Message of H.E. Mr. Shiro Sadoshima, **Ambassador of Japan**

We are celebrating this year the 40th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between Japan and Bangladesh. On this momentous occasion, I wish to express sincere appreciation of the endeavors of our predecessors who made great efforts to maintain a strong friendship between the two countries along with enormous moral support and timely assistance extended by the Government and the people of Bangladesh following the devastating earthquake and tsunami disaster of 11 March 2011.
