

Girl killed in fire, couple held for 'bid' to kill girl

A 9-year-old girl was killed in fire on Sunday night while a couple was held on Monday for alleged bid to kill a young girl by setting her on fire.

fire at Joytura village under Sombhag union in Dhamrai upazila on Monday, reports our correspondent.
The couple was identified as Shafiqul Islam, 30, son of Abul Hossain of Joytura village and Rawshan Ara, 25.

Quoting locals, police said that the couple set their neighbour Nasima, 25, on fire after pouring kerosene at around 8:00 pm as she became pregnant by Shafiqul Islam.

Shafiqul developed an illicit relation with his colleague Nasima about one and a half years ago, local union parishad member Mozaffar Hossain said.

Officer-in-charge of Dhamrai police station Jahangir Hossain said Nasima of Laxmipur village under Raipura upazila of Narsingdi district is a worker of a cycle making factory.

Severely injured, she was admitted to the burn unit of Dhaka Medical College and Hospital.

AL men block highway demanding release of leader held for 'looting'

Leaders and activists of Ramgarh upazila Awami League yesterday blocked Khagrachhari-Feni road in Ramgarh Bazar area for seven hours from 6:00am demanding release of one of their leaders arrested on Monday night.

Police said Abdul Kalam, vice-president of Awami League Ramgarh upazila unit, was arrested on charge of leading a gang that allegedly attacked and looted some houses in Ramgarh area on Friday.

Wahidur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Ramgarh Police Station, said they arrested the AL leader following a case filed against him by the victims. Commuters had to face a lot of trouble as AL men blocked traffic by burning tyres and putting up barricades on Khagrachhari-Feni road.

District AL leaders went to Ramgarh and sat with the plaintiffs who withdrew the case against Karim after negotiation. Vehicular movement on the road resumed after Karim was released at around 1:00pm.

Khagrachhari district AL Vice-President Kujendra Lal Chakma told this correspondent that the incident occurred due to a misunderstanding between two local AL leaders. A member of Ramgarh upazila AL requesting anonymity said Karim had a longstanding feud with another party leader named Shah Alam over establishing supremacy and distributing VGF cards in the area.

Culvert collapses only nine months into construction

A culvert on Galachipa launch terminal approach road collapsed nine months into its construction, causing immense trouble to the passengers. The culvert, built at a cost of Tk 2.80 lakh, collapsed during last week's high tide. Locals alleged that Galachipa municipality constructed the culvert with brick wall instead of concrete wall.

plank on the collapsed site to help passengers cross it. Launch passengers use the wooden plank amid risk of accident. Several thousand launch passengers use Golachipa terminal everyday and the culvert was built only the approach road to the terminal.

Local businessmen are also face problems to carry their goods to and from the terminal as vehicles cannot ply the approach road due to collapse of the culvert. They urged the authorities concerned to rebuild the culvert as soon as possible.

Moshiur Rahman, assistant engineer of Galachipa municipality, could not be contacted over cellphone for his comment despite repeated attempts. Contacted, Galachipa Municipality Mayor Abdul Wahab Khalifa said the culvert collapsed under heavy pressure of water during high tide. He said the municipality authorities will rebuild the culvert immediately.

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Five Jamaat men held in Pabna

Abducted schoolgirl rescued

Police rescued a schoolgirl from Dhaka Bus Stand area in the town yesterday. She was abducted three months ago from Hanafitola village under Sadar upazila. Police also arrested the alleged abductor.

The arrestee was identified as Mohammad Kamruzzaman Fantu, 30, a teacher of Devinagar Girls High School in Sadar upazila in Chapainawabganj. The victim was a daughter of Humayun Kabir of Hanafitola village and a student of class eight at the same school. Sub Inspector Jahid Hossain of Sadar police station said, the girl was kidnapped when she was going to her private tutor Kamruzzaman's house at Hanfitola village on June 14.



Rampant poaching threatens deer population

Deer population in the Sundarbans, the world's largest mangrove forest, is seriously threatened owing to the animal's rampant and indiscriminate poaching in the last few years. Poachers are getting easy access to habitats of deer population in connivance with a section of forest officials particularly forest guards. According to Divisional Forest Officer (DFO) Mihir Kumar De, there were nearly one lakh and fifty thousand deer in the Sundarbans as per report of census carried out by the Sundarbans Forest Division during 1996-97 financial year. But we cannot say the exact number of deer now living in the Sundarbans after cyclonic storms Sidr and Aila, he said. Forest guards on Sunday night caught two poachers from Amragachhia village under Sharankhola upazila of Bagerhat district. They were identified as Mosharef Hossain, 60, son of Shaijuddin Khalifa and Feroz Sawdagar, 45, son of Jabbar Sawdagar of the same village. The guards recovered 20 kilograms of venison, head and skin of a deer, two large size choppers and an axe from the possession of the poachers. Another poacher named Mannan Khalifa, however, managed to flee sensing presence of the forest guards. Maximum punishment for this crime of deer poaching under the act is six years of rigorous imprisonment and a fine of Tk 50,000, the DFO said. The venison seized from the two poachers were dumped in the Bagerhat court compound as per order of the court while skin and head of poached deer would be preserved by the forest department, he said. Earlier on September 4, forest guards arrested two poachers from Joimoni area under Mongla upazila of Bagerhat district. They were identified as Manik Talukder, son of Moslem Talukder and Golam Sarder, son of Kuddus Sarder. According to the DFO, the poachers caught a spotted deer by setting a trap in the forest. Later, they brought the slaughtered deer to Joimoni to sell the venison. However, the two poachers caught by the forest guards could not be prosecuted due to political influence, said Deputy Ranger Abul Kalam Azad.
