

SUNDAY'S ROADBLOCK BY DYF

400 sued in Khagrachhari for 'attack on policemen'

About 400 activists of Democratic Youth Forum (DYF), a front organisation of United People's Democratic Front (UPDF), have been sued on charge of attack on police during the road blockade programme enforced by the forum in Khagrachhari town on Sunday.

Sub-Inspector Mohammad Obaidur filed the case with Sadar Police Station on Monday. Of the accused, four are identified while the rest unidentified. The accused identified in

the case are Usising Marma, 23, Bachchu Moni Chakma, 25, Umesh Chakma, 22 and Johan Chakma. Usising and Bachchu were arrested following a clash with cops at Swanirbar Bazar in the town on Sunday.

Mostafizur Rahman, officer-in-charge (OC) of Khagrachhari Police Station, said law enforcers picked up a suspected DYF activist named Nipru Marma, 30, from the bazaar area during Monday's blockade programme.

Police are quizzing Nipru, the OC said, adding that drives are on to arrest

the accused in the case.

Contacted, DYF General Secretary Michael Chakma denied the allegation of attack on police by DYF men during Sunday's road blockade programme at Swanirbar Bazar in the town.

He demanded withdrawal of the "false" case and immediate release of the DYF activists.

Five policemen were injured during a clash with DYF men at Swanirbar Bazar on Sunday. Police fired tear gas shells at least 18 rubber bullets to disperse the pickets.

The youth forum enforced a 21-hour road blockade programme in Khagrachhari district immediately after police foiled its bid to besiege the head office of CHT Land Dispute Resolution Commission in the district town on Sunday.

DYF tried to lay a siege to the office to press its demands for cancelling the hearing process of the land commission, withdrawal of commission's Chairman Justice (ret'd) Khademul Islam, amendments to CHT Land Dispute Resolution Commission Act-2001.

One killed, 74 hurt as rival villagers clash in 2 dists

One person was killed and at least 74 others were injured as rival groups of villagers clashed in Sirajganj and Habiganj yesterday and the day before.

One person was killed and 25 others were injured in a fierce clash between Mollah group and Dokla group in Saratol village under Shahzadpur upazila in Sirajganj district yesterday, reports our correspondent.

Farhad Hossain, 65, of Dokla group, who was injured in the clash, died at Sirajganj General Hospital yesterday evening while undergoing treatment.

Jasim Uddin Sarker, OC of Shahzadpur PS said there was a long running feud between the two groups

over establishing supremacy in the area.

Several clashes took place in the past. Following a quarrel yesterday, supporters of Korban Ali and Abdul Mollah locked in a fierce clash leaving 25 people injured.

Among them, Farhad Hossain succumbed to injuries at the hospital. Seriously injured Sakhawat Hossain was sent to Dhaka for treatment.

In Sylhet, at least 50 people were injured in a clash between two groups of villagers over a trivial matter at Tajpur Bazar in Osmaninagar upazila on Monday night, reports Our Staff Correspondent.

Police and witnesses said Fatim Mia of Dashedal village locked in an altercation with Abdur Rab of Matihani village over throwing water

from Rab's beauty parlour on the first floor of a market at about 6:30pm.

Later, the supporters of two groups, equipped with sticks and rods, engaged in a fierce clash at the market on Dhaka-Sylhet highway, leaving 50 people injured from the both sides.

During the clash, the rival groups vandalised 20 shops and looted 15 others. Vehicles movement on the highway came to a halt for over an hour.

On information, police rushed to the scene and resorted to baton charge to bring the situation under control. The traffic movement resumed at 9:00pm.

OC Al Amin of Osmaninagar PS said additional police have been deployed in the area to avert further clash.

Criminals kill woman, hurt husband, son

Local criminals yesterday killed a woman and injured her husband and son at Sastarkhalkul village in Terokhada upazila.

The deceased was identified as Nahar Begum, 45, wife of Abdul Mannan Sheikh, 46, of Barasat village in the same upazila.

