International Linkages and Collaboration

1. IBA Karachi and IBA Dhaka have signed an MOU in June 2011 to promote and expand international development, understanding and friendship by stimulating and supporting educational, professional and intercultural activities.

2. An MOU has been signed between IBA and Quinnipiac University, New Heaven, USA in 2011 to establish and facilitate educational cooperation and academic exchanges.

3. A faculty fellowship MOU namely Wells-Ghani faculty fellowship has been signed between IBA and Kelly School of Business, Indiana University in December 2011. This initiative is a landmark in renewing the linkage between IBA and Indiana University, which was IBA's founding partner in 1966.

4. A collaboration on student exchange and transfer arrangements are in the process of finalization between IBA and University of Surrey, UK following the visit of Director, IBA to Surrey in December 2011 and subsequent reciprocal visit of the Surrey officials to IBA in February 2012.

5. IBA is one of the key founder members (1988) of the Association of Management Development Institutions of South Asia (AMDISA) which is headquartered at Hyderabad, India. The association caters to faculty and institutional development of their member organizations and also provides accreditation of business schools known as South Asian Quality Assurance Service (SAQS).

Management Development Program (MDP)

The Management Development Program of the institute is geared towards helping individual managers and organizations augment their management development efforts. The services provided by the program include management trainings, seminars, workshops and executive forums. A Chairperson heads the Management Development Program. At present the program is headed by Professor Saeed Alamgir Jafar.

IBA Alumni Association (IBAAA)

The IBA Alumni Association is one of the most diverse alumni networks in the country. This association acts as a conduit between IBA and the former graduates. Besides annual conventions and similar collegial events, the association holds seminars and workshops on topical issues on a regular basis and publishes a magazine named "Business Executive". The association is presently led by Mr. Nazmul Hassan MP as its President and M. Rafiqul Islam as General Secretary.
