UNREST IN MYANMAR Tension brews in Rohingya camps, outside

DWAIPAYAN BARUA, from Teknaf

Anxiety has gripped both the Rohingya refugees and the Rakhine residents in Teknaf of Cox's Bazar for the last few days following the recent sectarian violence in Myanmar's Rakhine state.

The cross-border human movement both by river and land routes as well as bilateral trade between Bangladesh and Myanmar through Teknaf land port and other points remained suspended since Saturday, putting the local businessmen in worry over the fate of their consignments.

Though the local administration has beefed up security measures, tension prevails among the people of two Rakhine villages under the upazila and a locality under Teknaf Police Station as they are fearing attack by Rohingya refugees, who are also aggrieved at the loss of their relatives in Myanmar.

Shooting took place at Sarak Bhaban on Tuesday not only over the recent tender businesses but also for establishing supremacy in tender manipulation, sources at the head office of Roads and Highways Department (RHD) said.

Syed Murad Reza, assistant engineer of RHD, said 14 tenders valued around Tk 520 crore had been invited in the current fiscal year of 2011-12.

Of them, four tenders for 18 works worth around Tk 250 crore were invited in November last year. But those were cancelled by the selection committee in April this year as it found manipulation there.

Sources said the cancellation of the tenders fuelled the feud between the respective groups of Shamim Shahriar, a contractor and publication secretary of Swachhasebak League central committee,

Govt plans to set up Eastern, Western Command, goes for big defence purchase

The Bangladesh Army's existing controlling system will be rearranged into separate Eastern and Western commands to modernise and strengthen the force, Planning Minister AK Khandker told the House yesterday.

Khandker, who is in charge of the defence ministry in the parliamentary affairs, said restructuring of the overall organisational organogram is now at the final stage to introduce the two new command structures in the army.

Welcoming the move, former army chief Lt Gen (retd) Mahbubur Rahman said this was the long overdue plan in the army. It would be good for the force if it is now implemented, he commented.

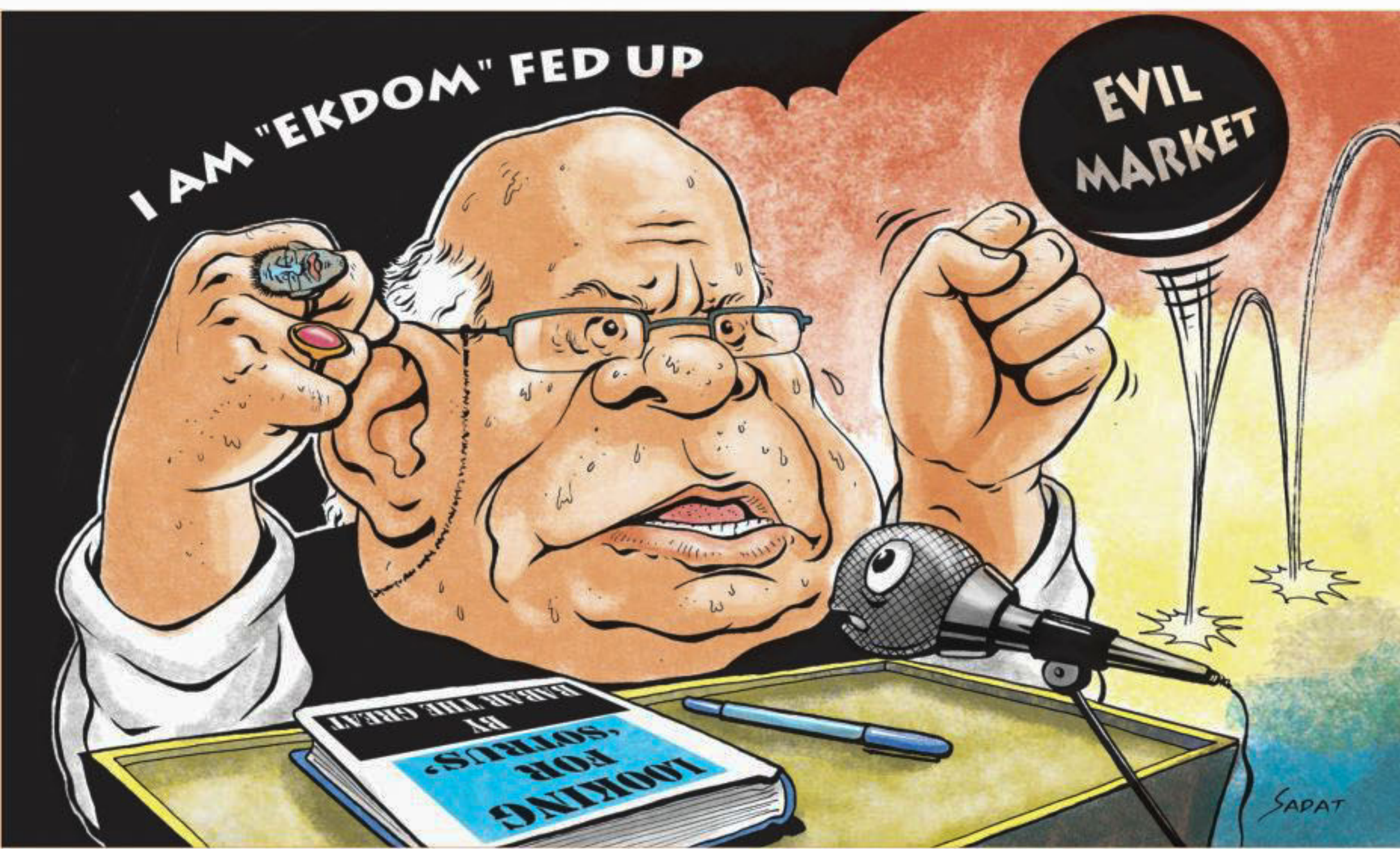
