The charge sheeted accused include a Supreme Court lawyer, Mohammad Moniruzzaman, while the others are Mohiuddin Azad Rabbi, Faruque Ahmed, Abul Kashem, Halema Begum and Dwigendra Kumar Chanda.

Monir and Faruque are now in jail custody while the

DB Inspector Fazlur Rahman, also the investigation officer (IO) of the case, submitted the charge sheet showing 23 people as prosecution witnesses to the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's Court of Dhaka.

The IO dropped names of Advocate Monir Hossain and Mizanur Rahman from the charge sheet as their involvement with the incidents was not found.

Two gunmen--Rubel and Mithun-- allegedly shot dead Sadequr Rahman, general secretary of Bangladesh Nursery Owners' Association, and his wife Romana Nargis, on March 24, 2010 at their residence at Kalachandpur in the capital's Gulshan, as they resisted Rubel from forcibly taking
