

Youth injured by BSF men dies in Rangpur clinic

A youth, who was critically injured by BSF early Monday died at a clinic in Rangpur district on Friday evening.

Rumi Begum, wife of Golap Hossain, 26, told this correspondent that her husband was attacked by BSF of Bhimpur camp in India while returning home with other cattle traders.

According to the locals, the cattle traders went to India on March 5 morning BSF members caught four of them at Chhagaldangi village and allegedly tortured them with wooden sticks and sharp weapons.

Besides Golap of Dakkhin Daudpur village, Erfan Ali Khyani of Mamudpur and Nuruzzaman of Kasba Sadarpur were severely beaten up.

The three managed to return to Bangladesh, but BSF detained Jalil Hossain, 40, of Harinathpur village of Birampur upazila of Dinajpur.

Ariful Islam, 17-year-old son of Jalil said, his family members are yet to know the whereabouts of his father.

"Our relatives in India looked for him at different places after the BGB and BSF flag meeting but in vain", said Ariful.

On March 5 morning, death news was rife at border villages of Birampur that Jalil was killed by BSF. Later at the flag meeting, BSF confirmed that they had detained Abdul Jalil.

BGB sources at Daudpur camp said, at the flag meeting the BSF informed them that they handed over the detained man to Hilli police in Dakkhin Dinajpur.

BGB has sent a letter to BSF know the present state of Jalil, an official said.

Meanwhile, Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) personnel returned an Indian boy to Indian Border Security Force (BSF) authorities through Charaldanga border in Gomostapur upazila of Chapainawabganj on Friday afternoon.

BGB-43 Rifles Battalion Commander Lt. Col. Anwar said, Pandab Mondol, 14, of Tegharia village of Maldaha district in India, was catching fish in a river inside Bangladesh.

Local people caught him and handed over to BGB Charaldanga BOP.

Later, a BOP Commander level flag meeting was held between BGB and BSF and Pandab was handed over to BSF Kalaibari BOP Commander SK Jadev.

Huge banned guidebooks seized in Rangpur, 2 held

Detective Branch of police seized hundreds of banned guidebooks and notebooks worth Tk 12 lakh in Librarypara area on Station Road in the city on Friday and arrested two people in this connection.

Arrestees Rafiqul Islam Loton, 40, son of late Chabir Uddin of Guptapara, is the owner of New Bani Manzil Library and its salesman Alamgir Hossain, 42, son of Anser Ali of Gobardhan village under Aditmari upazila in Lalmonirhat.

On secret information, a team of DB police raided the library at dead of night and arrested Loton and Alamgir

along with 2,393 guidebooks of class I to VIII worth Tk 8.86 lakh, said sub-inspector Mostafizar Rahman.

DB police again raided the shop on Friday afternoon and seized several thousand

guidebooks and notebooks from a hidden place on the rooftop, the SI added.

Meanwhile, bookshop owners enforced a two-day long strike yesterday to protest the arrests.

Updating work of voter list starts in 2 Khulna upazilas

The first phase of updating of voter lists has begun in Rupsha and Terokhada upazilas ahead of next general elections.

According to the source of District Election Office (DEO), the updating work started in the upazilas yesterday and will continue till March.

Photographs and fingerprints of probable voters would be taken there from March 21 to June 21 at the union level voter registration centres.

Enumerators will visit door-to-door at Paikgacha and Koira upazilas from June 19 to June 28 to collect information while the process for taking photographs and scanning fingerprints would start there from June 29 and will continue till October 6.

Updating works of the electoral roll will start at Batiaghata, Digholia, Dumuria and Dakop upazilas on October 4 and will continue till October 13 while photographs and fingerprints of probable voters will be taken from October 14 to January 20 next year.

On the other hand, the updating task to collect information with enumerators, who will visit door-to-door, will start at Phultala upazila from January 18 and continue till January 27 and other areas under Sadar, Sonadanga, Khalishpur and Daulatpur Police stations of the city.

Photographs and fingerprints would be taken from January 28 to April 30, said DEO officer Bibhor Kumar Biswas.

Referring the shortage of manpower in the district and upazila election offices, he emphasised to fulfil the vacant posts to carry out the updating task smoothly.

40 injured as AL rivals clash

At least 40 people were injured in a clash between two rival groups of Awami League at Chadpur village in Kuamrkhal upazila yesterday over election of a local school managing committee.

Ferdous Ahmed, officer in-charge of Kuamrkhal police station, said two panels -- one led by Abdur Rahim Mollah and another by Sohrab Hossain contested in the election of Chadpur High School governing body held in the afternoon.

Of them, Rahim, general secretary of Chadpur union unit AL, won the election. It angered the men of Sohrab, an influential member of the unit.

Following the incident, the supporters of Rahim and Sohrab attacked each other with lethal weapon, leaving over 40 from both sides injured at around 6:30pm.

Two children drown

Two children drowned in a pond at Bhomordah village in Monirampur upazila yesterday morning.

The victims were identified as Sadia Akter, 5, daughter of Mafizur Rahman and Eva Rahman, 6, daughter of Habibur Rahman of the village.

Sources said Sadia and Eva without the knowledge of their family members went to take bath in a nearby pond of their house early in the morn-

ing and went missing.

In Gaibandha, a 6-year-old girl was killed in a wall collapse at Harinsingha village in Sadar upazila on Friday.

The deceased was identified as Afrin Akter, daughter of Raja Mia of the village.

Locals said, while Afrin was playing near her house in the morning the wall

of an under-construction building suddenly collapsed on her leaving her dead on the spot.
