RUSSIANS VISIT ROOPPUR N-PLANT Division of scope of works determined

UNB, Dhaka

Bangladesh and the Russian Federation have primarily determined the division of scope of works for carrying out various studies in a bid to set up a nuclear power plant at Rooppur in Pabna.

A high-level experts' meeting between Bangladesh and Russia at the Bangladesh Atomic Energy Commission in the city on Thursday primarily fixed the division of scope of works after reviewing the outcome of a visit to Bangladesh by a high-level Russian experts' team, an official of the Rooppur Nuclear Power Plant project said.

The division of scope of works will be finalised soon, he said.

The areas of studies to be carried out include topographic, engineering, seismic, hydro-geological, geo-dynamic, metallurgical, meteorological and ecological.

A 16-member Russian expert team during its visit to Bangladesh from September 11-15 visited the planned nuclear power plant project area at Rooppur.

The Russian team also held meetings with experts of Buet, Dhaka University, Department of Environment, Bangladesh Meteorological Department, Bangladesh Water Development Board, Geological Survey of Bangladesh, Bangladesh Atomic Energy Commission, and Institute of Water Modelling.

They expressed satisfaction over the planned nuclear power plant after holding a series of meetings with the Bangladesh experts.

Site specific study, engineering survey and environmental study are very important for setting up nuclear power plant, according to an expert of Rooppur project.

Man drowns while fleeing from BSF

A Bangladeshi man drowned as he dived into the Nagor River on Beurjhari under Baliadangi upazila in Thakurgaon to evade capture by Indian Border Security Force (BSF) at noon on Thursday.

The deceased was identified as Anwarul Haque, 26, son of Abu Taher of Thoprabari village in the upazila.

Anwarul's family said BSF men gave chase near Beurjhari border near pillar number 380 while he was returning after a visit to his in-laws at Chunihari village in Gawalpukur Thana in Poshchim Dinajpur in India.

Fishermen found his floating body around 3:00pm and informed Beurjhari Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) outpost, who recovered and handed it over to Baliadangi police.

His body was handed over to the family in the evening.

Shraddha of Ajit Roy, a dedicated artiste of Swadhin Bangla Betar Kendra, was held in the city's Dhakeswari National Temple yesterday.

Romacho Roy, son of the veteran singer, performed the Shraddha, a ritual to pay homage to one's ancestors, especially to one's dead parents. Ajit's wife Bula Roy and other family members were also present.

Priest Bijoy Krishna Goshawmi said the Shraddha was held seeking salvation of the departed soul and later food was served to relatives and well-wishers of the deceased.

Many leaders and activists of different socio-cultural and political organisations including Communist Party of Bangladesh President Manzurul Ahsan Khan, M Hamid, Golam Kuddus, singer Rathindra Nath Roy, Subir Nandi, Papia Sarowar and Mita Haque attended the ritual.

Ajit Roy, also a prominent Tagore singer, passed away at Birdem Hospital on September 4.

He made major contribution in the Gano Sangeet genre, especially during the Liberation War. His songs ignited the patriotic sentiments of the common people as well as the soldiers on the battlefield.

After independence, he joined Bangladesh Betar (radio) as a music producer.

Roy was the composer of many timeless and patriotic songs including "Ekti Bangladesh tumi jagroto janotar" and "Apomaney tumi shedin".

He received several awards including Swadhinata Padak (2000), Gunijan Padak, Sraddhanjalipatro, Shabdoshainik Padak, Sequence Award (1988) and Begum Rokeya Padak.
