## Dhaka in disorder

*Students, transport workers go berserk over death, arrest*

City commuters suffered badly as traffic came to a standstill for hours yesterday owing to separate clashes between students, police and transport workers in Gulshan, Mirpur and Dhaka College areas. Tailbacks on both sides of the roads in these areas caused severe traffic congestions, which also clogged other roads across the capital. Law enforcers were seen struggling to ease the traffic chaos and avert vandalism by diverting vehicles to other roads. In Gulshan, several hundred students of Titumir College clashed with police, demanding the release of 26
