SI stabbed

A gang of criminals stabbed a sub-inspector of Detective Branch (DB) of police on Dhaka-Barisal highway at Bajitpur in Rajoir upazila on Wednesday midnight. Victim Anwar Hossain yesterday said the gang in a microbus intercepted his motorbike at around 11:00am while he was returning to Madaripur Sadar from Gopalganj after giving deposition in a case filed under the Women and Children Repression Act. They introduced themselves as Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) members and asked him to get into the vehicle. As he refused, the gang stabbed him indiscriminately, leaving him injured seriously. On information, police sent him to Madaripur Sadar Hospital, said Anwar.

Teacher commits 'suicide'

A college teacher allegedly committed suicide at his residence in Keshabpur upazila early yesterday. Victim Abdul Alim, 40, son of late Abdul Hakim Sarder of Chaluahati in Manirampur upazila, is a lecturer of Mohakhali Gas and Ceramic College in Dhaka. Keshabpur police said Alim killed himself by taking poison at his bed room following a family feud. On information, the law enforcers recovered the body and sent it to hospital morgue for autopsy.

Youth electrocuted

A young man was electrocuted at village Shalley in Sadar upazila yesterday. The deceased is Abu Taher, 24, son of Abdul Majid of the village. Taher came in contact with a live wire while he was switching off his motor in their court yard and died on the spot at about 2:00pm, said Aslam Khan, officer in-charge of Sadar Police Station.

Grenade, rifle found

CLASHES OVER LAND IN TWO DISTRICTS

One killed, over 100 injured

Clashes over capture of khas and disputed lands left one person dead and over 100 others injured in Satkhira and Sunamganj districts yesterday. In Satkhira, a man was killed and at least 12 others were injured as two rival groups clashed over capture of a disputed over at village Alhadipur in Tala upazila yesterday afternoon, reports our correspondent.

The dead identified as Ashraf Ali, 30, son of Abdus Samad of the village.

Police quoted locals as saying that there had been a dispute between Sohrab Ali

Morol and Abdul Aziz over the ownership of a land at the village for long.

Abdul Aziz attacked the day labourer, Ashraf Ali, engaged by Sohrab Ali for planting banana plants on the land at around 4:00pm. Ashraf received injuries and died on the spot.

On receiving the news, Sohrab and his men rushed to the spot and locked in a clash with Aziz and his supports. At least 12 people from both sides were injured during the clash that continued for half an hour.

Being informed, police reached there and dispersed the clashing groups. They also arrested five people from

the spot. They are Aziz Morol, Liakat Ali Morol, Ahad Ali, Yunus Ali, Mohsin and Raju.

The injured were admitted to Tala Upazila Health Complex.

Our staff correspondent from Sylhet reported that two groups of villagers clashed over capture of khas land at Shaktirgaon village in Chhatak upazila of Sunamganj district yesterday, leaving at least 100 people from both sides injured.

Police quoting locals said there had been a long standing dispute between former UP member Azam Ali and Borhan uddin of the village over capture of khas land at

the village at around 9:00am.

Two supporters of Azam and Borhan had an altercation over the issue at around 9:00am. After a while, the villagers belonging to the two rivals groups locked in a fierce clash.

On information, police reached the village and fired 15 tear shells to bring the situation under control. Of the injured, seven were admitted to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College and Hospital while the rest to Chhatak health complex.

CASE AGAINST JMB CADRES

Arrest warrants against 3 Rab men for skipping court as witnesses

Arrest warrants have been issued against three Rab men for skipping a court as witnesses of a case filed by the elite force against two members of outlawed Jama'atul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB).

Additional District and Sessions Judge's Court, Dinajpur, issued the warrants for arrest of Md Asrafal Alam, Md Arif and Md Shahin of Rab-5 of Joypurhat on Tuesday afternoon, court sources said.

The court also directed the Rab headquarters to execute the order and produced the three before it (court).

On December 3, 2008, a Rab team raided the house of Md Shahidul Islam, 55, a member of JMB, at Kasigari

village under Ghoraghat upazila of Dinajpur and arrested him with bomb making materials, books on jihad and leaflets.

On the basis of his statement, members of the elite force arrested Rafiqul Islam, military commander (Northern region) of the outfit, from Chapainawabganj.

Later, a case was filed against the JMB men with Ghoraghat Police Station under Anti-Terrorism Act. Rab members Asrafal, also the complainant, Arif and Shahin have been made witnesses of the case.

Court sources said the accused JMB members Shahidul and Rafiq were produced in the court and later sent to Dinajpur Jail as the witnesses were absent.

The court fixed July 4 for hearing of the case.

Man gets life for murder

UNB, Sylhet

A court here on Wednesday sentenced a man to life imprisonment in a murder case.

The convict is Koyes Uddin, son of late Faruk Uddin of Nagar village in Golapganj upazila.

The court also fined him Tk 50,000, in default, he is to

suffer 5 years more in jail.

According to the prosecution, one Fakhrul Islam of the village was stabbed to death by Koyes and his following a disputed over a land on April 28, 1998.

The victim's brother Nazrul Islam filed a case accusing Koyes and six others.

Non-govt teachers hold rally to press for 17-pt demand

Teachers and employees of non-government high schools and colleges of the district yesterday brought out a procession and held a rally in the town to press home their 17-point demand including nationalisation of the education system.

Under the banner of Bangladesh Shikshak-Karmachari Oikya Parishad (BSKOP), they also held a rally on the deputy commissioner's office premises.

The speakers at the rally urged the government to take necessary steps to implement the education policy-2010 immediately.

They criticised the government for giving them Tk 150 as house rent and Tk 100 as medical allowance.

They demanded the prime minister's intervention to end discrimination in the education system.

They also threatened to go for a tougher agitation programme if the demands were not met immediately.

Later, they submitted a memorandum to the prime minister through the DC.

Among others, convener of BSKOP Manikganj district unit and president of the district unit of Bangladesh College-Biswabidyalaya-Shikshak Samity Mir Mokhsedul Alam, spoke.
