Youth held with bombs

Kalia police yesterday arrested one person with four hand bombs in Kulsur school area in Kalia upazila town. The arrestee is Ebad Sheikh, 28, son of late Sultan Sheikh of Ghatbila village in Mollaher Hat union under Bagherhat district. Motiar Hossain, officer-in-charge of Kalia PS said locals caught Ebad with the bombs and handed him over to police. A case was filed in this connection.

Schoolgirl drowns

An eleven-year-old girl drowned in a shrimp enclosure at village Betangi in Shyamnagar upazila yesterday afternoon. The victim was identified as Trishna Mondal, daughter of Shyamal Mondal, of village Betangi. Quoting local people police said, Trishna, a class five student at Paschim Atulia Primary School was returning home from the school. All on a sudden she fell into the shrimp enclosure and drowned at about 2:30pm.

Motorbike lifters arrested

UNB, Brahmanbaria

Police arrested three motorbike thieves from Akhaura municipality area early Sunday. The arrestees were identified as Sohag Mia, 28, Kabir Hossain, 27, and Asad Chowdhury, 30. Police said the trio stole the motorbike of one Mobarak Hossain Ratan from Sarak Bazar of the municipality on May 2 and sold it at Homna of Comilla. Acting on secret information, a team of Homna police recovered the stolen bike from Kalima Bazar under the police station on Saturday night and informed Akhaura police of the incident. Later, police raided Sarak Bazar area in the early hours of Sunday and arrested the three thieves.

Trader murdered

A trader was murdered at Shantirhat village under Nalerchar union in Hatiya upazila yesterday morning. The deceased was identified as Md. Nuruzzaman, 32, son of Abu Taher Majhi of the village. Moktar Hossain, officer-in-charge of Hatiya police station said, Nuruzzaman, a grocer at Shantirhat Ghat, was going to his house after closing his shop around 11.30pm. As he did not reach his house after several hours, his father and family members searched for him. Later locals found his body beside a canal near Shantirhat Ghat at around 7am.

Farmer found dead

A farmer who went missing in Boraigram upazila on Saturday was found dead on Sunday. Police recovered the body of Amirul Islam, 40, a resident of Bhabanipur village in the upazila, from a crop field. Police said locals saw the body in the morning and informed them. Family sources said Amirul went missing while returning home from nearby Bonpara Bazar on Saturday night. The reason behind the killing could not be known.

Call to remove session jam

Students of 15 departments at Pabna Edward College demonstrated on the campus and at the district headquarters yesterday demanding removal of session jam. The aggrieved students formed a human chain on the college campus and later brought out a procession in the district town. They also submitted a memorandum to the education minister through the deputy commissioner, Pabna. In the memo, the students said, they were losing 2-3 years while completing a course.

Landslide kills one

A worker was killed and another was injured in a landslide while digging a well to set up latrine in Belkuchi upazila yesterday noon. The victim was identified as Abdur Razzak, 25, son of late Mozammel Haque of Ghatina village under Ullapara upazila. Locals said the two were digging a well at the residence of Korban Ali at Dhulgagrakhali village. All of a sudden a big chunk of earth fell on them. Local people took them to Belkuchi upazila health complex where the doctor declared Abdur Razzak dead. Injured Moshir Rahman is undergoing treatment at the health complex.

BNP factions clash

At least 20 leaders and workers of two BNP factions were injured as they clashed for about one hour in the town Sunday morning. Seriously injured Latif, 35, and Nazirul Islam, 30, were admitted into Bagerhat Sadar Hospital. Police charged baton to disperse the clashing groups. Bagerhat Sadar police station sub-inspector Harun-or-Rashid said, the clash started when two factions of BNP led by district BNP president MA Salam and joint general secretary Khadem Niamul Nasir went to Puraton Bazar crossing to hold rallies as part of the party's central programme demanding release of the jailed central leaders. During the hour-long clash both groups threw brickbats at each other and used sticks. A grocery shop and a tea stall in Puraton Bazar area were also ransacked.

