## Bank official, schoolgirl, 2 others commit 'suicide'

An officer of Bangladesh Krishi Bank (BKB) allegedly committed suicide at his residence at Kazipara in Puraton Kasba area of Jessore town yesterday.

The deceased, Mohammad Ali, 50, is son of Rafiqullah of the area.

Police quoting locals said, Mohammad Ali was suffering from various diseases for a long time. At one stage he became frustrated and committed suicide by hanging himself from the ceiling of a room of his house at dead of night.

Being informed, police recovered the body and sent it to local hospital for autopsy.

In Magura, a female high school student and a youth allegedly committed suicide in separate incidents in Sadar upazila on Sunday night.

Police said Rumea Begum, 15, a class ten student of Shibrampur High School, killed herself by hanging from the ceiling of her house at Atharokhada village.

Police quoting family sources said, Rumea had an affair with one Jalaluddin of the same village.

As her family members came to know about it, they rebuked Rumea and refused to accept the relationship, prompting her to commit suicide.

In another incident, a drug addict allegedly committed suicide at Shahapara of the upazila after failing to collect money for buying drugs.

The deceased was identified as Ripon, 30, son of Abdul Khalek of the area.

Two UD cases were filed with Magura police station.

In Satkhira, an old woman allegedly committed suicide at Kashibati village in Kaliganj upazila yesterday, reports our correspondent.

The victim was identified as Goljan Bibi, 85 wife of late Hazrat Ali of the village.

Quoting local people police said, Goljan took her life by hanging herself from the beam of a verandah at her house at about 5:00 am.

She committed suicide following a family feud, victim's relatives told police.

Police recovered the body and sent it to Satkhira hospital morgue for postmortem.

## 4 drug peddlers jailed, several others arrested

Four drug peddlers were jailed while several others held in five districts on Monday.

A mobile court sentenced three people to various terms of imprisonment for possessing drugs in Kapasia upazila town of Gazipur on Monday.

The convicts are Rafiqul Islam, 30, son of Abdul Latif (jailed for one year) and Dulal, 28, and Taj Uddin, 35, of Uttar Kham (6 months each), reports UNB.

Police arrested Rafiqul along with 50gm of hemp from Bus Station area on Monday and Dulal and Taj with 100gm of hemp on Sunday night.

In Lalmonirhat, a drug smuggler and peddler was jailed for one year at Mogholhat border village on Monday morning, reports our correspondent.

Convict Alom Miah, 22, is son of Subez Ali of the border village.

Police said, Alom Miah was held with 25 bottles of phensidyl at Mogholhat border by BGB on Monday night and later produced in a mobile court.

In Jessore town, police in separate drives arrested three alleged drug peddlers along with 4kg of hemp and 38 bottles of phensidyl on Monday night.

The arrestees are Joinal Abedin Jony, 27, son of late Maniruzzaman of Raghunathpur village of Benapole, Masud Rana, 30, son of Jamal Hossain of Chachra Raipara area of Jessore town and Barkat Ali, 29, son of Torfan Ali of Rajarhat area, reports our Benapole correspondent.

In Magura, Detective Branch of police in separate drives arrested four alleged drug peddlers along with 106 bottles of phensidyl on Monday, reports UNB.

The arrested were identified as Yasin Ali, 28, Zinnat Ali Sardar, 50, of Kalarao upazila in Satkhira district, Khokon Sheikh and his wife Rahela Khatun, 40, of Doarpar in the district.

DB sources said they raided a bus at Magura bus terminal at about 1:20pm and arrested Yasin and Zinnat with 18 bottles of phensidyl.

In another drive, the DB men raided the house of drug peddler Khokon and recovered 88 bottles of phensidyl from the house. The law enforcers also arrested Khokon and his wife in this connection.

In Rangpur town, Detective Branch police arrested two drug peddlers along with 2.5kgs of hemp on Monday night, reports our correspondent.

The arrestees were identified as Khairul Alom Sumon, 28, son of Kachim Uddin of Shingimari village of Hatibandha upazila under Lalmonirhat district and Alomgir Hossain, 22, son of Motiyar Rahman of Shingimari village of the same upazila.

## Former T&T official murdered in Rangpur

A former official of Telephone and Telegraph office in the district was killed allegedly by throwing him from the rooftop of a building on Monday evening.

The victim was identified as Abdul Halim, 61, retired accounts officer of T&T in Rangpur.

Kotwali police said, a gang numbering 3/4 claiming themselves as tenants entered the house of Dr Yusuf Ahmed at Islam Bagh in the town. Later they went to the second floor of the house where Abdul Halim resided.

Hamida Begum, 47, sister-in-law of the deceased told this correspondent that the gang held her hostage at the bathroom and threw Halim from the rooftop and left the house immediately.

Locals found Abdul Halim dead and informed the police.

## Follow-up Two held on charge of killing Jessore SSC examinee

Police yesterday arrested two people on charge of killing SSC examinee Masum Reza in Sharsha upazila two weeks ago.

The arrestees are Mafizur Rahman and Abid Hasan Shohag of Raghunathpur village.

Sub Inspector of Sharsha PS Azizur Rahman said the arrestees are among the five charge-sheeted accused in the murder case filed by Masum Reza's father Rafiqul Islam.

The meritorious student was strangled by criminals on January 24.

Meanwhile, two other accused--Habibullah, son of Abdul Mandal and Babulur Rahman of Shib Bas village, enlarged on bail by the High Court, have returned to the area, sending panic and

shock wave in the area.

The victim's family feared that the release on bail of the prime accused nine days after their arrest might cloud the fate of the case.

They returned to Shib Bas near Raghunathpur immediately after being out on bail, the bereaved family members alleged.

SI Azizur said, being informed, police conducted a drive and arrested Mafiz and Abid from their houses early yesterday.

They were produced before Jessore Senior Judicial Magistrate Javed Imam's court where they gave confessional statement on the killing.

Sharsha Pakshiar High School student Masum Reza was killed by a gang of criminals barely a week before he was supposed to sit for SSC examinations on February 1.

## BSF yet to hand over youth to BGB

Indian Border Security Force (BSF) is yet to hand over a Bangladeshi youth to Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB).

The youth was picked up by BSF from a paddy field in Genduguri border area of Hatibandha upazila on Monday afternoon.

Identified as Sadekul Islam, 19, son of Syed Ali, a resident of Singimari village, he was working in their paddy field at that time, BGB said quoting local people.

BGB of Singimari BOP camp sent a letter to BSF at Mirapara camp of Coochbehar district demanding release of Sadekul on Monday.

BGB received a letter from BSF yesterday morning which said that Sadekul Islam was arrested with 20 bottles of phensidyl in Indian territory and he was handed over to the police.
