Tiger kills crab catcher

Tiger killed a man in Baintala Canal area in the Sundarbans yesterday. The dead was identified as Amir Hossain, 35 son of Ajibar Rahman Gazi of Kalinchi village under Shyamnagar upazila of Satkhira. Police quoted locals as saying that Amir Hossain came under attack while he was catching crabs in the canal. A tiger swooped on him and dragged him into the deep forest, they added.

ITF in Khulna from Apr 9

The month long 11th International Trade Fair (ITF) will start at Circuit House Maidan in Khulna city from April 9. Khulna Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KCCI) and Messrs Dhruvo Enterprise are jointly organising the fair. Countries like Pakistan, Iran, China, Taiwan and South Korea have already confirmed their participation, booking stalls and pavilions. The fair will be most impressive and free from any sort of obscenity, said Shafiqur Rahman Palash, proprietor of Dhruvo Enterprise. 190 bullets found

Police said locals found the bullets while they were fishing in a water body in Shimultoli area of the upazila at around 2:30pm. Being informed, police went to the spot and took the bullets to Birampur Police Station.

Abducted girl rescued

A teenage girl, abducted by a gang from Narail municipality area on March 26, was rescued from a house at South Fotepur village under South Matlab Police station of Chadpur district on Monday. Victim's father filed a case with Narail Sadar Police Station the same day, accusing two youths--Sajol Biswas, 25, son of Shohid Biswas of Voakhali area under Narail Municipality, and Md Sumit Hasan Sohad, 24, son of Delowar Hossain Munshi of Brahmamanda village under Lohagara upazila of the district. Acting on a tip-off, a police team led by SI Amir Hossain of Narail Police Station raided the house of Late Abdul Malek at the village and rescued the girl. The kidnapers fled the scene, sensing the presence of the law enforcers. Sub-Inspector (SI) Amir Hossain, also the investigation officer (IO) of the case, said the two picked up the girl from Bir Shrestha Nur Mohammad Stadium premises while she was going to the stadium to witness a programme on the Independence Day.

Boy drowns in pond

A seven-year-old boy drowned in a pond at Mahmudpur village in Shyamnagar upazila on Sunday. He was identified as Sanjoy Saha, 7 son of Ratan Saha. Police quoted locals as saying that Sanjoy slipped into the pond while he was walking along its bank in the afternoon. Locals found the body floating yesterday and recovered it.

LOOTING, TORCHING HOUSES OF AL MEN

Jamaat leader Subhan, 30 others sued in Pabna after 9 years

A case has been filed against Jamaat leader and former lawmaker Maulana Abdus Subhan and 30 other BNP-Jamaat men on charge of looting, torching and vandalising houses at four villages in Chartarapur union under Sadar upazila in 2003.

Md Abdul Kuddus, former member of Chartarapur union parishad and a local Awami League leader, lodged the case with Pabna police station on Monday night after nine years of the incident.

The other accused

include Chartarapur UP chairman Rahmat Ali Sheikh and former Tantiband UP chairman Abdur Rouf, both local BNP leaders, said Enayet Uddin, officer in-charge of the PS.

The complainant in his case stated that a number of criminals, led by Subhan, Rahmat and Rouf, swooped on AL men's residences at Khapradangi, Daspara, Chokdarpara and Goyal Bari villages following a political feud, leaving over 200 people injured on August 30 in 2003.

They also vandalised

later, those were looted and set on fire.

Subhan was the mastermind behind the gruesome attack, the plaintiff said.

He said they could not file any case against the aforesaid people immediately after the incident as political environment was not favourable and police refused to take the case.

Refuting the allegations, the Jamaat leader said he was in parliament assembly when the incident took place. The case has been filed to harass me, he said.

VGD rice recovered

Fifty-six sacks of Vulnerable Group Development (VGD) rice were recovered from a godown in Duoshuo union of Baliadangi upazila on Monday afternoon.

Upazila nirbahi officer Md Moniruzzaman also sealed off the union parishad godown for possessing the rice illegally.

The UNO said following allegations from locals, a team led by him raided the godown.

According to the allegation, union parishad chairman Mokhlesur Rahman Chowdhury was distributing rice 24/25 kilograms to each beneficiary instead of 30 kg.

Later, 56 sacks of VGD rice sanctioned for distribution among poor people were recovered from there, he added.

There is a total of 269 beneficiaries in the union under the programme, said the UNO.

Contacted, the UP chairman said the rice was not distributed among only 23 beneficiaries due to various reasons while the rest of it was used for other projects.

KILLING OF TWO AL MEN

2 of 35 accused held in Gangni

Police yesterday arrested two of the 35 accused in the case for killing two Awami League (AL) activists in Gangni upazila of Meherpur on Monday.

The arrestees are Sariful Islam and Apel Uddin of Chargoal village in the upazila.

Awami League activists Habil Uddin, 60, and Atahar Ali, 46, were killed and 50 others injured during a clash between BNP and AL men over capturing a char in the river Mathabhanga.

Lalon Hossain, one of the injured, filed the case with Gangni Police Station on Monday night accusing 35 people including local BNP leader Atiar Rahman.

The clash ensued when

AL activists led by Atahar Ali went to the char to harvest wheat at around 11:30 am. BNP men led by its union general secretary Atiar Rahman swooped on them with lethal weapons. Officer-In-Charge of Gangni Police Station Golam Mustafa, said.

Habil died on the spot while Atahar succumbed to his injuries on the way to Kushtia General Hospital. The injured are undergoing treatment at different hospitals and private clinics in Meherpur and Kushtia.

The clash followed a longstanding dispute between the two sides over capture of about 500 bighas of char land, the OC told this correspondent.

"We are trying to arrest main accused Atiar and 32 others," the OC further said.

Armed BCL men take away SAU tender papers

A group of BCL men took away tender documents from the tender box at the Sylhet Agricultural University (SAU) on Monday.

Sources said, the university staff could not resist them as there was no security arrangements on the last date for dropping the tenders for Tk 1 crore work.

Witnesses said, about 6 to 7 young men in a private car went to the office of the Director, Planning & Development at SAU and took away the documents by breaking the lock of the tender box at about 12:30pm.

The tender box was scheduled to be opened at 3pm on the day.

The armed group, allegedly backed by BCL chief of Sylhet Govt College, threatened the office staff with dire consequences in case of any step against

them, sources said. Contacted, SAU Director, Planning & Development, Kamal Uddin Ahmed told this correspondent that he could not raise a hue and cry at the time of the incident since the group was armed.

The staff members except for a peon, were absent, he said adding he could not identify the culprits.

The official declined to give further details about the snatching of tender documents from his office. The tender would be cancelled and it would be invited afresh, he added.

The Tk one crore tender was invited for completion of civil, sanitary, electrification and gas work at Abdus Samad Azad Hall.

The superintending engineer of the SAU could not be contacted despite several attempts over phone.
