Two girls rescued while being trafficked to India

Police yesterday rescued two teenage girls while they were being trafficked to India through the border under Kaliganj upazila of the district and arrested an alleged trafficker.

The arrestee was identified as Babu Lal Gain, 23, son of Jogesh Chandra Gain of Kalmegha village in

Shyamnagar upazila.

Both the girls hail from Eranda village under Kotwali Police Station of Jessore district, said police.

Babu, who had been residing in India for long, recently came to his village home.

AKM Ali Nur, officer in-charge of Kaliganj Police Station, said the alleged trafficker, who introduced himself as Muslim, lured the

father of one of the victims to marry her and brought the girl along with her friend to Kaliganj Bus Stand.

Later, locals caught the trio following their suspicious movement and informed police. The accused was produced before a court that sent him to jail.

Babu brought the duo there in a bid to take them to India along with him, the OC added.

45 sued on charge of attack on police in Gaibandha

Forty-five people have been sued on charge of attack on police at Protap village in Sadullapur upazila of the district on Monday.

Injured police Sub-Inspector (SI) Mosharraf Hossain filed the case with Sadullapur Police Station on Tuesday.

A police team came under attack at Protap village after they arrested three people for their alleged involvement in a clash between the two rival groups of villagers over the ownership of a land on Monday morning.

The clash ensued when Suruzzaman of Protap village and his men equipped with lethal weapons went to a disputed land for harvesting boro paddy.

On receiving the news, Mukul Chandra Mohonta, who also claims the ownership of the land, and his supporters came to the spot and attacked their rivals. During the clash, at least 21 people from both sides injured.

Being informed, police went to the village and

dispersed the clashing groups. As cops picked up three people, including Mohonta from the spot, Mohanta's supporters barricade the road demanding release of arrestees.

When police charged batons on the unruly men, they hurled brick chips on the law enforcers, leaving SI Mosharraf Hossain, SI Mofizuddin, ASI Abdul Jalil, ASI Rahman, ASI Rabiul Islam, constables Abdul Latif, Mohidul Islam, Mokhesur Rahman, Musa Mia and Ganesh Chandra injured.

Later Mahfuzur Rahman ASP (Circle) with additional police force went to Protap village and brought the situation under control.

After filing of the case, male residents of the village fled their homes to avoid arrest.

Contacted, Abdul Jalil Sarker, officer-in-charge (OC) Sadullapur Police Station, said innocent people would not be arrested. Police will arrest only the accused in the case, The OC added.

HSC examinee murdered in Sailkupa

An HSC (Higher Secondary Certificate) examinee was murdered at Dulapur village in Shaikupa upazila yesterday morning.

The victim, Billal Hossain, 25, son of Fazlur Rahman of Charshantidanga village under Sadar upazila of Kushtia district, was appearing in the ongoing HSC examinations from DM College in Shaikupa upazila.

Family sources said Billal went out of their house at around 7:00pm and did not return home at night.

Locals found his body at a banana orchard of the village at around 9:30am and informed the police who recovered the body and sent it to Jhenidah Sadar Hospital for autopsy.

Police said the assailant shot him and then slit his throat. Quoting a relative of the victim, Shahidul Islam, officer in-charge of Shaikupa Police Station, said Billal, also an activist of Chhatra Moitre, was involved in drug peddling.

His rival peddlers might have killed him and dumped the body in the orchard, said the OC.

Six shops gutted