Locals and police said, Mannan had an enmity with his neighbour over a piece of land. Earlier Mannan was attacked allegedly by his neighbours and was forced to leave his native Barasat village along with his family and settle at neighbouring Sastarkhalkul, they said.

Yesterday at dead of night, a gang of local criminals stormed into Mannan's house and hacked Mannan, Nahar and their 10-year-old son Hasibur indiscriminately.

They were admitted to KMCH where duty doctor declared Nahar dead.

Ansar man, two youths jailed for stalking

Mobile courts in Lalmonirhat and Netrakona yesterday jailed an Ansar member and two youths for stalking schoolgirls.

A mobile court in Lalmonirhat jailed an Ansar for one year yesterday for stalking a schoolgirl near the Teesta Barrage at Dowani village in Hatibandha upazila, reports our correspondent.

Convict Hafizul Islam, 30, of Sindurna village in the upazila has also been dismissed from his job, police said.

Hafizul, a member of Teesta Barrage Ansar camp, stalked a girl student of class eight at Dowani High School in the morning

when she was going to school alone, they said.

When the girl informed the matter to her classmates and teachers, they besieged the Ansar camp. A large number of villagers also joined them. They also blocked Barokhata-Dimla road. At this, police from Hatibandha PS rushed to the camp and arrested accused Hafizul.

Later, the mobile court led by executive magistrate Shakhawat Hossain sentenced Hafizul to one-year jail in presence of police, Ansar officials and locals.

In Netrakona, a mobile court yesterday sentenced two youths to jail for sexually harassing a schoolgirl, reports our correspondent.

The convicts are Sobhan

Mia, 21, son of Dulal Mia and Sumon, 22, son of Mojibur Rahman of village Tanga in Sadar upazila.

OC of Netrakona Sadar police station Azizur Rahman said Sobhan Mia was jailed for one year while Sumon got six months imprisonment.

According to police, the two youths waylaid the daughter of one Chanfor Mia of same village when she was returning home from nearby Golam Hossen High School.

The two youths also embraced the girl on the road. Hearing the girl's cry for help, locals rushed to the spot and rescued her.

Later, police arrested the two youths from their houses and produced them before the mobile court.

Sad death of teacher protested

Classes at different high schools in the district town remained suspended till noon on Sunday as the teachers and students protested sad death of a teacher on Monday last.

They demanded immediate punishment to the person responsible for the callous act that led to the collapse of a wall of an under construction building, causing his death at Haldarpara in the town.

Jiban Kumar Sheel, an English teacher of Brahmanbaria Government Model Girls' High School, was killed when a portion of a wall on the top floor of a 13-storey building collapsed on him.

On Sunday, the teachers and students of the schools gathered at 'National Hero Abdul Kuddus Makhon Muktao Mancha' demanding immediate punishment of the owner of the building and his contractor.

Youth shot dead in Moheshkhali

A youth was shot dead by a gang of criminals at Mohammadshah Ghona village in Moheshkhali upazila of the district on Monday night.

The victim was identified as Md Belal Hossain, 26, son of Akbar Ahmed of the village under Kalamarchhora union.

Police and witnesses said a gang of criminals picked up Belal while he was returning home from Kalamarchhora Bazar at around 11:00pm. They took Belal to Mujibkilla area and shot him dead.

As locals rushed to the spot, the gang fired blank shots and managed to flee.

Locals said there had been a conflict between two groups over capture of shrimp enclosures in the area. Belal might have been killed as a sequel to the conflict.

He was a supporter of former UP chairman and Awami League leader Osman Goni, who was shot dead by a gang at Kalamarchhora Bazar on the night of March 29 this year.

Ranjit Barua, officer-in-charge of Moheshkhali Police Station, said they recovered the body yesterday morning and sent it to Cox's Bazar Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Police have been deployed in the area to avert any further untoward situation, the OC added.

No one was arrested in connection with the murder as of 6:00pm yesterday.
