BGB recovers 6 pistols, 32 bullets from smugglers' den

Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) personnel seized six pistols, 36 bullets and 12 magazines from Hili border in Hakimpur upazila of Dinajpur district early yesterday.

Acting on a tip-off, the members of Joypurhat-3 BGB Battalion led by Major Zakir raided a den of the arms smugglers in bordering Sonapur area at around 4:30am and recovered the firearms, bullets and magazines.

They also recovered 39

bottles of phensidyl from the spot. Sensing the presence of the border guards, the arms smugglers fled the scene, BGB sources

BGB filed a case with Hakimpur Police Station yesterday morning. No one was arrested in connection with the recovery of arms and ammunition as of 5:00pm.

According to BGB, Rab and police sources, as many as 25 firearms, 138 bullets and 18 magazines were recovered from different frontier areas under BGB Dinajpur Khulnadistrict.

Of them, Rab seized two pistols, three pipe guns, two revolvers, one shooter gun, eight bullets and two magazines. BGB seized eight pistols, two revolvers, one short gun, 130 bullets and 16 magazines. Police seized two revolvers.

Following their confessional statements, the law enforcers recovered 13 firearms and 26 bullets from short gun, four one Jongra area of the Sundarbans under Dakope upazila of the district the same day.

The arms and ammunition meant for sale to the pirates of the mangrove forest were found hidden under ground on the bank of Jongra Canal, said Lt three illegal arms traders C o m m a n d e r in Khulna city and Hasanuzzaman, staff Batiaghata upazila of officer of coastguards Mongla West Zone.

Valiant freedom fighters and Indian allied forces on this month in 1971 continued their triumphant march towards Dhaka, making the final victory against the occupation Pakistan forces imminent.

People of Manikganj district will celebrate the 'Manikganj liberation day'

Declaring the district (the then sub-division) free from occupation forces, freedom fighters on this day in 1971 hoisted national flag atop the Primary Training Institute (PTI) in the town.

Under the leadership of Captain Abdul Halim Chowdhury, the freedomloving people of the district vowed to resist the Pakistani Army in March 1971.

A day after the declaration of independence on March 26, freedom fighters collected firearms from Manikganj Treasury and started training at different places of the district.

Later the Pakistani forces captured important establishments, entered different areas of the district and killed many innocent people while the freedom fighters locked in fights and resisted

were killed and 50 others held with injuries in a fierce battle with freedom fighters at Golaidanga village in Singair upazila on October 28. Freedom fighters Lokman Hossain, Zahidur Rahman and Tobarak Hossain Ludu

Ahead of the occasion, the freedom fighters a couple of days ago urged the Muktijuddher Bijoy Mela authorities to complete the lists of the martyred freedom fighters and inscribe their names on the plaque at the martyrs' memorial in front of Shahid Miraz-Tapan Stadium in the town.

The plaque now has only 39 names as the authorities are yet to complete the list of freedom fighters who made supreme sacrifice during the LiberationWar, they said.
