Showcause on Pabna municipal authorities

The Department of Environment (DOE) yesterday issued a show-cause notice to Pabna municipal authorities for dumping toxic bitumen into Ichhamoti River.

Director (monitoring and enforcement) Md Munir Chowdhury issued the notice following a report published on the national page of The Daily Star the same day headlined 'Toxic bitumen dumped in river'.

Md Tobibur Rahman, executive engineer of Pabna municipality, has been summoned to DOE headquarters in Dhaka on April, 25 to explain why legal action against the municipal authorities should not be taken for polluting water of Ichhamoti River.

Pabna municipal authorities on Saturday dumped toxic bitumen, a black sticky road-surfacing material obtained from tar, into the river beside an under construction road at Singa point in the municipality. The authorities dumped

the toxic substance, saying that it was not fit for use.

According to the **Environment Protection** Act, dumping of toxic chemicals into river is a punishable offence, the Doe director stated in the letter. "After receiving the letter,

we have asked the contractor concerned to lift five drums containing bitumen from the river and dumped them at any other suitable place," engineer Tobibur Rahman said.

More people hurt, held on second day of hartal

At least 130 people were injured in sporadic clashes in districts yesterday, the second day of countrywide hartal enforced by BNP.

Police also picked up at least 152 people from different areas of the districts during hartal hours, report our correspondents.

BNP called the countywide general strike to protest 'forced disappearance' of the party's Organising Secretary (Sylhet division) and former lawmaker M Ilias Ali from the capital on Tuesday night.

In Chittagong: sporadic incidents marked hartal in the port city yesterday. Police arrested at least 25 BNP activists from different points.

Police and BNP men officer-in-charge of clashed in front of the city BNP office at Kazir Dewri at around 12:30pm. Police fired tear gas shells to disperse the BNP activists.



At least 35 houses and five shops were gutted in Natore and Satkhira districts yesterday and the day before.

The houses were gutted in four separate fire incidents in Natore district yesterday noon, reports our correspondent.

Ten houses were gutted at Tamaltola Adarsha Gram under Bagatipara upazila. The fire originated from an electric short circuit at a house of the area and soon spread to the adjacent houses.

The victim families claimed that the extent of damage caused by the fire would be around Tk 10 lakh.

In a separate fire incident in the same upazila, 11 houses were gutted at Pravatpur village. Locals said that the fire originated from the kitchen at Md. Sazdar Rahman's house.

The victims claimed that the fire damaged property worth Tk 20 lakh.

In Lalpur upazila, 14 houses were gutted in Udhanpur-Ramkrisnapur village. The fire originated from the kitchen at Zakat Ali's house.

The affected house owners claimed that the extent of loss from the fire could go up to Tk 14 lakh. In Satkhira, at least five shops were gutted
