

Patients suffer as lone health centre remains shut for *haat*

Dhaperhat health centre in Sadullapur upazila remain closed twice a week due to make-shift village market, locally known as *haat*, on its compound.

Several hundred vendors and consumers through the health centre premises every Monday and Thursday causing untold sufferings to patients of the village as they cannot consult any doctor, said locals.
Talking to this correspondent, Dhaperhat union parishad chairman Shahidul Islam Shipon said, patients were forced to visit upazila health complex as the lone health centre could not provide services on those two days.
With weekly holiday on Friday, the health centre virtually remains shut for 3-4 days in a week, he added.
Amirul Islam, principal of Hingerpara School and College, said several thousand villagers virtually depend on the services of the health centre located at a triangular point of three upazilas.
However, they remain deprived of necessary treatment on those two days due to the *haat*, he added.
The authorities seem indifferent to the matter despite frequent prayers to resolve the problem, said health and family planning officer Dr Akhter Alam.
Contacted, upazila nirbahi officer Golam Mowla said, steps would be taken soon to remove the market from the compound of the health centre.

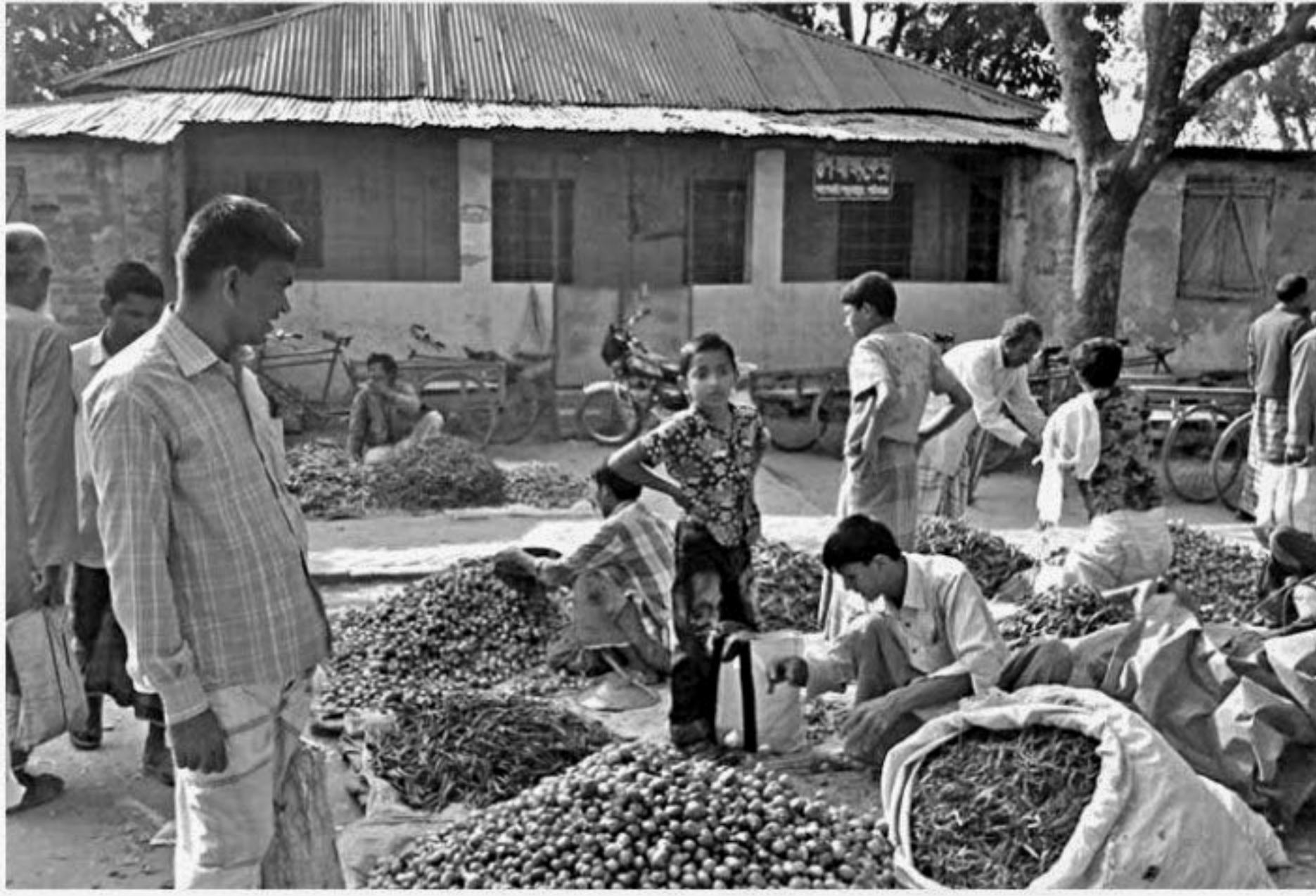

Allegation of corporal punishment

A college student was 'severely' punished by the principal on charge of stalking and other offences in Sadar upazila yesterday.
Rasel Islam, 18, son of Abdus Salam of Noyarhat Bhatri village, is an HSC first year student at Noyarhat Adorsho Degree College.
Rasel alleged that principal AKM Mahbulul Alam called him to his office at around 11:00am, tied him with a tree on the campus and tortured him for an hour in presence of teachers and students.
"I could not understand why the principal beat me mercilessly although I was innocent", said Rasel.
Refuting the allegation of Rasel, Mahbulul, also founder of the college, said he gave the student simple punishment for stalking female students for long and committing other offences.
Earlier, the college management committee issued a temporary suspension notice on Rasel for such unwanted activities three months ago, he added.
Rabiul Islam Robi, a lecturer of the college, said the principal gave corporal punishment to Rasel as he did not attend classes regularly and committed a number of offences.
Meanwhile, Rasel's mother Arzina Begum said her son was not involved in any offences.
Abdus Salam said, they did not file any complaint over the issue as the principal was a very influential man in the area.

An outlaw and prime accused in AL leader Salam Mridha killing case was murdered by rivals at a village in Goalunda upazila of Rajbari district on Monday night.
The deceased was identified as Mohan Sardar, 40, son of Pachu Sardar of Kachnandapur village in Sadar upazila and a top cadre of outlawed Sarbahara Party.

In fear, she cried for help. Locals caught Ammulya and handed him over to police. He was produced before the court led by executive magistrate Golam Mowla, said Sadullapur police.

