Udichi tragedy day today

The 13th anniversary of Udichi tragedy will be observed today in Jessore. On this day in 1999, at least 10 people were killed and scores injured in two separate bomb explosions at the Jessore town hall during the closing ceremony of the 12th convocation of Udichi. Udichi Shilpi Goshthi has chalked out various programmes to mark the day. The programmes include wearing black badges, lighting up candle, discussion and a cultural function. The organisation demanded the trial of the murderers.

5 hurt in clash over tender

Five people were injured in a clash between the activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and Jubo League in Lalpur upazila town on Sunday morning. Of the injured, Mahmudul Haq Mukul, president of upazila Jubo League unit, and activist Arefin, were admitted to upazila health complex and Rajshahi Medical College and Hospital respectively while the rest were given first aid. Locals said the clash began at around 11:00am following an altercation between the supporters of Mukul and BCL unit president Saiful Islam over tender manipulation. On information, police rushed in and brought the situation under control, said Matiur Rahman, officer in-charge of Lalpur police station. They also arrested Jubo League activist Rebab Hossain Riko from the spot, the OC added.

Worker found dead

Police recovered the hanging body of a stone-quarry worker in Jaflong area of Goainghat upazila on Saturday. The victim is Asim Barman, 25, son of Haralal Barman of Chanpur village in Dirai upazila of Sunamganj district. The body was sent to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College and Hospital morgue for autopsy. Police said Asim did not join his duty, his co-workers went to his shanty at a colony at Ballaghat in the area at noon, found him hanging from the ceiling and informed police. Mohon Lal Talukder, sub-inspector of Goainghat police station, said it would be clear after receiving the autopsy report whether Asim committed suicide or was killed.

Three 'cheats' arrested

Police arrested three people, who used to cheat people posing them as 'jiner badshas' (kings of genies) while selling a fake gold statue at Boleya village in Kaharol upazila, on Saturday. The arrestees were identified as Anisur Rahman, 34, son of Abul Kashem of Boleya village, Abdul Mannan, 42, son of late Abdul Khaleque of Kashimpur village, and Sakiuddin, 50, son of Tajimuddin of Noyapara village, in the upazila. Officer in-charge of Kaharol police station Rabiul Islam said the three had long been engaged in making money by deceiving people in the name of giving them gold statues.

Shop owners protest acts of muscleman

Hundreds of shop owners at Gobra Bazar in Sadar upazila yesterday kept their shutters down for four hours and blocked Narail-Noapara road demanding punishment to a local influential person.

The road barricade left hundreds of vehicles stranded on both sides of the road creating a huge tailback. The protesters also brought out a procession and held a rally in the bazar area.

Expressing solidarity, the villagers also joined the shop owners.

Anwar Hossain, a shop owner at the market said that Julfikar Ali Bhutto, a local influential man, also a shop owner always mis-

behaved and assaulted other traders.

Uzzal, another shop owner said that Bhutto recently beat up four staffs including a woman of Grameen Bank branch at the bazar for ransom. When we went to the spot and protested, he threatened to set fire to my shop.

President of Gobra Bonik Samity Gautam said that Bhutto is a man of union parishad chairman and also an activist of local AL.

"We again and again complained to the chairman about his misdeeds but to no effect," he said.

Yesterday all the shop owners at the bazar decided to keep their shutters down and block Narail-Noapara road, demanding punishment to Bhutto.

College girl, elderly man commit 'suicide'

A college girl and an elderly man allegedly committed suicide in Lalmonirhat and Satkhira districts on Sunday and the day before.

A college girl allegedly killed herself by taking insecticide at Paschim Doljor village of Aditmari upazila of Lalmonirhat on Sunday, reports our correspondent.

Victim Asnaul Husna, 20, was daughter of Azimuddin. She was a second year BA student at Mozida Khatun Govt Woman's College in the district.

Quoting family members, OC of Aditmari PS Mahfuzur Rahman said, Husna returned home from her college at around 12.03pm. After a while she entered her bed room and locked it from inside. Later she was found dead when they family members entered the room breaking open the door at around 1pm.

The reason behind her suicide could not be known immediately.

In Satkhira, a 65-year-old man allegedly committed suicide at village Dhumghat Hasarchar in Shyamnagar upazila on Saturday, reports our correspondent.

The victim was identified as Prafulla Awlia of the village.

Quoting locals police said, Prafulla took his life at night by hanging from the branch of a tree near his house.

Local people and the relatives of the victim saw the body hanging from the tree in the morning and informed the police.

Prafulla committed suicide due to family feud, neighbours said.

Killing of college student sparks agitation

Several hundred locals of Chakrampur Moholla in Naogaon municipal area formed human chain, held rally and blocked Naogaon-Bogra road of Naogaon town yesterday, demanding arrest and exemplary punishment of the killers of a college student.

Speakers at a rally, held in Tulshiganga area, said that victim Rabbi Hasan, a HSC student of Shantahar Government College, was brutally killed on February 21.

Rabbi went to his cousin's house at Dogachi village in Sadar upazila on the day and locked in an altercation with his maternal uncles over a piece of disputed land. At one stage, his relatives beat him up mercilessly leaving him dead on the spot.

Victim's father Saiful

Islam filed a murder case with Naogaon model police station the same day, but police are yet to arrest the killers.

The protesters demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment of the killers.

They also gave an ultimatum to the police saying they would call a hartal in Naogaon town if the accused were not arrested within 72 hours.

Sohel Rana, ward commissioner of Naogaon municipality, Shahidul Islam, Kamal Hossain, victim's father Saiful Islam spoke at the rally, among others.

The angry locals then staged a roadblock for an hour from 11:00am.

They withdrew their programme after police rushed to the spot and assured them of taking steps to arrest the killers.