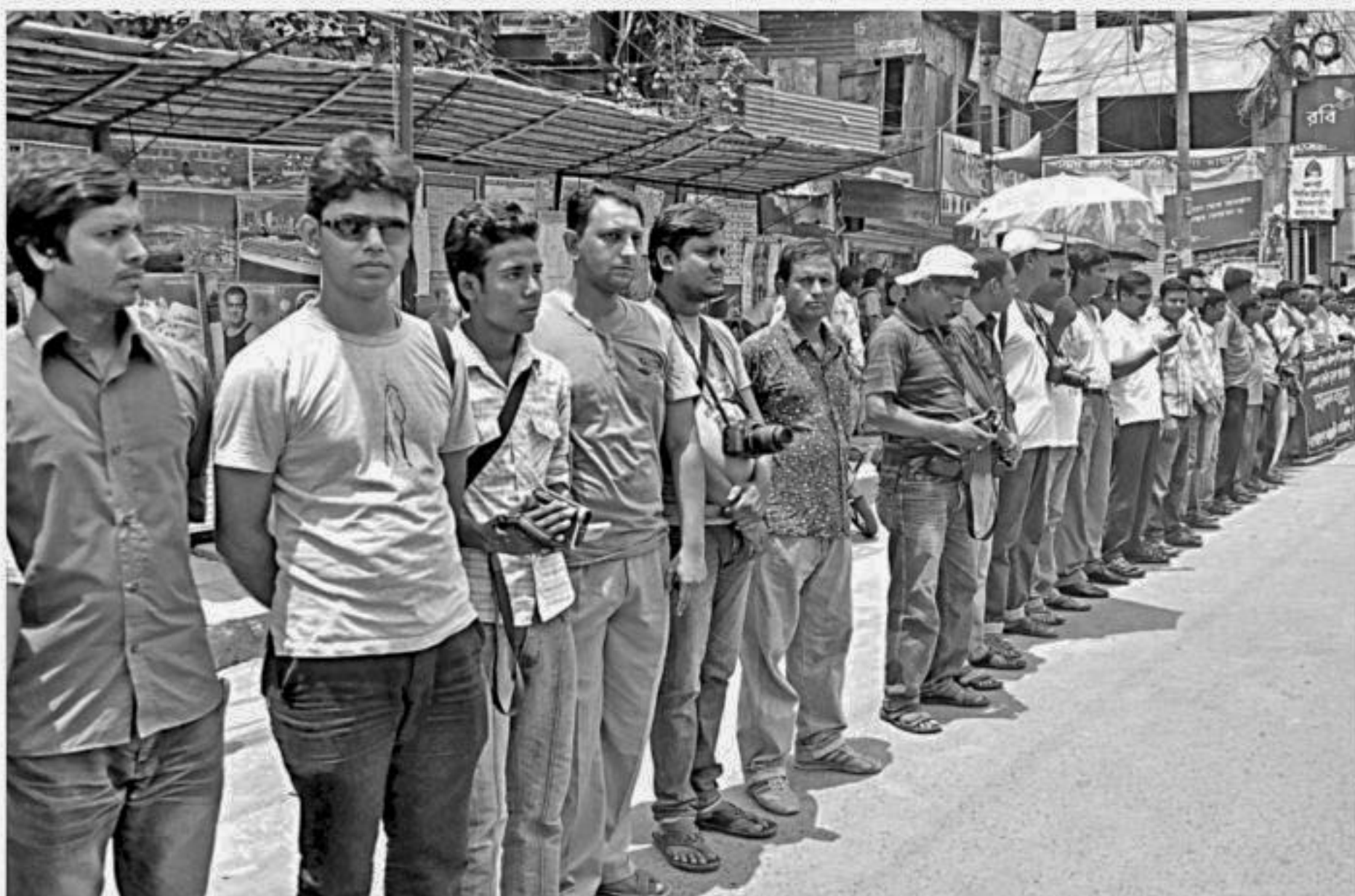

2 electrocuted in Jessore, Nilphamari

Two people were electrocuted in Jessore and Nilphamari districts yesterday and on Sunday.

In Jessore, a shopkeeper died following a severe electric shock at his shop at Khedapara Bazar in Monirampur upazila yesterday morning.

The victim was identified as Shankar Paul, 35, son of Bolai Paul of the area, reports our Benapole correspondent.

Police and locals said Shankar received severe electric shock while working at his shop around 9 am.

Critically injured, he was rushed to Jessore Medical College Hospital where he died later.

In Nilphamari, a teenage boy was electrocuted at Dakkhin Chawra Anjumanpara village in Sadar upazila on Sunday.

The victim was identified Kibria, 18, son of Ramjan Ali of the village, reports UNB.

Locals said Kibria was electrocuted while trying to refix a snapped electrical wire around noon.

He was rushed to Nilphamari Modern Sadar Hospital where the attending doctors declared him dead.

Lightning kills 4, injures 6 in three districts

Lightning killed four people in Madaripur, Mymensingh and Nilphamari districts yesterday and on Sunday.

A pregnant housewife was killed by lightning at Thantoli village under Sadar upazila of Madaripur yesterday afternoon, reports our correspondent.

The victim was identified as Dalia Aktar, 28, wife of Rakib Matbor of the village.

Masud Hossain Khan, sub-inspector (SI) of Madaripur sadar police station said Dalia was struck by lightning while she was waiting beside a road for bus at around 12:00pm. She died on the spot.

In Mymensingh, a woman and her daughter were killed by lightning at Dhalia Badepurua village in Bhaluka upazila yesterday noon.

The victims were identified as Baby Sultana, 35, wife of Suruj Khan and their daughter Shamima Sultana, 14, of the village, reports our correspondent.

Police and family sources said, Baby and Shamima were working in their court-

yard during rain. Suddenly they were hit by a thunderbolt and killed on the spot.

In another incident yesterday, a girl child was injured critically by thunderbolt at village Kathali in Bhaluka at noon.

The girl was identified as Papiya, 10, daughter of Idris Ali of the village.

She was admitted to Bhaluka upazila health complex, police said.


In Nilphamari, a man was killed and five people were injured as lightning struck them in Dimla upazila on Sunday.


The deceased was identified as Helal Uddin, 45, of Uttar Sundarkhata village in the upazila, reports UNB.

Witnesses said Helal, his daughter Hira, 12, and Sufia Begum, 40, wife of Moyez Uddin, Rupali Begum, 35, wife of Abdur Rauf, Momina Begum, 20, daughter of Nur Islam, and Manju, 40, of nearby Ruphara village were injured in separate lightning strikes in the early hours.

Helal succumbed to his injuries on the way to hospital.

The injured were admitted to the upazila health complex.

Applications are invited from candidates in prescribed form for admission into a two-year Master of Disaster Management (MDM) Professional Degree Program for the session 2012-13.

Eligibility for Admission: Admission is open to individuals, either Bangladeshi or foreign nationals, who have at least a Bachelor Degree with honors or its equivalent from any recognized university or at least a four year graduation degree from any recognized institution, such as university, medical college/university, engineering university/college, agricultural university/college, defense college etc., or master degree with graduation in pass course. No individual with only pass course graduation degree, or having third division/class at any level is eligible to apply. Individuals in the field of disaster management, climate change, disaster risk reduction, adaptation, disaster response and related development areas with practical experiences and who are currently in service are encouraged to apply.
