# Syria accuses West for 'total chaos'

AFP, Damascus

Syria accused the West of trying to unleash "total chaos" that would lead to the break-up of the country, as rights groups said Syrian forces strafed political dissidents with machineguns yesterday.

China meanwhile expressed its concern at the wider implications of the violence in Syria, even as the United States pressed Beijing, a veto-wielding member of the Security Council, to back stronger UN action against Damascus.

Syrian Foreign Minister Walid Muallem, speaking at the annual UN General Assembly, said foreign governments sought to undermine the co-existence between Syria's different religious groups.

"How can we otherwise explain media provocations, financing and arming religious extremism?" he asked.

"What purpose could this serve other than total chaos that would dismember Syria -- and consequently adversely affect its neighbours?"

He said anti-regime protests in which at

least 2,700 people have been killed have become a "pretext for foreign interventions."

Rejecting the accusations, Germany's Foreign Minister Guido Westerwelle called for UN Security Council action.

"The courageous men and women in Syria deserve a clear signal of our solidarity," Westerwelle told the UN assembly, condemning the "brutal force" used by President Bashar al-Assad's forces.

Damascus does not accept the existence of popular opposition to the authorities, instead blaming "armed gangs" and "terrorists" for trying to sow chaos.

In the latest violence, a human rights group said Syrian forces raked the city of Rastan in central Homs province with machinegun fire from sunrise on Tuesday, wounding at least 20 people.

The city, about 180 kilometres from Damascus and a gateway to the country's north, has been the focus of security force operations against anti-regime dissent in flashpoint Homs province for several days, according to activists.

#### Forces trying to 'destabilise polity' Says Indian PM

Indian Prime Minister Manmohan Singh yesterday said attempts were being made to "destabilise polity" and accused the opposition of getting "prematurely restless" to "force" early parliamentary elections.

He made it clear that his government will "stay the course" and complete its full five-year term. Fresh elections are due in the year 2014.

"I suspect there are other forces which want to destabilise our country," Singh said.

He said there was no dissension in his cabinet in the context of the recent Finance Ministry note which suggested that Palaniappan Chidambaram as the then Finance Minister had not done enough to ensure the auction of 2G telecom spectrum in 2007.

The government of Singh faces a 39-billion dollar scam relating to sale of telecom spectrum.

Replying to a question about the Opposition, which appeared reasonable in the UPA-I, the Prime Minister said

the Opposition is getting "prematurely restless". "I have said this in Parliament that we have the mandate of the people to govern for five years and the Opposition should wait for two-and-a-half years.

## former aide denied bail

A former aide of India's top opposition leader LKAdvani of BJP was arrested yesterday after a court here rejected his plea for interim bail in connection with a cash-for-vote scam during a parliamentary trial of strength sought by Prime Minister Manmohan Singh in July 2008.

The case relates to three BJP lawmakers waving wads of currency notes totalling Rs one crore on the floor of Lok Sabha, lower House of Parliament, in July 2008 alleging ruling Congress had attempted to buy their votes during a confidence motion sought by the prime minister.

Pakistan assures China on 'anti-terror' fight

Prime Minister Syed Yusuf Raza Gilani yesterday extended Pakistan's full support to China in fighting Muslim separatists following claims the fighters were trained on its soil.

China last month pinned the blame on Islamist camps based in neighbouring Pakistan for training "terrorists" from its minority Uighur ethnic group blamed for two incidents in July in the Xinjiang region that left 21 dead.

Gilani made his comments following a meeting to discuss regional security with Chinese Public Security Minister Meng Jianzhu, who had also held meetings with President Asif Ali Zardari, Interior Minister Rehman Malik and General Khalid Shameem Wyne, chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff Committee.

"We are true friends. China's enemy is our enemy, we will extend our full cooperation to

China on security," Gilani said in televised comments aired by state-run Pakistan television. Meanwhile a key American lawmaker

from Texas has introduced a resolution in the House of Representatives to freeze all US aid to "disloyal" Pakistan. The House Resolution if passed will freeze

all US aid to Pakistan with the exception of funds that are designated to help secure nuclear weapons.

"Since the discovery of Osama bin Laden in Abbottabad, Pakistan has proven to be disloyal, deceptive and a danger to the United States," Congressman Ted Poe said in a statement after tabling the resolution in the House on Friday.

"This so-called ally continues to take billions in US aid, while at the same time supports the militants who attack us. The United States must immediately freeze all aid to Pakistan," said Poe.

At least 31 children and four adults were killed when a bus crashed on the motorway southeast of Pakistan's capital Islamabad, officials said yesterday.

