# Newsmen protest assault on colleague in Joypurhat

Newsmen of different dailies and electronic media in Joypurhat district yesterday formed a human chain followed by rally, demanding stern action against the culprits who assaulted the district correspondent of Channel-i on Thursday.

At the rally at Joypurhat Press Club they strongly condemned the attack on Shafiq Bari Russel by the mayor of Kalai municipality and organising secretary of Kalai upazila ruling party.

After the incident, Russel filed a case with Kalai police station on Saturday accusing 10 people including Mayor Toufiqul Islam Talukdar, upazila AL leader Abu Kalam, Alam Hossain, Natsi Talukdar and Abdur Razzak.

The journalists at the human chain and rally protested the attack on Russel near a bus stand just for carrying out a report on clashes between the activists of AL and BNP of the upazila on January 27 afternoon.

Several journalists of the district received threats over their cell phone after the incident. The callers asked them not to file any report of assault on Russel, said the speakers.

Advocate Nripendranath Mondal, President of Joypurhat Press Club chaired the rally.

At the meeting, the newsmen demanded immediate arrest and punishment of the offenders.

Meanwhile, Kalai police yesterday arrested accused Alam Hossain, said Mokhlesur Rahman, officer in-charge of Kalai police station.

Russel is still being treated at the Joypurhat Modern Hospital.

Contacted, Kalai municipality mayor said he was not involved with any of the incidents.

# Top outlaw murdered in Paschimbanga

Shailendra Nath Biswas, 45, alleged ringleader of outlawed New Biplobi Communist Party (NBCP) was shot dead by his rivals at about 10:30pm on Saturday in Indian state of Paschimbanga.

Shailendra hailed from Shalua village under Rangpur union in Dumuria upazila of Khulna.

Sources across the border said, police recovered his body at about 11:00am from beside Ashoknagar rail station of Howrah district.

However, the report could not be independently confirmed.

Pratap Chandra Biswas, younger brother of the outlaw said he also had received a message over cell phone at 3:00pm on Sunday from one of his friends about the

murder of Shailen.

According to OC Abdul Kader Baig at Dumuria police station, Shailendra Nath Biswas fled the country in 2003 in the face of combing operation by joint forces. He was later arrested by Indian police on charge of murdering a Bangladeshi youth and released from jail in the second week of December last year.

"I have also heard about his death," he said.

The notorious outlaw was wanted in connection with 54 criminal cases filed with different police stations of Khulna, Satkhira and Jessore districts, he added.

Besides, there are 21 more criminal cases against him with Dumuria police station alone on charge of murders, kidnap and extortions.

He was awarded death penalty in a murder case, the OC said.

# VIOLENCE AFTER SENHATI UP BY-POLL 3 separate cases filed

Three separate cases were recorded with Digholia police station on Sunday night in connection with violence that erupted soon after the results of by-election to Senhati union were announced on Thursday.

OC Mashiur Rahman was complainant of the first case while one Md. Saifullah filed the second case.

The OC said that he arrested seven people in connection with the case filed by himself.

The seven arrestees are: Jalal Ahmed, Kazi Al Amin Morol, Md. Yusuf Howlader, Md. Ashrafur Islam, Md. Hasan Sheikh, Md. Yasin Morol and Md Al Amin Morol.

## Follow-up

On the other hand, 12 people have been accused in the case filed by Md. Saifullah, son of late Rustam Ali of Chandanimahar under Digholia upazila.

The complainant brought the allegation of an attempt on the life of newly elected chairman Farhana Halim, candidate of a faction of Khulna Awami League.

The lone accused arrested in connection with this case is Faruk Mallick.

The complainant further stated in his case that the accused with the help of others on Saturday looted many houses, shops and set

those on fire while Farhana Halim was meeting people to express her gratitude after the election.

On Sunday night president of Senhati union unit BNP Md. Nazrul Islam lodged another case accusing nine leaders and activists of Awami League.

The complainant stated in his FIR that the accused had attacked his house twice on Friday and Saturday. They also damaged the furniture, looted valuables and later set fire to clothes of members of the family during the rampage, he said.

He further said that the supporters of Farhana Halim gave him death threats thrice.

### Woman beaten to death

A woman succumbed to her injuries at Rangpur Medical College and Hospital (RMCH) on Sunday noon, four days after she was beaten up allegedly by her neighbours over a trivial matter. The victim was identified as Nuri Khatun, 30, wife of Saiful Islam of Nijpara village in Pirgachha upazila. Police and local sources said, a chicken of Shariful Islam, son of Babu Mia at the village, entered Saiful's house on January 26. Nuri then attacked the fowl with a bamboo stick, leaving it dead on the spot. As a sequel to the incident, Mukul Mia, elder brother of Shariful, and his wife Trisna Begum beat up the victim mercilessly, leaving her injured. Nuri was admitted to RMCH in a critical condition. She succumbed to her wounds at noon.

