'Gamcha' carries the day for Anurag Kashyap's team

'Gamcha', the common folks' towel, was the cynosure of all eyes at the prestigious Cannes Film Festival recently when Bollywood filmmaker Anurag Kashyap's latest work was premiered there.

Anurag, actors Manoj Bajpayee and Nawazuddin Siddiqui and other members of the cast of the filmmaker's "Gangs of Wasseypur", a thriller on the coal mafia in eastern India, threw red-check 'gamchas' over their shoulders when they walked onto the dais before the screening of the six-hour movie.


