Request for Expressions of Interest (EOI)
Selection of a Consulting Firm for Developing Training and Learning Materials as well as Organizing Training/Orientation Program (Package No. SD14)

The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit (IDA Credit No. 4481-BD) towards the cost of the Services for Children at Risk (SCAR) project from the International Development Association (IDA). Department of Social Services (DSS) under the Ministry of Social Welfare has initiated the implementation of the SCAR project and intends to apply part of the proceeds for contracting a consulting firm (consultant) for Developing Training and Learning Materials as well as Organizing Training/Orientation Program for the project.

2. The objectives of the assignment are to:

(i) Develop a course curriculum and training manual along with learning/reading materials for five days long orientation workshop for service providers, including (a) officials/personnel working at the district and upazila social service offices of the DSS; (b) the Union Social Workers from grassroots level; (c) officials/personnel involved in the operation and management of child care/juvenile institutions run by DSS; (d) personnel appointed at the Integrated Child Protection Service (ICPS) Centres in seven divisional cities across the country on child rights and protection issues as well as deliver training to 210 participants through 7 (seven) orientation workshops in 07 divisional headquarters;

(ii) Design a day long package (curriculum) for one day advocacy & orientation workshops on child rights and protection issues in Dhaka for the government officers including national level officials and personnel of the Ministry of Social Welfare (MoSW), DSS and representatives from different line ministries/departments, Probation Officers of the Juvenile Courts, police officials and other stakeholders as well as deliver training to 100 participants through four advocacy workshops on issues related to child rights and protections;

(iii) Design a day long package (curriculum) for one day advocacy & orientation workshops on child rights and protection issues for the district and upazila level government officials including: (a) personnel of DSS and line departments; (b) personnel of child care/juvenile institutions run by DSS; (c) Probation Officers of the Juvenile Courts; (d) district level police officials; and (e) other stakeholders as well as deliver training to 210 participants through 7 advocacy workshops in 07 divisional headquarters;

3. The contracted consulting firm would deliver services in the following three training areas including development of course curricula, training manuals along with learning and reading materials as well as organizing training/orientation/sensitization programs using those. The development of curricula, manuals and other materials as well as rolling out of each package would be carried out under the overall supervision and guidance of the PIU-DSS in accordance with the broad guidelines are given below:

Lot-1: Development of a course curriculum and training manual along with learning/reading materials for five days long orientation workshop for service providers, including (a) officials/personnel working at the district and upazila social service offices of the DSS; (b) the Union Social Workers from grassroots level; (c) officials/personnel involved in the operation and management of child care/juvenile institutions run by DSS; (d) personnel appointed at the Integrated Child Protection Service (ICPS) Centres in seven divisional cities across the country on child rights and protection issues as well as deliver training to 210 participants through seven orientation workshops.

Lot-2: Designing a day long package (curriculum) for one day advocacy & orientation workshops on child rights and protection issues for the government officers including national level officials and personnel of the MoSW, DSS and representatives from different line ministries/departments, Probation Officers of the Juvenile Courts, police officials and other stakeholders as well as deliver training to 100 participants through four advocacy workshops.

Lot-3: Designing a day long package (curriculum) for one day advocacy & orientation workshops on child rights and protection issues for the district and upazila level government officials including: (a) personnel of DSS and line departments; (b) personnel of child care/juvenile institutions run by DSS; (c) Probation Officers of the Juvenile Courts, (d) district level police officials; and (e) other stakeholders as well as deliver training to 210 participants through 7 advocacy workshops.

4. The Department of Social Services of the MoSW now invites eligible firms to submit their Expressions of Interest (EOI) for providing the required services. Interested firms must submit information **with documentary evidences** in support of the requirements described below, indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of assignments of similar nature, experience in similar conditions, financial resources, availability of appropriate skills among the staff, etc). The EOIs would be reviewed on the basis of the following aspects to prepare a short-list:

- Registration of the firm
- Age of the firm in business
- Availability of key professionals
- Availability of resources
- Experience of the firm in similar task
- Experience of the firm in other works
- Support services of the firm.

5. Consultants (firms) may associate to enhance their qualification, but should mention whether the association is in the form of a "joint-venture" or a "sub-consultancy". In the case of an association, all members of such "association" should have real and well-defined inputs to the assignment and in such "association", it is preferable to limit the total number of firms including the associates to a maximum of four.

6. A consultant will be selected using the Quality & Cost Based Selection (QCBS) sub-method in accordance with the Public Procurement Act-2006 and the Public Procurement Rules-2008 issued by the Government of Bangladesh. A short-list of firms will be prepared from the expressions of interests for issuing Request for Proposals for this assignment.

7. Interested firms may obtain further information from the office of the undersigned during office hours on working days. The authority reserves the right to accept any, or reject any or all EOIs, or annul the procurement process without assigning any reason thereof.

Expressions of Interest shall be clearly marked "Expression of Interest for selection of a consulting firm for Developing Training and Learning Materials as well as Organizing Training/Orientation Program (Package No. SD14)" and be submitted on or before February 23, 2012 during office hours in sealed envelopes delivered to the address below.
