-level officials of India and Bangladesh yesterday inaugurated the first-ever official border haat on the noman's land here in efforts to bring economic benefits to the people of the area.

The inauguration comes nine months after the neighbouring countries signed agreements to set up two borderhaats.
