# Witness of horror tells of death, his freedom

Seeing some BDR soldiers beating Maj Gazzali, Lt Col Mohammad Abu Tasnim quickly hid himself behind a building in Pilkhana during the bloody mutiny on February 25 in

Within a few minutes, he heard

someone groaning after two or three gunshots. Coming out of the hideout, Lt Col Tasnim saw a few armed jawans taking away the body of Maj Gazzali in a sack.

Fifty-seven army officers including Gazzali were among the 74 people brutally killed in the February 25-26 BDR mutiny.

A survivor of the carnage and then commanding officer of signal sector, Lt Col Tasnim was presenting his statement to a Dhaka court yesterday as the third prosecution witness to the killing case.


