# More work to do for Teesta

Manmohan tells Shahara; Delhi reassures Dhaka of steps for no border firing at talks of home ministers

PALLAB BHATTACHARYA, New Delhi

India yesterday assured Bangladesh that efforts were on to bring down the incidents of Border Security Force firing along the border to zero and that the issue with the proposed treaty on Teesta water sharing would be resolved. Indian Prime Minister Manmohan

Singh conveyed this to Bangladesh Home Minister Shahara Khatun, who called on him at his residence in New Delhi yesterday morning.

"We are trying to resolve the Teesta issue," quoting the Indian premier Shahara told representatives of Bangladeshi media later on. She had a separate press conference for Bangladeshi newsmen.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's foreign affairs adviser Gowher Rizvi, who was also present, said the Indian prime minister conveyed that some progress has been made towards solving the Teesta issue but more work is needed.



## AL's 14-party allies root for 15 killed in bus plunge Driver loses control of overcrowded vehicle
