Youth stabbed to death

A young man was stabbed to death in Chattakumira area under Sadar upazila on Wednesday. The victim, Abdur Rahman, 28, of the area, is a worker of an engineering workshop named 'Rahman Scale'. Quoting family members, Muhammed Atiar Rahman, officer in-charge of Sadar Police Station, said victim's co-worker Nasima Begum, 42, who has been recently sacked, blamed him over her termination. Following the issue, she made a call at night and asked Abdur to come her home. At one stage, Nasima attacked him with a knife, leaving him injured seriously. He was rushed to Saheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College and Hospital where he died, the OC added.

Fake currency trader held

2 drug peddlers arrested

Schooling eludes kids in two Jamuna chars

Several hundred children of two char areas (newly emerged landmass) under Shapdhori union of Islampur upazila of the district are totally deprived of education just for want of a primary school.

Besides, the people of the areas are not getting health services due to lack of health centres for long.

The two chars, known as Bishroshi and Projapoti, emerged in Jamuna River in 1986 and it followed human settlement there.

Bishroshichar and Projapoti in the middle of the river are cut off from the other villages of the union. So the children of the two char areas cannot go to schools located at other villages due to risky and troublesome communication.

The children of Bishroshichar are reluctant to go to Chengania Government Primary School at village Chengania of the union as they are to walk at least two kilometres through

sandy path and cross around half a kilometre of river by boat.

On the other hand, the children of Projapoti do not go to Charshishua Govt Primary School at all as they are to walk four kilometre sandy path and cross half a kilometre of river.

The situation has been prevailing since the start of human settlement at Bishroshichar and Projapoti and thus people of the areas have become illiterate and so do the children, said the char people.

During a recent visit to the areas, people, mostly marginal and poor farmers and fishermen, told this correspondent that they could not have education just for want of schools.

Marginal farmer Sekandar Sheikh of Bishroshichar said, "I am a hapless man as I could not make my three sons and two daughters educated. If there was a primary school here, many of our children would have the light of education,"

he said.

Another poor farmer Fakir Ali of Projapoti, which is about 5km away from Bishroshichar, expressed similar views and added that it was high time to set up a primary school in the char to ensure education of their children.

Meanwhile the people of the two char areas are suffering badly for want of a community clinic and union health centre.

People of the two chars alleged that they do not get health services as they are living in remote char areas.

The upazila health complex is around 18km away from the two chars.

Patients have to walk three km, cross five km of Jamuna River and then go another 10 km by motor vehicles to reach the health complex.

Serious patients, especially children, elderly people, pregnant women become the worst sufferers when they are taken to the upazila health complex amid such troublesome

communication.

Contacted, Shapdhori union chairman Asaduzzaman Asad said that about 2,000 people of Bishroshi and 3,000 others of Projapoti remain deprived of education as there is no school in those areas.

"Even no NGOs have come forward with formal or informal schooling for the children yet," he said.

"Moreover, people are suffering much as there is no community clinic there," he added.

Erosion leaves 33 families homeless

At least 33 families at two villages under Lalmonirhat Sadar upazila have lost their dwelling houses in the last three days due to erosion by the Dharla River.

People of Ghatpar and Shimulbari villages said the erosion by the river has taken a serious turn, devouring homesteads one after another.

Dobiar Rahman of Ghatpar village said, "My house has been eroded. Now I along with four other family members have taken

shelter in a relative's house at neighboring village."

Abdal Hossain, 50, of Shimulbari village said, "At least 18 families at the village have been made homeless by the Dharla since Tuesday."

The river devoured his homestead yesterday and he along with five other members of his family have taken shelter at the adjoining village.

Erosion-hit Montez Ali, 65, of Ghatpar village said Dharla has devoured half of a hundred acres of cultivable land. Some orchards and bamboo clusters have already gone into the river, he added.

16 get life for killing grocer in Feni

A court here yesterday sentenced 16 people to life imprisonment for killing a grocer in Dagon Bhuiyan upazila of the district in 2004.

Judge Muhammad Harunur Rashid of the Additional District Judge's Court pronounced the verdict. He also fined the convicts Tk 10,000 each, in default they are to suffer another two months in jail.

The convicts are Main Uddin, 23, Mozammel, 26, Didar, 31, Fakhrul Islam, 32, Jahangir Alam, 21, Abul Kalam, 25, Nabi, 25, Nayan, 25, Mir Hossain, 22, Yasin, 23, Halim, 24, Kamal Uddin, 32, Jane Alam alias Jana, 20, Joyal Abedin alias Moqbul, 19, Ratan, 23 and Harun, 28.

They all are from Khushipur village in the upazila.

Six of them--Main, Mozammel, Didar, Fakhrul, Jahangir and Kalam--are now in jail while the rest still at large.

According to the prosecution, a gang of 17 people entered the grocery shop of Nur Alam Sohag at Gozaria Bazar in Dagon Bhuiyan upazila on the night of April 13 in 2004.

When Sohag asked them to pay their dues and refused to sell them goods on credit, they became furious and beat him dead.

Sohag's father Habib Ullah filed a murder case with Dagon Bhuiyan Police Station the following day, accusing 17 people. One of them named Rafiq Ullah alias Rafique Member died during the trial of the case.
