## Restaurant worker killed in Ctg

A restaurant worker was murdered by two of his colleagues following an altercation in the port city yesterday, police said.

The deceased was identified as Yusuf, 25, hailing from Ramgati upazila, Laxmipur.

Abul Kalam Azad, officer-in-charge of Kotwali Police Station, said Yusuf, working at Roaster restaurant in Mehadibug area, engaged in an altercation with two of his colleagues around 8:00am yesterday. At one stage, the two fellows attacked and injured him, he said. Yusuf died in Chittagong Medical College Hospital around 10:00am after locals took him there.

The OC said police could not identify the two restaurant workers who killed Yusuf. For investigation, they detained three workers from the restaurant, he said.

General Secretary of the district BNP Amin-Ur-Rashid informed the media men at a briefing organised by Comilla South BNP at his house at 11:00am.


Whether the councilor aspirants are also going to boycott the poll, he said the party will wait until December 14, the last day for withdrawing nomination. However, the party men are split into two over the

# DU to appeal HC order

The Dhaka University authorities last night decided to appeal against the High Court order that directed the university authorities to immediately re-evaluate the answer sheets of this year's 'Ga' unit admission tests and publish fresh results.

"The DU syndicate took the decision after discussing the matter with its legal counsel", Vice Chancellor Prof AAMS Arefin Siddique told The Daily Star over phone last night. An HC bench of Justice AHM Shamsuddin

Chowdhury Manik and Justice Jahangir Hossain directed the university authorities

to re-evaluate the answer sheets of 'Ga' unit admission tests by a three-member committee led by educationist Dr Muhammad Zafar Igbal on December 1. The court issued the order following a writ

petition filed by 12 successful admission seekers on November 22. The admission test for the 2011-12 aca-

demic session was held on November 11. But the publication of the results sparked protests by hundreds of students over what they alleged was a wrong counting of marks. In the wake of the allegations, the univer-

sity authorities decided to cancel the results and hold a fresh test on December 9.

Dr Jalal Alamgir, an associate professor of Boston University in the US and son of Awami League lawmaker Muhiuddin Khan Alamgir, drowned as he was taking a bath along with his wife in the sea in Thailand yesterday.

Dr Jalal was 40. He got married one year ago and went to Bangkok with his wife on December 2.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina expressed her deep shock at the death of Dr Jalal Alamgir, reports UNB. In a condolence message, she prayed for the salvation of the departed soul and conveyed her sympathy to the bereaved family.

Prof Muntasir Uddin Khan Mamun, cousin of the deceased, told The Daily Star that they were trying to bring the body home soon from Thailand.

Dr Jalal Alamgir, who had been teaching political science at Boston University, was on a one-year vacation, the family sources said.

Speakers at a discussion in New York have demanded that the government should form a tribunal like the war crimes tribunal to try those who were the masterminds behind the jail killing in 1975.

1971 also masterminded the killing of four national leaders--Syed Nazrul Islam, Tajuddin Ahmed, M Mansur Ali and AHM Qamaruzzaman-- in captivity in Dhaka central jail on November 3. New York and Florida branches of Ekattorer Ghatak Dalal

They said the same culprits who led the mass killing in

Nirmul Committee and Samprity Forum jointly organised the discussion on November 17, says a press release.

Dr Manju Islam, son of Syed Nazrul Islam, said the nation should arrange symbolic trial to initiate the movement for trying the killers of four national leaders like Jahanara Imam did in 1994 for trying the war criminals.
