Pak Taliban 'number two sacked'

The number two commander in Pakistan's nebulous, umbrella Taliban movement has been sacked as deputy chief but will remain within the organisation, a spokesman said yesterday.

Maulvi Faqir Mohammad

is the Taliban's commander in Bajaur, one of Pakistan's seven districts in the tribal belt on the Afghan border and one that has seen a recent lull in fighting between the Taliban and Pakistani soldiers.

He was sacked on Sunday at a meeting presided over by Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan (TTP) chief Hakimullah Mehsud at a secret location in Pakistan's north-western tribal belt, spokesman Ehsanullah Ehsan told AFP by telephone.

"A shura (council) meeting was held on Sunday and it decided to remove Maulvi Faqir Mohammad from the position of deputy chief of TTP," he said, adding that

Mohammad would continue to serve the group as an ordi nary member.

Ehsan gave no reason for the removal. Neither was a successor announced.

The TTP is a loose confederation of militant commanders founded and run by Baitullah Mehsud until his

death in a US drone strike in August 2009. His killing sparked a bitter succession battle won by Hakimullah Mehsud.

A source close to the Taliban told AFP on condition of anonymity that the Bajaur commander fell out of favour with Mehsud over his alleged support for peace talks with the Pakistani government.

Mohammad also had sympathies with Mehsud's biggest rival within the TTP, Waliur Rehman, the source added.

North-western Pakistan, particularly the main city of Peshawar, has seen a recent increase in suicide and gun attacks blamed on Taliban.

UK journos are 'spies'

Says Libyan militia BBC ONLINE

Two British journalists detained in Libya are suspected of spying, the militia that is holding them says.

Faraj al-Swehli, commander of a Misrata brigade, said the men had entered Libya illegally and were carrying "incriminating evidence".

He said the activities of reporter Nicholas Davies, 37, and cameraman Gareth Montgomery-Johnson, 36, were being investigated.

The men had been working for Iran's TV station Press TV.

The BBC's Gabriel Gatehouse in Tripoli says that at a hastily convened press conference, reporters were shown video footage of what was purported to be the two journalists testfiring weapons.

The authorities will have to mark zebra crossings on streets near Matsya Bhaban, High Court Mazar Gate, Jatiya Press Club and Institute of Engineers, Bangladesh in 15 days, it said.

It also directed a deploying of adequate traffic police at the crossings.

The authorities must submit separate comprehensive reports on the number of motor vehicles operating in the city, total area of streets, pathways, walkways and foot bridges in the capital by April 10.

At the same time, the DMP commissioner was directed to submit the notifications, if issued earlier, restricting rickshaw operations in Dhaka city over the last one year, Deputy Attorney General Amit Talukder told The Daily Star.

The HC ordered the Bangladesh Road Transport Authority chairman to submit a report on the number of registered motorised

vehicles plying the city. The HC bench of Justice Mohammad Bazlur Rahman and Justice Md Habibul Gani also issued rules upon the authorities

to explain in four weeks why directives should not be given to them to ensure unhindered movement of people in the city.

In the rules, it asked the communications secretary to explain why he should not be ordered to constitute Dhaka Metropolitan Transport Authority which will regulate and coordinate the public and mass transport system.

The government was also asked to explain why it should not be directed to arrange sufficient segregated pathways for pedestrians and non-motorised vehicles and to remove all the obstacles for free movement of people through the existing walkways.

Two Supreme Court lawyers -- KM Zabir and Aynun Nahar Siddiqua -filed the two petitions in August and October last year on the basis of media reports on sufferings of people while moving in the city.

The HC heard expert opinions of Prof Sarwat Jahan, a teacher of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology, who presented a study report prepared by Japan International Cooperation Agency in 2010

on vehicles plying in Dhaka. Citing the study, he said rickshaws are more useful than private cars in terms of

occupying space. Against the 40 percent of road space they require, rickshaws transport almost 54 percent of passengers, while cars taking up 39 percent of road space, transport less than 9 percent passengers, Prof Sarwat said.

"It is thus clear that cars, not rickshaws, are the main culprit," he said.

He said bicycles use 1.7 percent of road space but transport 2.5 percent passengers; buses occupy only 6 percent of space but transport 28 percent passengers, baby taxies (auto-rickshaws) 10 percent of space but carry only 4 percent of passengers, he said.

The communications secretary, home secretary, inspector general of police, administrators of DCC North and DCC South, deputy commissioner of DMP (traffic) and its joint commissioner, and Bangladesh Road Transport Authority chairman have been made respondent to the orders and the rule.

Advocate ABM Waliur Rahman Khan appeared for the petitioners.

Inept contractor fails

the project as their mobilisation was too little.

"The company could have begun the primary work and accelerate it later on getting the land. It rather refrained from implementing the project even after the deadline had been extended by a year," said Aminur Rahman Laskar, who was in charge of the project and is now chief engineer of the RHD.

The contractor's negli gence prompted the communications ministry to drop the project in February last year. It asked the firm to complete work on the Patia bypass and the three bridges.

Officials of the RHD had several meetings with the ITCL authorities but could not make the company resume work. The firm did not even maintain the project roads as per contract.

To resolve the issue, Aminur on June 5 last year in a letter to ITCL Chairman Quazi Galib A Sattar warned him of possible conse-

quences for failing to resume the project within two weeks. The company in reply asked the RHD to withdraw

the letter. "The ITCL couldn't produce any record on utilising the mobilisation advance, which is a violation of the contract," an RHD official

told The Daily Star. As the government moved to realise the advance amount, the firm sent a legal notice demanding the initiation of an arbitration to settle the matter. It also alleged that the RHD had terminated the contract.

"Though the deal was intact, the ITCL had made the allegation to drag the RHD into a legal battle and avoid repayment of the mobilisation advance," claimed an RHD official.

Despite many attempts over several days, The Daily Star could not reach any ITCL high officials for their comments. The company office, however, gave The

Daily Star contact information on the project manager, Surajit Datta. But when contacted, Datta told The Daily Star over the telephone that he did not work for the company any more.

According to sources at the RHD, the contractor in its bidding documents had made the Dhanmondi branch of Prime Bank its guarantor. In case of any payment

default or failure in delivering the project, the deal can be cancelled and the bank is liable for the repayment of the advance money. The RHD had written to

the bank for encashment of the guarantee but the bank disagreed with those letters, citing a stay order of the High Court in this regard.

This is not the first time the company has bailed out leaving a project incomplete. It did it on at least two other occasions, leaving its work half done but taking the advance mobilisation money, RHD officials told The Daily Star.

Singapore top carbon emitter in Asia-Pacific

Affluent Singapore had the largest carbon footprint per head in the Asia-Pacific in 2010, conservation group WWF said yesterday.

The environmental advocacy group said Singapore's 2010 per capita gross domestic product of more than \$40,000 -- one of the highest in the region -fuelled exorbitant consumption habits.

But the group also fingered the corporate sector and in particular the construction industry for crowning the tiny city-state as the region's top per capita carbon emitter.

Precise figures for various nations in the Asia-Pacific will be released together with the WWF's Asia Footprint Report in June.
