Erosion of Sirajganj dyke thwarted

Further erosion by the river Jamuna at Hard Point of Sirajganj town protection embankment has been thwarted by throwing huge number of concrete blocks and sand bags in the breached portion.

Executive Engineer of Sirajganj Water Development Board (WDB) Abdul Malek said that the erosion is now under control and a four-member committee headed by the WDB chief engineer has started investigation into the embankment collapse.

The turbulent Jamuna devoured about 70metre of the town protection embankment at hard point on July 18 and another 105-metre on July 21.

While visiting the breached portion at the hard point of Sirajganj town protection embankment yesterday, Water Resources Minister Ramesh Chandra Sen said the two affected spots will be repaired at any cost.

Steps have already been taken to prevent breach in other parts of the hard point, the minister said, adding that capital dredging in

the river at Sirajganj point will be started soon.

Built in 1997 by a South Korean company with a 100 years' guarantee, parts of the town protection embankment collapsed on July 19 in 2010 and twice in 2009. Locals brought allegation against the authorities concerned of misappropriation in the repair of the dyke. WDB sources said 24,000 blocks and 26,000

sand bags have so far been thrown in the breached portion of the embankment at hard point. BNP lawmaker from Sirajganj-2 constitu-

ency Rumana Ahmed also visited the erosion-hit area yesterday morning. She blamed the authorities concerned for not taking effective steps to save the hard point.

Water level in the Jamuna at Sirajganj point marked a further rise and was flowing above the danger level yesterday.

At least 40 illegal structures were demolished around Hili land port in Hakimpur upazila on Friday to resolve water logging problem in the port area during the rainy season.

Deputy commissioner's (DC) office with the help of Hakimpur municipality launched the drive led by Md Tofazzal Hossain, executive magistrate, also UNO of Hakimpur upazila, in the morning.

Sources said that the DC office so far identified 125 establishments encroaching upon land on both sides of four-km road stretching from Zeroline to Hili port area.

The situation greatly hampers the trade through the Hili port, he pointed out.

A meeting at Dinajpur deputy commissioner's office held on July 19 headed by DC Jamal Uddin Ahmed, decided to remove the illegal structures on the 4km road to resolve the water logging problem.

The drive will continue for three more days, said Tofazzal Hossain.

Earlier the deputy commissioner's office issued notice to the encroachers to remove their establishments but to no effect.

Headmistress beaten up for TR fund 'share'

Criminals yesterday beat up the headmaster of Udoypur Registered Primary School in Sujanagar upazila under the district for declining to give them 'share' of the Test Relief (TR) fund allocated for development of the school.

With serious injuries, Hasina Begum, the victim, is undergoing treatment at the upazila health complex.

Identity of the criminals could not be ascertained immediately but a teacher on condition of anonymity said they are backed by local influential people.

"Three to four criminals

attacked me on the school premises at about 3:00pm today as I declined to meet their demand for giving them Tk 10 thousand from the Tk 32 thousand allocated under the TR fund for development work in the school," the headmistress told this correspondent when he visited her at the health

complex yesterday. "After receiving the fund, I engaged workers for earth work. I also took initiative for repair work and buying benches for the students. But a few local criminals demanded Tk 10 thousand from me over cell phone two days ago. At about 3:00pm

today, they entered the school and again demanded the money. As I declined, they started beating me with sticks and iron rods," she

Hearing her scream, locals rushed to the spot, rescued her and took her to Sujanagar upazila health complex, Hasina Begum said, adding that the matter was brought to the knowledge of the upazila education officials and the police.

"Police visited the spot. I asked the victim to file a case. Action will be taken against the criminals after getting the case," said officer in charge of Sujanagar police station Md Ahsanul Haque.

A housewife was electrocuted and three linemen of Palli Bidyut Samity (PBS) were injured at Paschim Bahali Para village in Sadar upazila on Friday night.

The housewife was electrocuted as she went to make the power switch of her house on at the time of blast.

The injured were admitted to Sadar Hospital.

The district administration has set up CC TVs at three points in Panchagarh town to resist stalking and sexual harassment.

Panchagarh Deputy Commissioner (DC) Md Tofazzol Hossain formally inaugurated the programme at a function at the conference room of his office on Wednesday.

"To resist the social menace of stalking, we have initially set up three CC TV surveillance system at different places to monitor the matter efficiently. Whenever such an incident will be seen on the monitor of CC TV police team with an executive magistrate will be sent to the spot," the DC said.

Within a short time several CC TVs will be set up at some other important places in the town that are regularly used by the school and college going girls, he "It is possible to effec-

tively check stalking as well as other crimes with the help of modern technology. The surveillance system has already been appreciated as a cost effective crime prevention device in the developed countries," the official added.

Officials of district and police administration, journalists, teachers and other professionals were present at the programme.

Recently the incidents of stalking and sexual harassment have increased in the town, locals said.

The Field School are expected to develop into Farmers' Organizations (Community-based Organizations), which develop strong links to the government and non-government service providers and the private sector input supply and marketing institutions. The Union Parishads are expected to have an important role in the Component through protection of the rights of the hardcore poor Component beneficiaries and through support to the CBOs, notably through allocation of an annual block grant.
