Interns call off strike

Interns at Khulna Medical College Hospital (KMCH) called off their strike and returned to duties yesterday following a fruitful discussion between the KMCH authorities and the leaders of intern doctors. Dr. Kazi Karim Newaz, president of intern doctors' association told this correspondent that the KMCH authorities beefed up security measures at every ward and introduced gate pass system from yesterday morning. He also said that the eight-member committee assured them of taking steps to realise their two point-demand by next 7 days. Interns enforced the work abstention from Tuesday morning.

2 Hizbut Tawhid men held

UNB, Joypurhat

Two activists of Hizbut Tawhid were arrested from Akkelpur police station premises on Tuesday. The arrestees were identified as Zahid Islam of Gangni upazila in Meherpur district and Abu Sayeed of Panchbibi upazila of Joypurhat district. Police said two unidentified men entered Akkelpur PS and started explaining the role of Hizbut Tawhid organisation and criticising the government before the officer in-charge in the evening. Suspecting militant, police arrested them immediately and sent them to jail after interrogation on the same night. A number of *Jihadi* books, leaflets and mobile phones were seized from them.

Contractor found dead

UNB, Thakurgaon

A contractor of the food directorate was found dead at a residential hotel in the district town on Tuesday. Police recovered the body of Tofazzal Hossain Akanda, 52, son of late Khoda Baksh Akanda of Soidebgaon village in Muladi upazila of Barisal district, from Salam International Hotel in the afternoon. Police said Tofazzal checked in at room 304 of the hotel on Sunday. The hotel authorities informed police after getting no response from him till Tuesday noon. Later, police broke into the room only to find him lying dead. Officer in-charge of Sadar police station Gopal Chakrabarty said Akanda died of cardiac arrest.

Port workers call off strike

Workers at Benapole land port withdrew their identified strike yesterday after the authorities accepted their demand for implementation of the government-declared minimum wages. Loading and unloading of goods resumed at the port around 2:00am. Earlier, Benapole Port-handling Workers' Union went on an indefinite strike on June 2 demanding pay hike. Export and import between Bangladesh and India came to a halt as the workers of Petropole Port in India expressed solidarity with the Benapole workers. The workers called off the strike after local lawmaker Sheikh Afiluddin mediated the matter.

'Rapist' arrested

Police arrested a man on charge of raping a teenage girl at village Talukder of Chareshawar union under Hatiya upazila yesterday. The victim was a daughter of a farmer of the village. Md Iqbal Hossain, sub-inspector of Hatiya police station said when the victim came out of her house to respond to the call of nature at around 1:00 am, Elias, 25, son of Azhar Ahmed and his accomplice Irak Ahmed gagged mouth, took her to a nearby place and raped her. Hearing the screaming of the victim, her parents started shouting. Neighbours immediately caught Elias, but Irak managed to flee the scene. Elias was handed over the Hatiya police station after a good beating.

Infighting in Sylhet BNP deepens

With the emergence of a new group comprising some leaders and activists of the district and city units, internal feud in Sylhet BNP has further deepened.

Though the rival groups of both units held rallies and other programmes jointly for days after Ilias Ali's disappearance, now their feuds have re-surfaced.

The dissidents sat with a three-member team of the central committee headed by Joint Secretary Md Shahjahan separately on Sunday. Former district BNP general secretary Abdul Kahir Chowdhury and former city BNP leader Dr Shahriar Hossain Chowdhury were, among others, present. The three-member team also held separate meetings with the district and city units the same day. On Saturday night, the team members held a separate meeting with Swechchasebak Dal men, who have been running activities separately for months. Central BNP Vice-

Chairman and former foreign secretary Shamsheer Mobin Chowdhury and Chairperson's adviser Inam Ahmed Chowdhury also held meetings with the district and city units on Sunday. Members of the three-member team were present at the meetings where the leaders and activists of the two units called for unity and demanded immediate steps to resolve the internal feuds.

Before Ilias Ali's disappearance on April 17, Swechchasebak Dal district unit President Shamsuzzaman Zaman quit Ilias's camp over the killing of JCD cadre Shawkat. Zaman blamed city JCD Joint Secretary Dinar for Shawkat's killing as he had earlier left Dinar's faction. Dinar and his associate Zunayed went missing on April 1, but his (Dinar) wife Princila Parvin Pinki, daughter of district BNP General Secretary MA Gaffar, filed a case on May 11, accusing Zaman. Zaman alleged that Gaffar and other district and city BNP leaders are engaged in creating trouble for the party, capitalising on Dinar's disappearance.

Housewife killed for dowry

UNB, Madaripur

A housewife was beaten to death allegedly by her husband and in-laws for dowry in Sadar upazila on Monday night.

The victim was identified as Hiron alias Liza, 22, daughter of Badsha Howlader of Balia village in the upazila.

Police quoting family members said Hiron was married off to Palash Howlader, 30, son of Karim Howlader, six years back. Since the marriage, Palash and his family members used to torture her for dowry.

On the fateful night, an altercation ensued over the issue. Angered by her refusal to bring money from her father, they beat up her mercilessly, leaving her dead on the spot.

10 hurt in BCL-JCD clashes in Sylhet

At least 10 people were injured in clashes between the activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) in city's Pathantula and Subidbazar areas on Tuesday night.

Locals said there was a long standing dispute between Safayet, an activist of Bidhan group of BCL and Nabil, a worker of Kala Manik group of JCD in the city.

As a sequel to their

enmity, both the groups equipped with lethal weapons locked in a clash at about 10:30pm in front of Pathantula Petrol pump, leaving three people injured.

Later, BCL workers attacked JCD workers at about 11:30pm in front of Subidabazar Ali Center leaving seven JCD men injured.

Of the injured, Safayet Khan, 22, Shiplu, 20, Bidyut, 21, Ripon, 20, Jubayer, 22, Abdus Sabur, 23 and Mostaq, 20, were admitted to Sylhet Osmani Medical College Hospital.

2 human traffickers get life in Manikganj

UNB, Manikganj

A tribunal here on Tuesday sentenced two people to life imprisonment in a human trafficking case.

The tribunal also fined Awal Hossain of Singair upazila in the district, and Pabitra Rosario alias Gilbert, 32, of Savar in Dhaka, Tk 10,000 each, in default, to suffer three months RI more. According to the prosecu-

tion, the convicts sent a woman of Laxmibazar in Dhaka, to Dubai with a promise to give her a job at a shop.

But there she was forced to engage in flesh trade. When the victim informed her husband of the matter, he gave the human traffickers Tk 17,000 to get her back.

As the traffickers did not return his wife, he filed a case with Singair police station on May 13, 2006.