The bus, which was ferrying private school pupils back from a picnic, came off the road and fell into a ravine in Punjab province late Monday.

"Thirty-five people, including 31 children and four adults, have been killed in the accident," Naseem Sadiq, a senior administration official in the children's home district of Faisalabad, told AFP.

"The driver, his helper, vice principal and a teacher of the school were also among the dead," he said. All the children were aged 10 to 15, he added.

Speaking from the scene of the crash in Chakwal, about 100 kilometres (60 miles) southeast of the capital, senior police officer Chaudhry Salim said overnight that 24 school students were among at least 30 dead.

Officials said they would investigate the cause of the acci-

dent, but said early reports indicated that the brakes failed. In June, at least 12 children were killed when their school

bus plunged into a canal in Pakistan-administered Kashmir. Pakistan has one of the world's worst records for deadly traffic accidents, blamed on poor roads, badly maintained vehicles and reckless driving.

#### China tells police to use social media

China has ordered police nationwide to make more use of social networking sites to ensure greater openness and "dispel misunderstandings", the state Xinhua news agency said yesterday.

Huang Ming, vice-minister of public security, delivered the message at a conference on Monday aimed at helping law enforcement officials to use China's hugely popular microblogs -- sites similar to Twitter -- the report said. "Internet users are one of the major groups of our soci-

ety and they are not satisfied," Huang posted on the Beijing Public Security Bureau microblog. "Public security microblogging should gradually cross

the country to each province and city and form the backbone of public security." China's online population -- the world's largest at 485 million -- is increasingly turning to Internet services such

as the microblogs for information, instead of relying on news from the country's official media. Microblogs, known as weibos, have proved an effective public platform to report governmental and police malpractice as traditional media outlets such as newspapers

remain more easily controlled by government authorities. The recent case of a Chinese tourist who was dragged from his hotel room in Beijing and savagely beaten, reportedly by security staff local officials had hired, pro-

voked outrage among Internet users.

### Telangana temples shut for statehood

It is not just the ordinary people in Telangana who are affected by the ongoing general strike. Even the temples have been shut by priests -- all for the cause of a separate state.

Hundreds of temples across the region, comprising Hyderabad and nine other districts, stopped 'Arjitha sevas' and other special rituals as priests and other employees joined the 'people's strike' which entered its 15th day.

Except for 'darshan', the temples have stopped rituals like 'Arjitha sevas' 'Abhishekha' and 'Arachana' on a call given by the Joint Action Committee of Telangana priests and employees of endowment department, which manages the affairs of the temples.

Upendra Sharma, one of the top priests and leaders of JAC, said the action was in tune with the aspirations of four crore people of Telangana who are fighting for a statehood.

According to officials of the endowment departments, the temples would lose huge income because of the protest.

Sri Lakshminarasimha Swamy Temple at Yadagirigutta in Nalgonda district, also called the Tirupati of Telangana, wore a deserted look yesterday as the temple was shut for all rituals. Hundreds of people throng the temple every day and the strike is likely to result in the loss of Rs.4-5 lakh.

The other famous temples in the region, including those at Bhadrachalam, Vemulawada and Basar, were also hit by the strike by priests and other employees.

A large number of temples in Mahabubnagar, Warangal and Karimnagar districts -- the hotbeds of Telangana movement -- were closed since Sep 13. Rajarajeswari Swami temple at Vemulawada in Karimnagar district has so far lost revenue of Rs.60 lakh.

#### Scores injured in China metro crash

Two metro trains collided in Shanghai yesterday, injuring more than 240 people, the system operator said, just months after a deadly highspeed rail crash that shocked China.

The firm blamed the accident on a signal failure -the same cause as a July train crash that killed at least 40 people and shook public confidence in China's vast rail network.

## Beijing to tighten grip on media, web

China's top leaders are considering "cultural reforms", state media reported, which analysts said would be aimed at tightening control over the media and Internet to shape public opinion.

A meeting chaired by President Hu Jintao on Monday

called for the "mastering of new trends in cultural development" and for an emphasis on "Chinese characteristics" as part of the proposed overhaul, Xinhua news agency said. Details of the draft changes to be considered by

Communist Party leaders next month were not given, but analysts said they were likely to tighten Beijing's grip on newspapers, television and popular social networking sites.

For the past decade Beijing has been encouraging staterun media to be more competitive and less reliant on state subsidies, which has led to more critical reporting and racier programming as outlets compete for readers and viewers.

The huge and rising popularity of weibos -- microblogs similar to Twitter that have taken China by storm since they first launched two years ago -- has also posed major challenges to censors and fuelled official concerns.
