## Two Hizb-ut Tawhid men arrested

Police arrested two activists of Islamist outfit Hizb-ut Tawhid at Pathanpara Moholla in the district town yesterday morning.

They also seized books and leaflets on *jihad* (Islamic uprising) from their possession, said Golam Mortuza, officer in-charge of Sadar police station.

The arrestees are Zahidul Islam, 29, son of Abdul Kuddus of Goalgram village and Abdul Gaffar, 22, son of Haibatullah of Sindurkouta village under Gangni upazila in Meherpur district.

Being informed by locals, the law enforcers arrested the duo from the area at about 10:30am while they were distributing books and leaflets on *jihad*.

Later, the arrestees were produced before a court that sent them to jail, the OC added.

## Storm damages 200 houses in Pabna

A violent storm ripped into six villages in Santhia upazila of the district on Saturday night, damaging at least 200 thatched and tin-roofed houses and two educational institutions.

The affected villages are Goyashbari, Mongolgram, Tebaria, Debipur, Shargram and Vobanipur under Vulbaria union.

Upazila administration sources said at least 200 houses were damaged and over 500 trees uprooted at the villages during the storm that lasted for ten minutes from 9:30pm.

Debipur School and College, a primary school and a post office at Goyashbari village collapsed during the twister,

sources added.

Md Abdul Aziz, chairman of Vulbaria Union Parishad (UP), said the storm caused extensive damage to houses and trees at six villages of his union. He sought immediate relief for the affected villagers.

Santhia Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Md Enamul Haque visited the spot yesterday. He assured the affected villagers of all possible help and assistance for their rehabilitation.

Contacted, the UNO said he asked the local UP chairman to prepare a list of the storm-hit people and submit it to his office. "After getting the list, we will take initiative to help the affected people," the UNO added.

## Poultry trader stabbed to death

A poultry trader was stabbed to death and his two friends were injured in an attack by a gang of criminals at Dakkhin Betiara village in Chouddagram upazila early yesterday.

The victim was identified as Mohinuddin, 28, son of Abdus Salam of the village.

Police said, a gang entered a room adjacent to the poultry farm at about 1:30am and beat up Mohinuddin's two friends -- Mokbul and Helal, leaving them injured.

Later, they entered the room of Mohinuddin when he was asleep and stabbed him to death. The criminals managed to flee the scene.

Police said the youth might have been killed following previous enmity over drug trading. Mohiuddin was doing poultry business giving up drug peddling but his friends were still involved in drug trading.

The injured were admitted to Feni Sadar Hospital. Police recovered the body and sent to hospital morgue for autopsy.

Victim's brother Illias Ahmed filed a case with Chouddagram PS.

## Victims of 'online fraud' stage protest in C'nawabganj

Police arrested a local coordinator of an online outsourcing company at Batenkhan intersection in Chapainawabganj town on Saturday night on charge of swindling people.

The arrestee is Sohel Rana, 28, son of Ruhul Amin of Namoshankarbaty village under Chapainawabganj municipality.

Golam Mortuza, officer-in-charge (OC) of Sadar Police Station, said they arrested Sohel Rana, owner of Renaissance Digital Studio at Batenkhan intersection, following a case filed by one Shariful Islam.

Shariful alleged that Sohel Rana, local coordinator of onlineaddclick.net, swindled TK 79.44 lakh out of him and his three friends. He said they gave him (Sohel) the money to open accounts in their names.

Police yesterday produced Sohel Rana in a court that sent him to jail.

Hearing the news, over 100 clients of

onlineaddclick.net formed a human chain in front of the deputy commissioner's office demanding punishment of Sohel and his accomplices for swindling them.

Shamim Kawsar of Dariapur area of Chapainawabganj town, said he and 22 others

invested TK 2.10 lakh but earned only Tk 30,000.

Masum Billah of Ranihati village in Shibganj upazila said he became a client of the company three months ago and invested Tk 70,000. "The company cheated me," he alleged.

According to the aggrieved investors, online

addclick.net started its business in Chapainawabganj district in January this year.

They alleged that at least 750 people, including students, were cheated by Sohel and his accomplices. They swindled at least TK 1.25 crore out of the investors.

## 19 houses, 5 shops gutted in Comilla, Bogra

At least four people were injured and 19 houses gutted in a fire at Sultanpur village in Deviddar upazila of the district early yesterday.

Fire Brigade sources said originating from electric short circuit, the fire burned down the houses at about 3:30am, leaving four inmates injured.

The injured are Abdus Salam, 50, Nannu Sheikh, 55, Mostafa, 35, and Abdur Razzak, 40. Among them, Abdus Salam was admitted to a local hospital.

Firefighters from Muradnagar fire station rushed in and doused the blaze after three hours of

frantic efforts.

In Bogra, a devastating fire gutted five shops at Kagil Bazar in Gabtoli upazila of the district on Saturday noon.

Sources said the fire broke out at a cosmetics shop at noon and soon engulfed four adjoining shops.

On information, firefighters rushed to the spot and controlled fire.

However, the affected shop owners claimed that the extent of loss from the fire could go up to Tk 25 lakh.

Locals said a rival gang might have set the fire due to past enmity over extortion.

A clash ensued between two groups at the market following the fire incident that left five people injured.

## 50 hurt in Habiganj clash

At least 50 people were injured, 25 critically, in a fierce clash between two groups of people over catching fish at Karab village in Lakhai upazila on Saturday afternoon.

Police said when Saiful Mia of the village along with his men went to catch fish at the nearby *haor* (water body) at about 2pm, his rivals led by Kuddus Mia obstructed them.

Later, both the groups equipped with lethal weapons attacked each other leaving at least 50 people injured from both sides.

Of the injured, 25 people were admitted to Sadar Adhunik Hospital in critical condition.

## Abducted man yet to be rescued

Police could not rescue farmer Jamal Mollah who was abducted three days ago for ransom by a gang from Raisar village in Alamdanga of Chuadanga district.

Police however, arrested the fathers of two suspected abductors.

According to police, a group of 8/9 stormed into the house of Habibur Rahman Mollah at about 12.30pm on Wednesday night.

The gang took the family members hostage at gun point and looted cash and valuables.

Then they abducted Habibur's son Jamal Mollah, 39, from the house and demanded Tk 5 lakh ransom for his release.
