

Take into account India's past role before signing treaty: Jamaat

Bangladesh Jamaat-e-Islami yesterday asked the government to take into account India's previous activities with Bangladesh prior to signing any new deal with it. "The government has to take into account the past activities of India before going for signing a new agreement. They (India) had signed the Indira-Mujib agreement, but never implemented it," said Jamaat acting Secretary General ATM Azharul Islam at a press conference at the party's central office.

No transit without Teesta treaty: Matia

Agriculture Minister Matia Chowdhury yesterday said there would be no transit deal with India without Teesta water sharing treaty.

Matia said this at a relief distribution programme among the flood victims from Nalitabari and Nokla upazilas at Nalitabari upazila parishad hall room.

Referring to criticism that Indian Prime Minister Manmohan Singh's visit was a failure, she said: "I don't say we've got all that we had wanted. But whatever we've got is not insignificant."

She said, "We've got many things with the agreements with India, including quota-free access of 46 Bangladeshi products to Indian market and Tin Bigha corridor."

Int'l support to ensure quality edn sought

Education Minister Nurul Islam Nahid yesterday sought international support to ensure quality of education in the country.

"To check school dropout and ensure quality of education at all levels are the main challenges for many countries. Financial and technical support from the Unesco and experience sharing are needed to face these challenges", he said.

Nahid was addressing an Education Ministerial meeting of E-9 countries at Manek Sha Centre in New

Delhi, said a PID handout.

Speaking on the occasion, he said the present government led by Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has already brought a significant change in the country's education sector.

"We've formulated the National Education Policy 2010 taking opinions from different levels. We're implementing it gradually," he said.

Nahid urged the E-9 countries to work unitedly for checking school dropout and ensuring quality of education in these countries.

He is leading a three-member delegation at the international conference titled 'Women's Literacy for Inclusive and Sustainable Development' in New Delhi.