Ex-firefighter murdered

A former firefighter was stabbed to death allegedly by his neighbours at Kolabaria village in Kalia upazila early yesterday. The deceased is Abu Jafor Sheikh, 65, son of Jalal Sheikh of the village. Police recovered the body and sent it to Narail Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy. Locals found Jafor's body lying on Kolabaria Bazar Road and informed police. Sarwar Hossain, officer in-charge of Naragati police station, said there was a longstanding clash between Jafor and his neighbours over a disputed land. He might have been killed by them, the OC added.

Two siblings drown

Two siblings drowned in Netai River in Dhubaura upazila yesterday afternoon. The victims are Shariful Haque, 6 and Ariful Haque, 8, sons of Azizul Haque, a day labourer of frontier village Kalsindur. Mir Alimuzzaman, officer in-charge of Dhubaura police station, said Shariful accidentally fell into the river while he was playing on a boat at around 3.30 pm. In the mean time, Ariful, who was on the bank of the river, jumped into the river to save his brother. Both of them did not know how to swim.

Woman, daughter burnt to death in Rajshahi fire

A woman and her daughter were burnt to death in a fire at Helenabad Colony in the city on Monday.

The dead are Shimi Khatun, 24, wife of Ziaul Islam and her daughter Sumaiya, 3.

Rajshahi Sadar fire station officer Khurshid Anwar said residents of the building informed them that they noticed smoke billowing from the first floor.
On information, a firefighting unit rushed to the spot but the fire was doused before they arrived.
Rescuers recovered the charred bodies of the mother and the daughter from the kitchen by breaking open the door of the house.
The bodies were sent to hospital for autopsy.
Firefighters said, the fire

originated from electric short circuit while the woman was cooking in a rice cooker.
In Naogaon, an elderly woman who sustained burn injuries at Khas Naogaon in the district town on Saturday, died at hospital early Sunday.
The deceased was identified as Rabeya Khatun, 50, wife of Khalilur Rahman of the area.
Family sources said, Rabeya suddenly caught fire while lighting up a hurricane lamp after electricity went out on Saturday evening.
She was rushed to Naogaon Sadar Hospital and later shifted to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital on the night following deterioration of her condition.
She succumbed to her injuries at the RMCH in the early hours of Sunday.

Bogra Jubo League leader killed

A local Jubo League leader was stabbed to death at Central High School playground at Sutrapur in the town on Monday night.
The dead is Abdullah, 35, son of Sheikh Belal, a resident of Eidgah Lane in Sutrapur.
Witnesses said a gang mercilessly beat him with cricket stumps and stabbed him with sharp weapons, leaving him dead on the spot.
On information police recovered the body and sent it to Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College Hospital for autopsy.
