Taliban vows retaliation

Outrage continues over civilian killing; US won't rush in troops pullout

Attack on Afghan officials killed at least one yesterday while Taliban wowed revenge over the killing of 16 villagers by a rogue US soldier underlining anger at the massacre.

The attack in southern Kandahar province came hours after hundreds of students chanting "Death to America" took to the streets of Jalalabad, in Afghanistan's first protest against the US army sergeant's killing spree.

Two of Afghan President Hamid Karzai's brothers were in the delegation which came under sustained gunfire, a local reporter at the scene in Panjwayi district told AFP.

Taliban insurgents have vowed revenge for the killings, and the US embassy in Kabul has warned its citizens to be on their guard, mindful of a wave of deadly protests last month over the burning of Qurans at an American military base.

The Taliban, leading a 10-year

insurgency against the foreign troops and Karzai's government, threatened to take revenge against "sickm i n d e d American savages".

The United States and its Nato allies are looking to withdraw their 130,000-odd

combat troops from Afghanistan by 2014, although Sunday's massacre in Kandahar risks exacerbating a mood of war-weariness in the West.

In Washington, Obama warned the US public against a hasty drawdown from Afghanistan, after a weekend poll said most Americans believe the war is not worth the cost and want an early withdrawal.

Though he warned against a



precipitous pullout, Obama said in a separate interview with Denver CBS affiliate KCNC that it was "important for us just to make sure that we are not... in Afghanistan longer than we need to be".

The Jalalabad students, echoing a call by the Afghan parliament on Monday, also demanded that the US soldier be tried in public in Afghanistan.

But the United States made clear that the soldier would be subject to US military law -- and that he could face execution if convicted.

Briefing reporters en route to a visit to Kyrgyzstan, Defense Secretary Leon Panetta was asked if the death penalty could apply. "My understanding is in these instances that could be a consideration," he said.

The US army sergeant was on his first tour of duty in Afghanistan after serving three tours in Iraq, according to US officials.

He left his forward operating base in Kandahar province in the predawn darkness Sunday and went on a murderous rampage before turning himself in back at the base, Afghan and American officials say.

He is accused of breaking into village homes and opening fire, killing 16 people including women and children, in an incident that has further imperiled Afghan-US relations as the countries try to craft a post-2014 partnership deal.

US drone strikes kill 15 in Pakistan

US drone aircraft struck twice in Pakistan's unruly tribal regions along the border with Afghanistan yesterday, killing 15 suspected militants, including two senior commanders of the Pakistani Taliban, security and intelligence officials

Maulvi Nazir, one of the most influential militant leaders in the region, was killed along with his eight companions in the first attack.

Seven suspected militants were killed in the second attack later in the day, when a drone fired missiles at a vehicle in the border Waziristan.

The New America Foundation think-tank in Washington says drone strikes have killed between 1,715 and 2,680 people in Pakistan in the past eight years.

India seeks to avoid mistrust with Lanka

With Tamil Nadu MPs insisting that India make its stand clear on the US-sponsored resolution against Sri Lanka in UNHRC, Prime Minister Manmohan Singh has said efforts are on to achieve a "forward-looking" outcome which would avoid "deepening confrontation and mistrust."

Meanwhile, Indian Rajya Sabha was adjourned till noon yesterday as opposition parties demanded to know the government's stand on the resolution. "We are engaged with all parties in an effort to achieve an

outcome that is forward-looking and that ensures that rather than deepening confrontation and mistrust between concerned parties a way forward is found on issues related to accountability and reconciliation," Singh told DMK chief M Karunanidhi. In a letter to the DMK leader, who demanded that India

support the US resolution against Colombo for alleged war crimes during voting, Singh said India's objective, as always, remains the achievement of a future for the Tamil community in Sri Lanka marked by equality, dignity, justice and self-respect.

Noting that India had emphasised to Sri Lanka the importance of a genuine process of reconciliation to address grievances of Tamils, he said New Delhi welcomed the report of Sri Lankan Lessons Learnt and Reconciliation Committee (LLRC).

Choudhury Manik and Justice Jahangir Hossain Selim ordered the committee to submit the investigation report by June 30 before it and also fixed July 10 for further order on the issue.

The bench, however, exempted Oli from personal appearance before it in

connection with the matter. The court also issued a rule upon the officials concerned to explain why the government should not be directed to cancel the lease agreements of the land on the beach and to explain calarea. why the allocation of the land should not be declared illegal and against public interest.

The secretaries to the ministries of cabinet, land, law, environment, civil aviation and tourism, and

home affairs, the director general of the environment department, and the deputy commissioner and the superintendent of police of Cox's Bazar have been made respondents to the rule.

Based on a report published in The Daily Star with the headline "Oli's castle on beach," the HC on February 22 issued a suomoto rule and summoned the LDP chief before it yesterday to explain his role in constructing the structure on the beach, an ecologically criti-

The report stated that Oli Ahmed, without any permission from the authorities concerned, is going to build a four-storey structure in the jhau woods on the beach that is a violation of environmental laws.

The site falls in the ecologically critical area (ECA), where any type of construction is prohibited by the Bangladesh Environment Conservation Act, 1995 (Amendment 2010), according to the report.

Supreme Court lawyers Manzill Murshid, Iqbal Kabir Lytton, and Deputy Attorney General ABM Altaf Hossain placed the report to draw the attention of the judges for necessary order that day.

Oli's counsel Moudud Ahmed yesterday told the court the reports published in The Daily Star on February 22 and 23 did not reflect the whole truth upon which the HC issued the rule. Moudud also said his

client had sent a rejoinder to The Daily Star against its two reports on the issue, but the newspaper published a small part of the rejoinder.

Moudud, however, did not place the rejoinder and replies made by The Daily Star before the court.

The court instantly asked The Daily Star correspondent, who was on duty on the court premises, to appear before it for an explanation on the allegations made by Moudud.

The correspondent told the court The Daily Star on March 2 published the rejoinder, which was sent by Oli Ahmed through his attorney, in detail with its reply and clarification.

The Daily Star reports, which were contested by Oli Ahmed, were fully correct, except an editing error.

Instead of saying a fourstorey building was being constructed, the report published on February 23 stated a four-storey building had already been constructed, he said. He added The Daily Star

on March 2 said in the reply that "This was an editing error and we stand corrected." The court asked the cor-

respondent to place an issue of The Daily Star published on March 2 containing the rejoinder and the reply before it later.

Additional Attorney General MK Rahman and Advocate Iqbal Kabir Lytton argued before the court.

EU had already chalked out a project worth \$100 million to be implemented in Myanmar for the Rohingya refugees intruding in Bangladesh.

The minister said that the EU would also be setting up an office in Myanmar to restore diplomatic ties with the country because of the changing political conditions.

"The delegation assured of extending help in the repatriation of the Rohingyas as the refugees have been causing various economic and social problems in Cox's Bazar areas," Razzaque told the reporters after the meeting.

He said that the delegates also expressed their intent to support the NGOs

(non-government organisations) in Cox's Bazar working for the welfare of the refugees.

urged them to stop the intrusion of Rohingyas in Bangladesh.

"No NGO is allowed to work there without prior approval of the local administration," he informed the delegates, adding that such restrictions were imposed to discourage the influx of the Rohingyas.

Razzaque said the activities of certain foreign NGOs in Bangladesh had also hurt the country's image.

The minister said "We are not against the activities of the NGOs. The government has also done many things for Rohingyas on humanitarian grounds but we

should not encourage more of them to come to Bangladesh." There was a mass influx
