

DEATH OF PATIENT

Owner of Pabna clinic arrested

Police have arrested the owner of Seba Clinic in Chatmohar upazila following death of a pregnant woman at the clinic on Wednesday morning due to alleged wrong treatment by the doctors.

After filing of a case with Chatmohar Police Station at around 11:00am on Wednesday, police arrested clinic owner Md Amir Hossain Bablu in the evening. Two other accused in the case—Dr Doli Rani and anaesthetist Dr Bibhuti Sarkar—have been absconding since the incident.

Irene Khatun, 25, wife of Zakim Uddin of Dhulauri village in Chatmohar upazila of the district, was admitted to Seba Clinic at around 6:30 am on Wednesday. She died at the operation theatre during her caesarean at around 9:00am.

Family sources alleged that Irene died due to alleged wrong treatment by the doctors. Irene's brother Md Mizanur Rahman filed a case against clinic owner Md

Amir Hossain Bablu and two doctors Doli Rani of Boraigram Health Complex in Natore and anaesthetist Dr Bibhuti Sarkar of Jonail union health center in Chatmohar upazila. Police said both were hired by the clinic owners.

District health department sealed the operation theater of the clinic on Wednesday night and formed a two-member inquiry committee yesterday.

Chatmohar Municipality authorities yesterday took a decision to cancel the trade licence of the clinic.

The officer-in-charge of Chatmohar Police Station quoted the victim's family as saying that she was not properly examined by the doctors before caesarean section. "We have recorded the case and trying to nab the doctors accused in the case," the OC said.

At least five patients died at the clinic in a year. There is no permanent doctor at the clinic, said Md H Islam Hira, mayor of Chatmohar Municipality.

4 get life for throwing acid in Habiganj

A court in Habiganj yesterday sentenced four people to life term imprisonment for throwing acid on a young girl at village Kaitgaon of Bahubal upazila in 2006.

District and Sessions Judge, Habiganj Md. Mahbub ul-Haque also fined each of the convicts Tk 50,000, in default, to suffer one year more in jail. The convicts are Abdul Quaiyum, 26, Haris Miah, 22, Auli Miah, 20, and Alkas Uddin, 35. However, besides Haris, the others are at large.

According to the prosecution of the case in brief, failing to satisfy their evil desire, the accused broke into the house of Abdur Rahman and hurled acid on his daughter Mayarunnesa, 18, in the night following 23

February of 2006.

Mayarunnesa's mother Begum Bibi sustained injuries as she tried to save her daughter. She was later treated at Habiganj Sadar Hospital.

Abdur Rahman filed a case with the Habiganj cognizance court accusing the aforesaid four people.

In Netrakona, a man was sentenced to 10 years rigorous imprisonment in an arms case on Wednesday.

The convict was identified as Chan Mia, 46, of village Telachi in Durgapur upazila of the district, reports UNB.

According to the prosecution, on secret information, a team of Rab-9 raided the house of Chan Mia and recovered a revolver from his bedroom on May 10 in 2008.

Girl's body recovered from septic tank

Sundarganj police yesterday recovered the decomposed body of an eight-year-old girl from a septic tank of Dharmapur Abdul Jobber Degree College.

Police said the college reopened yesterday after Eid vacation. The students attending classes smelt bad odour near the toilet.

After opening the cover of septic tank they found the body of a girl child.

The hapless girl was later identified as Fency Begum, 8, daughter of Feroz Mia of village Kalir Khamar.

Family sources said that girl was supposed to visit her grandfather's home adjacent to Dhamapur bazar on the occasion of Eid festival. Prior to Eid day she went to the nearby union parishad area to see the distribution of rice under VGF card. Since then she went missing and never returned home. Relatives continued to search for her but failed to locate her whereabouts.

Police suspect that criminals might have killed her after rape and dumped the body inside septic tank. There were several marks of injury on her person, they said.

Sit-in for road repair

Students of a school under Nagarkanda upazila held a sit-in at local Shaheed Minar premises yesterday demanding immediate repair of a road to their school at Ziakoli village. They also submitted a memorandum to Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) S.M Abdul Kader. Source said, around 50 students of Poradia SA Khan High School held the sit-in programme from 10am-12 noon. Md. Samsuddoha Talukder, a member of the managing committee said, around 200 students of Ziakoli village suffer as they wade through waist deep water in rainy season. The allocated money and TR to repair the road were gobbled up several times, he alleged.

10 hurt as BNP rivals clash

At least 10 people were injured in a clash between two rival groups of BNP at Bandhal bazar at Gopalpur village in Kochua upazila on Wednesday night. Of the injured, Masum Billah, 30, Limon Sheikh, 26, Anam Sheikh, 20, and Delwar Sheikh, 40, were admitted to a local clinic. Locals said there was a longstanding dispute between BNP activists Shahiduzzaman Milton and Humayun Kabir over establishing supremacy at the village. They said an altercation ensued between them over a trifling matter at the bazar at about 8pm. Later, both the groups equipped with lethal weapons, sticks and brickbats attacked each other leaving 10 people injured from both sides.

11 shops, one house gutted

UNB, Laxmipur

At least 11 shops and one dwelling house were gutted in a fierce fire in Ramgati upazila headquarters Tuesday night. Local people said the fire originated from the petrol shop of Jahangir Alam at about 11:30pm and soon engulfed the adjacent shops and house. Three people were also injured while extinguishing the blaze. Of them, critically injured Firoz Alam Babul was admitted to the upazila health complex.
