Road crashes kill 5

Five people were killed and three others injured in separate road accidents in Chandpur, Narsingdi and Khagrachhari yesterday.

Our Chandpur correspondent reports: At least two auto-rickshaw passengers were killed and three others injured when a Shahrastibound auto-rickshaw from Haziganj collided head-on with a passenger bus coming from opposite direction in Uaruk area of Shahrasti upazila yesterday.

The deceased are Kazi Abbul Awal, 45, and Abdul Khaleq, 65. They are from Dikchail area of Haziganj.

Our Narsingdi correspondent says: At least two people, including a motorcyclist, were killed in separate road accidents in Chaitabo and

Panchdona area of Sadar upazila yesterday.


Police said the first accident took place in Chaitabo area when a Narsingdi-bound riceladen truck from Dhaka hit a stationed truck from behind, leaving its helper Sumon, 27, dead on the spot.

The second one in Panchdona area, a motorcyclist was killed when a Dhaka-bound bus hit him while he was going to Panchdona.

The deceased is Anisur Rahman, 28. Our Khagrachhari correspondent adds: A minor boy was killed as a speedy Khagrachhari-bound bus of Shanti Paribahan from Chittagong crushed him while he was crossing the road in Bhuiyan para area of

Matiranga upazila yesterday. The deceased is Shakibul Hasan, 7, son of Md Iqbal, of the same area in the district. He was a student of local primary school.

### Bangladesh, US navies begin Carat exercise

The navies of Bangladesh and the United States yesterday began an eight-day of maritime safety and security exercises in Chittagong.

This is the first-ever Cooperation Afloat Readiness and Training (Carat) Bangladesh 2011, said a press release of the US embassy in Dhaka.

The exercise formally began at BNS Issa Khan, marking the first time Bangladesh has participated in the 17-year old Carat exercise series, which the US Navy conducts with navies of seven other Southeast Asian nations.

Carat participants now include Bangladesh, Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore and Thailand.

There are four US Navy ships and approximately 500 US personnel participating in the exercise.

The ships include the guided missile destroyer, the frigate, mine countermeasures ship and the dive and salvage rescue ship.

Carat Bangladesh combines training events ashore and at sea, with shore events focused on dive training, riverine warfare, ship boarding training and medical and community service projects.

Training events are helicopter operations, shipboard communications, maneuvering drills, surface gunnery exercises and tactical free play.

# JS body to see Sadarghat expansion possibility

A parliamentary body yesterday formed a three-member sub-committee to examine the possibility of expanding Sadarghat launch terminal, aimed at reducing suffering and harassment to passengers in the city's lone launch terminal.

Headed by Golam Kibria Tipu, the subcommittee is to submit its report to the parliamentary standing committee on shipping ministry within the next two months.

Two other members of the subcommittee are Nasrul Hamid Bipu and Nazrul Islam Babu, lawmakers of Awami

League.

"Passengers and the number of launches in Sadarghat launch terminal have increased significantly over recent years. Besides, passengers suffer as there is only one road to reach the terminal," said Noor-e-Alam Chowdhury Liton, chief of the committee.

Emerging from the meeting at Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban, Liton, also a ruling Awami League lawmaker, said the committee thinks expansion of the terminal is imperative to reduce harassment to passengers.

He said some of the committee members suggested building another launch terminal at Keranigang, opposite to Sadarghat terminal.

# 69 vie for one JU seat
