

# Gallamari memorial opens at Krishnanagar of Khulna

Built after long 40 years of independence, Gallamari memorial at Krishnanagar under Batiaghata upazila of Khulna district was inaugurated yesterday.

Pakistani occupation forces and their local collaborators used Gallamari as killing ground during the War of Independence in 1971 and killed at least 14,00 people here.

Mayor of Khulna City Corporation (KCC) Talukder Abdul Khaleque inaugurated the memorial as chief guest. Divisional Commissioner Md Mashur Rahman and Vice-Chancellor of Khulna University Prof Md Saifuddin Shah were the special guests at the inaugural function with the deputy commissioner, Khulna, in the chair.

Anwarul Iqbal, adviser to the caretaker government, laid the foundation of the memorial on December 30 in 2008 and construction work began on November 20 in 2009 under the supervision of Khulna Zila Parishad. The work was expected to be completed by May 2010.

The government allocated Tk two crore to begin construction work of the memorial while Khulna Zila Parishad spent Tk 16 lakh from its own fund for the

purpose.

In his inaugural speech, the mayor said the zila parishad wrote an official letter to the Ministry of Local Government and Rural Development (LGRD) on March 29 this year, asking for allocation of Tk 8 crore more to complete the remaining works of the memorial.

The remaining works to be done are construction of boundary wall, an approach

road, waiting room and a separate room for security guards, a flower garden and a museum.

According to Executive Officer AN Ahmad Ali of Khulna Zila Parishad, the LGRD ministry forwarded the letter to the Ministry of Liberation Affairs on April 6. But the file relating to the letter has not yet been sent to the finance ministry, he said.

## UP member murdered

A union parishad (UP) member was killed by criminals at East Someshpur village in Nalitabari upazila early yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Nazmul Haque Dewan, 42, son of late Ashraf Hossain and member of Poragao union parishad.

Local people said Nazmul along with some of his friends went to a jungle behind the information centre of Madhutula Eco Park and was drinking alcohol late at night.

At that time a gang swooped on him and at one stage strangled him.

## 2 Shibir men arrested

Abu Taleb, ameer of Kaliganj Jamaat unit, said police suddenly launched attack on the peaceful rally.

# Harijans demand basic rights

People of Harijan community in Chapainawabganj and Natore districts yesterday formed human chains and held rallies demanding basic human rights.

In Chapainawabganj, they formed a human chain, held a rally and submitted a memorandum to prime minister through the deputy commissioner calling to meet their five-point demand.

Bangladesh Harijan Oikya Parishad, Chapainawabganj unit formed arranged the programme in front of DC office marking the World Respect Day, reports our correspondent.

Speakers at the rally said, people in the country consider them as untouchables. They demanded formulation of a law to eliminate the social discrimination against them and to ensure their civic rights.

The Harijans are worst victims of discrimination in getting government jobs too, they alleged.

We are living an inhuman life with no citizens' rights. There are little educational facilities for our children. Even if some of them get education, they do not get jobs, as they are Harijans, said a speaker.

He urged the government to formulate a national policy immediately in this regard.

The Harijan leaders also demanded regularisation of their jobs in city corporations, municipalities, non-government and private organisations and reserving 80 percent posts of sweepers

in every sector for the community members.

Brahmma Thakur, president of the Parishad, district unit, its vice president Dilip Kumar, general secretary Deb Sagar Thakur, spoke at the rally, among others.

Harijans in Natore also formed human chain and brought out a procession

near the press club in the town at noon.

Around 200 Harijan people of the Natore unit joined the human chain programme and made similar demands.

Addressing a rally at the venue, Natore district unit president of Bangladesh Harijan Oikya Parishad Dipu Mondol said that the govern-

ment and non-government organisations are hiring people from other sects as cleaners and sweepers.

He also demanded wage hike of Harijans and urged the government to ensure 80 percent job quota for them.

Later, they submitted a memorandum to the deputy commissioner.

# Lalmonirhat was freed on this day in 1971

On this day in 1971, this northern border district was freed from the occupation of Pakistani forces. The district town was the Sector 6 headquarters of the freedom fighters (FF).

As Lalmonirhat was a railway divisional town, a large number of Biharis (Urdu-speaking people) lived here as railway employees.

During the war, Pakistani soldiers with the help of the Biharis easily attacked Bengalees and picked up local women and tortured them at camps.

Local Rajakars (collaborators) residing at Khata Para, Nayekey Tari, Station Colony, Gila Bari, Botrishazari and Upyead Colony villages used to help the Pakistani soldiers attack the freedom fighters.

These collaborators of the occupation forces also picked up Bengalees from the villages and killed them after brutal tortures.

Finally on the night of December 3, the freedom fighters led by Sector Commander Air Martial Khademul Bashar launched attacks on Pakistani soldiers at different places of the district, including Saptibari, Sarolkhan, Ambari and Gilabari areas.

The next day, more than 50 Pakistani soldiers gave in to FFs at Botrish Hazari and Fulgach villages, and the following day, another hundred soldiers surrendered at different points of the district.

Lalmonirhat was declared free on December 6 with the hoisting of national flag in the morning.

Commander of Lalmonirhat district Muktiyoddha Sangsad Yusuf Ali told this correspondent that the district town was a safe haven for Pakistani soldiers due to the presence of a large number of Biharis.

He alleged that around 19 percent freedom fighters in the district are still not getting proper honour as they are living under the acute poverty.

# Former school committee men sued for corruption

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) on Tuesday last filed four cases against the members of a former managing committee of Asaduzzaman Girls' High School on charge of misappropriating Tk 35 lakh.

Mohammed Zahurul Huda, deputy director, ACC at Rangpur office filed the cases with Gaibandha Sadar police station accusing nine people including former director of ACC and former additional district magistrate, Gaibandha and former president of the said school managing committee Mojibar Rahman Al Mamun.

The other accused are former president of school committee and president of district BNP advocate Hamidul Huq Chhanna, existing headmaster of school AKM Golam Azam, former headmistress Mahela Khatun, Shahana Banu, headmaster of Gaibandha Govt High School, Md. Khorshed Alam, upazila education officer and former

headmaster Abdul Baki, guardian members of the school committee Khandker Matlubar Rahman and Abdul Mannan Sarker.

In the cases, the ACC alleged that in 2003, the school managing committee spent Tk 47,46,707 for the construction of a market along the school. But it showed an expenditure of Tk 64,56,753 through fake vouchers and thus misappropriated Tk 17,10,046.

Besides, the then 6-member appointment committee appointed the existing headmaster of school, AKM Golam Azam, illegally and so the headmaster drew Tk 8,88,000 illegally from 2003 till date, it was alleged.

The headmaster also misappropriated Tk 2,59,680 and Tk 6,88,000 simultaneously from the school fund in the name of loans allocated for the shops of school's market. The ACC filed two cases against him in this connection.

Afzal Hossain Khan, OC of Gaibandha Sadar PS yesterday admitted filing of four cases by ACC Rangpur office.
