PDB aims to triple output

Plans conversion of 2 old units with little extra gas

SHARIER KHAN

The Power Development Board plans conversion of two old gas-fired power plants in Ghorashal to increase their generation capacity threefold using very little extra gas and thus save huge fuel cost.

PDB Chairman Alamgir Kabir told The Daily Star that if a heat-based 210 megawatt Ghorashal unit is turned into a combined cycle one, it is possible to have another 400 MW power. In combined cycle technology, the heat that escapes from the basic power plant is trapped and utilised for additional power generation.

In other words, this would save the PDB a lot of money required for buying and supplying primary energy like natural gas or liquid fuel, which are used for power generation. Ensuring the primary fuel has become a major concern due to several years of persistent gas crisis.

There are six power plant units in Ghorashal with four 210 MW ones. Each of these four units need 50 million SEE PAGE 6 COL 1


At least 50 students and 10 policemen were injured and over 100 vehicles and 15 buildings were vandalised when students of two private universities at Banani in the capital yesterday clashed over the alleged stalking of a female student.