### Man held with arms, ammo

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) arrested a man along with two foreign pistols and two bullets from Karimpur village in Sadar upazila on Saturday. The arrestee is Akhil Chandra Dhar, 40, son of Nolini Chandra Dhar of the village. Commander of Rab-9 Lt Kawser Mahmud said, on secret information, they raided the house of Akhil at about 8:00pm and arrested him along with the arms and ammunition.

### Fugitive convict held

Police arrested a fugitive convict in a murder case from Kanarpara area of the district town on Saturday night. The arrestee is Pankaj Kumar Chandra, 35, son of Gopal Kumar Chandra of Dhorerbari area in the town. He was awarded life term imprisonment in a case in 1999. Acting on a tip-off, a team of police conducted a drive in the area and arrested Pankaj. He was absconding since the murder. According to the case, the arrestee stabbed one Younus to death at the ticket counter of Merina Cinema Hall in the town on April 30, 1999.

### Youth killed by rival

UNB, Comilla

A youth was stabbed to death allegedly by his rival at Kaliajuri in the district town on Friday noon. The dead was identified as Javed, son of Jahangir Alam of the village. Police said Javed locked in an altercation with one Mayenuddin at the village over previous enmity at about 12:00pm. At one stage, Mayenuddin stabbed Javed, leaving him dead on the spot. Mayenuddin was also injured during the scuffle. Mayenuddin then fled the scene and went to Comilla Medical College and Hospital for taking treatment from where police arrested him.

### Two held with jatka

UNB, Bagerhat

Police arrested two people along with 640 kilograms of jatka (hilsa fry) from a van at Signbord Bazar in Kachua upazila on Friday. The arrestees are Abdur Rob, 40, of Rajoir village in Sharankhola upazila and Abdur Khalek, 41, of Bhaijora village in Morolganj upazila. Iman Uddin, sub-inspector of DB police, said on secret information, they arrested the duo along with the jatka when they were going to Dhaka from Morolganj to sell the jatka. Later, the arrestees were produced before a mobile court led by executive magistrate Mehedi Hasan. The court realised Tk 10,000 in fine and released them, the SI added.

# Woman murdered, husband arrested

A housewife was murdered in Kaharol upazila early Saturday allegedly by her husband.

The victim was identified as Surobala Roy, 32, wife of Anittya Roy of Ishanpur village of the upazila.

Kaharol police said, villagers saw the body of the victim at an open place at Mutunihat village and informed the police. Police recovered the body and sent it to Dinajpur Medical College and Hospital for autopsy.

Police later arrested Anittya Roy, husband of the victim on charge of murder.

Subhash Chandra Roy, brother of the victim filed a case with Kaharol police station.

Rabiul Alam, officer in-charge (OC) of Kaharol police station said there were several marks of injuries on the body of the woman.

In Thakurgaon, police recovered the body of an unidentified woman, aged about 30, from a bamboo cluster at Rampur village under Ranishankoil upazila on Friday, reports our correspondent.

Officer in-charge of Ranishankoil police station Feroz Khan told this correspondent over cell phone that local people saw the body in one Ananta Roy's bamboo cluster at about 10:00am. Her hands and legs were tied up from behind with rope.

On information, police went to the village and recovered the body.

It seems that the woman might be a member of ethnic community, the OC added.

The body was sent to Thakurgaon Sadar Hospital for autopsy. A case was filed with Ranishankoil police station in this connection.

# Five brick kilns fined in Natore, Faridpur

Mobile courts in Natore and Faridpur districts fined five brick kilns for illegal operation and activities on Saturday.

Three illegal brick kilns were fined Tk 70,000 by a mobile court in Natore Sadar upazila and Lalpur upazila on Saturday afternoon.

The team fined M/s Jamuna Bricks Tk 40,000 in Natore Sadar upazila, M/s YRKF Bricks Tk 5,000 and M/s MHT Bricks Manufacturers Tk 25,000 in Lalpur upazila.

In Faridpur, a mobile court in separate drives fined two brick fields Tk 90,000 for burning firewood in Boalmari upazila on Saturday.

The brickfields are Raj Builders and MRS Bricks.

The mobile court, led by executive magistrate Nasrin Jahan, conducted the drive at the two brick kilns at around 10pm and realised the fine for burning firewood violating government ban.
